6.	The module must be labeled with its permanently affixed FCC ID label, or use an electronic display	Yes	The module transmitter will be labeled with its own FCC ID, and for OEM integration the integration manual contains labeling instructions for the host device per Part 15.212 (vi)
7.	The module must comply with all specific rules applicable to the transmitter, including all the conditions provided in the integration instructions by the grantee	Yes	The EUT is compliant with all applicable FCC rules.
