





### Battery

Before you use it for the first time, the L6 must be fully charged. To do this, connect L6 to your computer via the USB to micro-USB cable. The indicator on the side of the right ear cup illuminates with a red light to show that the device is charging. Once charging is complete, the indicator light turns off.



### Wearing the Earphone

Changing Eargels  
For the optimal audio experience, try the different eargel sizes. The fit should feel tight and secure in your ear.

### Bluetooth Connection

Before L6 can be used with your telephone or Bluetooth audio player, the two devices must be paired(3). Once the two devices have detected each other, it is no longer necessary to pair each time.


1. From your telephone or Bluetooth audio player, start a search for Bluetooth peripherals.
2. Select "L6"

Once your telephone is paired with the L6, the two devices will connect to each other automatically each time that the L6 is switched on. It is not possible to simultaneously connect several devices to L6.

NOTE: If two mobile phones have been connected to the Lezun Sport Wireless Earphone, you may need to select which phone will be used for calls/music open the Bluetooth menu on the mobile phone you wish to use and select the Lezun Sport Wireless Earphone from the list of devices.



### Call & Music

#### Turn on/off

**Turn on:** Press and hold the multi-functional button for 5 seconds until indication light flash in blue rapidly with du du sounds. Indication light lasts blue and able to bluetooth connection.  
**Off:** Press and hold the multi-functional button for 3 seconds.

#### Play/pause music

Tap the Multi-function button

#### Answer/end call

Tap the Multi-function button

#### Reject call

Double-tap the Multi-function button

#### Redial last number

When not on a call, double-tap the Multi-function button

#### Adjust volume

Press the Volume up or Volume down button

#### Music skip /track

Press and hold (2 secs) the Volume up or Volume down button

### ⚠ Warning

- Listening to music at high volumes for long periods can lead to hearing problems. We do not recommend using these headphones at maximum volume, particularly for long periods of time.
- To protect your hearing, turn down the volume of your music player before connecting your headphones. After putting on the headphones, gradually turn up the volume until you reach a suitable level.
