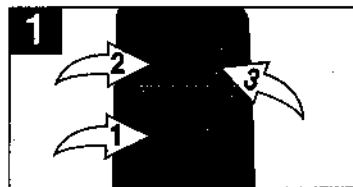


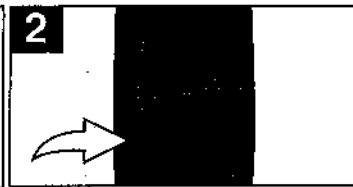
UNIVERSAL REMOTE CONTROL

PROGRAMMING THE UNIVERSAL REMOTE CONTROL

According to the Device Brand Code List at the end of this manual, find out the device brand name and code of the device that you want to control (For example, you can find codes for "Radio Shack" TV: 008,013,014 etc). Then follow steps as below:



Press and hold the SET button ❶ and the desired button, TV ❷ or VCR ❸, for the unit you would like to operate until the LED indicator stays lit, then release.

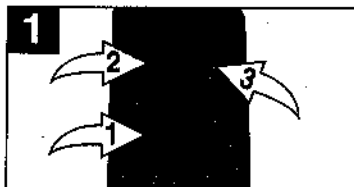


Enter the three-digit code from the chart at the end of the manual; the LED Indicator will turn off after the last digit is entered. If the wrong code is entered, the LED Indicator will blink twice and then remain lit; try another code.

UNIVERSAL REMOTE CONTROL (CONTINUED)

MANUALLY PROGRAMMING THE REMOTE CONTROL

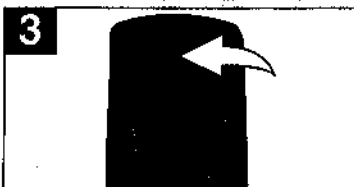
If you tried all the codes under the brand name and the remote still does not work or you can not find the correct brand in the Device Code List, you can use Manual Search to find out the correct code.



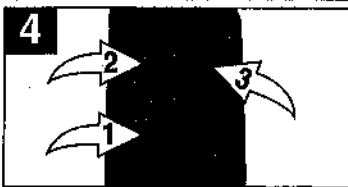
Turn on the unit you want to control and insert a tape (if using a VCR). Press and hold the SET button  and the desired button, TV  or VCR , for the unit you would like to operate until the LED indicator stays lit, then release.



Press the POWER button, then release it. The remote control will enter the Manual Search Mode and the LED will keep flashing.



Point the remote control to the device and then press the POWER button. See if the device turns off. If it does not, repeat this step every one second.



If the unit does turn off, test the other buttons. If they do not work return to step 1.

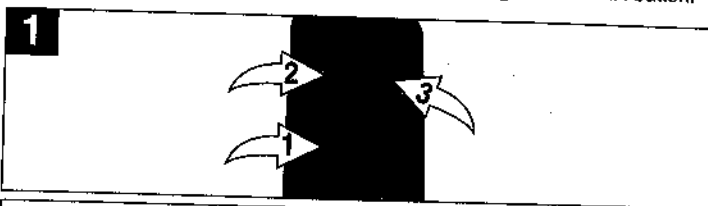
NOTES:

- While searching, you can press the SET button to switch between Forward and Backward to change search direction and find the right code quickly.
- To exit Search mode, press the device button and the LED will turn off.
- In the Search mode, besides the POWER button, all other key's function can be checked normally. That is to say you can test other keys without leaving search mode.
- The remote will exit the search mode automatically if no key is pressed in 30 seconds.

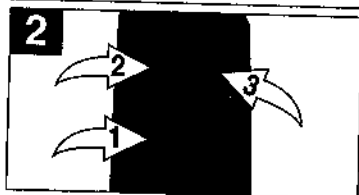
UNIVERSAL REMOTE CONTROL (CONTINUED)

AUTO SEARCH

This search is similar to Manual Search but the remote control will transmit the power signal automatically instead of manually pressing the POWER button.



Turn on the unit you want to control and insert a tape (if using a VCR). Press and hold the SET button ❶ and the desired button, TV ❷ or VCR ❸, for the unit you would like to operate for three seconds, then release and the auto search will begin; the LED indicator will flash and the remote control will transmit the power signal once every 2 seconds automatically.



When the device turns off, test the other buttons. If they do not work return to step 1.

NOTE:

- To exit the Auto Search mode, press any button (except SET) to quit.

UNIVERSAL REMOTE CONTROL (CONTINUED)

DEVICE LOCK/UNLOCK

This function will make one device code fixed and unable to be changed by code setup by Manual Search or Auto Search:

1. Press the device button that you want to lock such as TV, etc.
2. Press and hold the SET button, then press the 7 button. Release both pressed buttons, the LED indicator will blink twice then turn off and the code of the current device will be locked.
3. If you want to unlock the current code, press and hold the SET button, then press the 8 button. Release the pressed buttons, the LED indicator will blink twice and then turn off and the current code will be unlocked.

NOTE:

- The locked code can be changed by unlocking or resetting only.
- Only one code can be locked in all devices. If you try to set this function on different devices, the system would reserve the last setup only. You can make the operation of unlock under any device.

RESET

This will erase all the set-up data you programmed.

1. Press and hold the SET button.
2. Press the 0 button.
3. Release both pressed buttons, the LED indicator will blink twice then turn off and the remote control will reset.

PUNCH-THROUGH FUNCTION:

When you change the device from one to another, if the new device does not have a volume button and mute button, the remote control will remain set to the volume button and mute button of the last device.

DEVICE CODE DISPLAY:

The device code is a 3-digit number and any one of the digits can be recalled:

1. Press and hold the SET button, then press the digit that you want to display, such as 1, 2 or 3.
2. Count the times that the LED blinks as the blinking will represent the digit's number. If there is no blink, the digit is zero.

UNIVERSAL REMOTE CONTROL (CONTINUED)

NOTES:

- After you have finished set-up and you want to use the remote control, first press the desired device button (i.e. VCR, etc) that you want to control, then operate your remote control normally.
- All settings (i. e. device code) will be memorized until changed or reset.
- If the remote control acts improperly, take out the batteries for a few minutes, then replace the batteries. Your remote control should act normally now.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

CLEANING

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

If you experience a problem with this unit, please refer to the following chart before requesting service.

Problem	Cause	Remedy
I can not find the transmitted picture	Check your TV input mode	Your TV input (or source) mode should be set to the same mode as when you use your VCR. This is usually the Video mode (it may be Video, Video 1, Video 2, or Input).
	Check your VCR Mode	Your VCR should be set to the VCR mode, not the TV mode. This button can usually be found on the VCR or the VCR remote. Make sure your TV is set up to receive the signal from the video input mode that you have selected. If your camera is hooked up to Video 2, your TV has to be set up to receive the signal from Video 2. Check your TV manual for further instructions.
I cannot find picture on my TV when using the VCR input jacks on the FRONT of my VCR	Your VCR may be set up to receive from the REAR Video Input	Make sure your VCR is setup to receive the signal from the FRONT Video Input. Check your VCR manual to select the FRONT Video Input jacks.
I cannot find the picture on my TV when using the VCR input jacks on the REAR of my VCR	Your VCR may be set up to receive from the FRONT Video Input	Make sure your VCR is setup to receive the signal from the REAR Video Input. Check your VCR manual to select the REAR Video Input jacks.
Picture has interference	Channel Selector switch	Change the position of the "A/B" Channel Selector Switch on your VideoCam and Camera base (inside battery compartment). Make sure that the VideoCam and Camera Base "A/B" Channel Selector switch are set to the same position (A or B).
Poor picture quality	Weak batteries	Install new alkaline batteries.
If your TV display is in black and white (not color picture)	Weak batteries	Install new alkaline batteries.
If your TV display has vertical lines	Weak batteries	Install new alkaline batteries.
TV speakers have feedback	Your TV volume may be too high	Press MUTE or lower the volume on your TV.
