To whom it may concern,

Pursuant to CFR 2.1043, Extreme Networks, Inc., hereby requests a Class II Permissive Change for the following project(s):

FCC ID: QXO-AP4060 (Original Grant Date: 07/14/2025)

The changes filed under this application are:

1. Add a new model AP4060X. The differences with AP4060 are listed below.
 - a) Change from PIFA internal antenna to dipole external antenna (Ant 1~2)
 - b) Add a new dipole external antenna (Ant 3~4)
 - c) Add a new dipole Omni antenna (Ant 10, support Bluetooth / 802.15.4)
 - d) Add a new dipole Patch antenna (Ant 11~12, support WLAN 2.4GHz / 5GHz / 6GHz)
 - e) The same antenna with AP4060, but was re-test due to a reset in the antenna configuration (Ant 5~8)

All antenna configuration changes have been fully re-evaluated through testing to ensure compliance with applicable regulatory requirements.

2. AP4060X DFS Retesting Justification:


Due to the change in antenna configuration and the reduced antenna gain, DFS re-testing has been conducted to ensure continued compliance.
