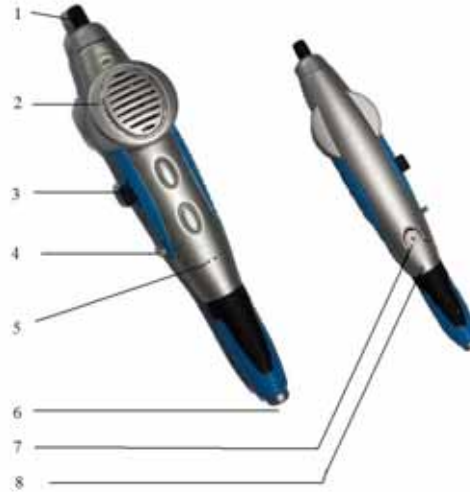


INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Components:

1. Antenna
2. Speaker
3. On/off switch
4. Push-to-talk switch
5. Microphone
6. Pen
7. Battery Door Screw
8. Battery Door



Battery Installation:

ONLY AN ADULT SHOULD INSTALL OR CHANGE BATTERIES.

1. Slide the on/off switch to Off position before replacing the batteries.
2. Use a screwdriver to open the battery compartment.
3. Install four standard button cell – DC 1.5 volt “LR44” batteries following the polarity diagram on the inside of the compartment.
4. Never mix old and new batteries.
5. If not using for a long period of time, remove the batteries.
6. When the batteries are installed, reclose the battery door and replace the screw.

Operation:

1. Switch on the unit by sliding the on/off switch to On.
2. To transmit a message, push the Push-to-talk switch and talk clearly to the microphone.
3. To receive a message, release the Push-to-talk switch.
4. In the event of interference caused by other radio signals in the vicinity, move to a different location.
5. To switch off the unit, slide the on/off switch to Off.
