INSTALLATION

1. Insert the cigarette lighter plug, slide the base unit on to the base holder cigarette lighter plug until the stop is locked in place. make sure that the polarity of the battery are the same on the base unit and its holder.
2. Insert one end of the connection cable (included) into the base unit. Then, insert the other end of the standard 2.5mm plug in to your cellular phone.
3. Insert the base unit into the cigarette lighter in your vehicle. The two adjustable screws on the base unit plug can be used to adjust the face direction of the base unit.
4. Turn the power switch on the base unit to the "on" position. The power indicator light (Red) on the base unit should be lit to indicate that the unit is working.

WEARING YOUR WIRELESS EARPHONE HEADSET

1. Push the ear-hook toward your ear and clip it on your ear
(Refer to figure 1).
2. Slightly turn the earphone around until the earphone fits comfortably.
(Refer to figure 2).

BATTERY CHARGE

1. Push the earhook, the blue light on the earphone should be lit. Otherwise, the earphone's battery needs to be charged.
2. The earphone unit automatically charges the battery when the earphone is on the base unit. If the charge indicator light on the base unit is blinking, the battery is charging. When the indicator light is steady (red), the battery is fully charged.
3. When the earphone is picked up, the charge indicator light on the base unit should be green.

USING YOUR WIRELESS EARPHONE HEADSET

1. Receiving a Call

- * Pick up the earphone headset from the base unit to receive calls
(Note: some cellular phones do not support this function)
- * Push the receive button on the base unit if you are wearing the earphone headset.

2. Placing a call

- * While wearing the wireless earphone, use your cellular phone to dial the number
- * This wireless earphone supports voice dial function. For more information, refer to your cellular phone manual.

3. Ending a call

- * Put the wireless earphone headset back to the base unit to end calls
Push the receive button once on the base unit if you are wearing the wireless earphone headset
