


Location option 1: ON TOP OF EACH SOCKLINER



Option 1 - Placement of compliance stickers on top of sockliners

The sockliner is bonded to the midsole of the shoe, and the compliance information will be printed onto a sticker with a very strong adhesive that is very difficult to remove from the sockliner. Because the lace engine is **not** user-removable and is therefore permanently located in the footwear, and the sockliner is permanently bonded to the midsole of the footwear, the wireless communication device will be permanently labeled.

Location option 2: ON BACK OF EACH SOCKLINER TAG



Option 2 - Tag stitched to each sockliner

FCC ID label on back of sockliner tag

The sockliner tag is stitched to the sockliner (which is bonded to the midsole of the shoe), and the compliance information would again be on a high-adhesive sticker on the back of that tag. The way the shoe is put together, the tag (and attached compliance sticker) are sticking up off the sockliner resting against the inner wall of the shoe, so you can easily access/see both sides of the tag.
