1. Product overview

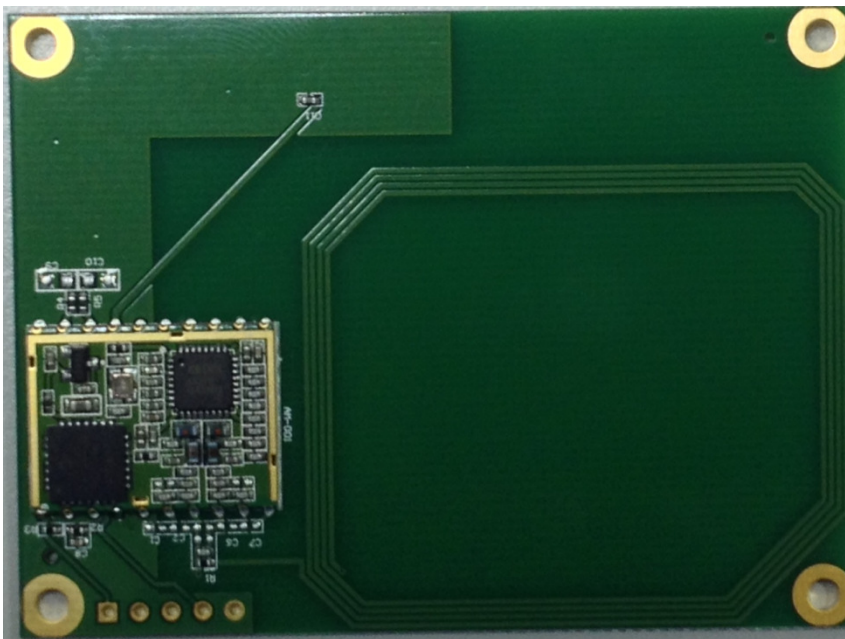
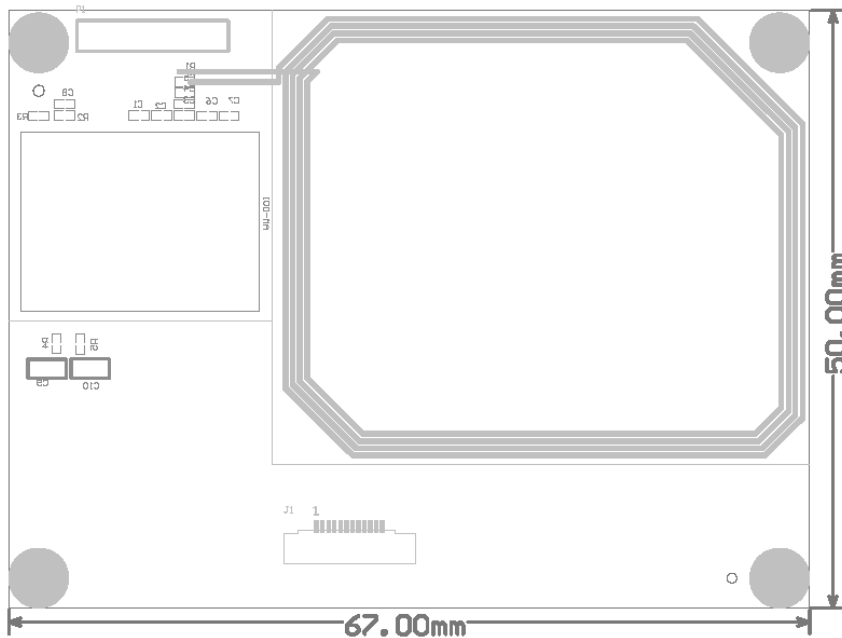
1. General Description

- **The G100NFC is an OEM HF compact NFC reader module** suitable for a wide range of applications including Access Control, Automotive, NFC Infrastructure, and Ticketing. G100NFC, It's simplified USB interface and superior performance, make it easy to integrate any device with NFC technology.

LABEL OF THE END PRODUCT:

The final end product must be labeled in a visible area with the following "FCCID: **QYLF110NFC**". If the size of the end product is larger than 8x10cm, then the following FCC part 15.19 statement has to also be available on the label: This device complies with Part 15 of FCC rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) this device may not cause harmful interference and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation.

If not, a second label must be placed on the outside of the final device that contains the following text: "Contains FCC ID: **QYLF110NFC**" .

The grantee's FCC ID can be used only when all FCC compliance requirements are met.
