

User's Manual (AF15W,AF20W,AF25W)

This light device has been tested and found to comply with the limits for Consumer RF Lighting Device, pursuant to Part 18 of the FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection against harmful interference in a residential installation. This equipment generates, uses and can radiate radio frequency energy and, if not installed and used in accordance with the instructions, may cause harmful interference to radio communications. - 1 Use only on 120V/60Hz.
- 2 Never disassemble or modify-any changes could void the user's authority to operate this device.
- 3 Not for use in totally enclosed recessed fixtures.
- 4 Risk of electric shock-do not use with where directly exposed to water.
- 5 This device is not intended for use with emergency exit fixtures or emergency exit lights.
- 6 This product may cause interference to radio equipment and should not be installed near maritime safety communications equipment or other critical navigation or communication equipment operating between 0.45-30MHz.
- 7 To prevent burns, do not touch the bulb during operation or immediately after switching off.
- 8 Not for use with dimmers, electronic timer or photocell devices or occupancy sensor.
- 9, If device is malfunction such as excessive audible noise or excessive radio interference with nearby equipment, turn off and replaces the device. In some cases, moving lamp to another location may reduce or eliminate Radio Interference.
