Important Safety Information

Thank you for purchasing a REVOLT product. To ensure safe operation of your vehicle, please review the following guidelines:

Before First Use:
Read the manual thoroughly and store it securely for future reference.

Safety Guidelines:
*Keep small accessories out of children's reach.
*Do not use the vehicle in high-temperature environments (e.g., near open flames or heating devices).
*Children must operate the vehicle under adult supervision. Always keep the vehicle within the driver/instructor's line of sight.

Bubble Function Warning:
Always use bubble solution in a single area to prevent creating a slippery surface.

Battery Safety:
*Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
*Ensure correct polarity when installing/replacing batteries.
*Do not mix old and new batteries or different battery types.
*Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
*For prolonged storage (>10 days), discharge the battery to 40%-50% capacity (e.g., if fully charged, open the car and let it sit for 10-15 minutes). This optimizes battery lifespan.

Charging & Maintenance:
*Only use the provided charging cable.
*Disconnect the car from the power source before cleaning.
*Do not use sharp objects, converters and accessories for damage. Discontinue use immediately if damage detected.
*Power off the vehicle and remove remote control batteries after use.

Storage & Handling:
This packaging and instruction manual contains important information and should be kept in a safe place for future reference.
*Never damage the product in water.

Low Battery Protocol:
When the car's indicator lights flash or the car stops, recharge immediately.

Battery Installation & Adding Bubble Solution

Remote Control Battery Installation

1. Unscrew the bubble tank at the bottom of the car.
2. Add bubble solution.
3. Return the bubble tank to its position under the car and rotate until tight.

Activating the Bubble Feature

Press the heart-shaped button on the remote control to activate bubbles blowing from the back of the car.

Bubble Button

Basic Operation Of The Car

Pairing: Switch on the remote control and press the ON/OFF switch on the vehicle to the "ON" position. Wait for 1-2 seconds and the car and remote will automatically pair.

R/C Car Battery Installation

1. Open the battery cover at the bottom of the car.
2. Place the battery into the battery compartment and connect the cable.
3. Place the battery compartment cover back into place and tighten the screw.
