




## About your Phone

### Installing and Removing battery

SIM (Subscriber Identity Module) is a 'Smart Card' that holds user phone number, service details, and memory for Phone Book numbers and messages. You can use your SIM in any GSM phone and will be charged for the calls.


#### 1. Installing SIM card

1. Power off the phone first.
2. Pull out the battery.
3. Insert the SIM card.
4. Slide the latch over the SIM card to lock it in place.



#### 2. Removing SIM card

1. Slide the latch to the right.
2. Remove your SIM card from the phone.



\* Protect your SIM card from scratches, water, dirt and static electricity.


\* Do not bend or scratch your SIM card.

## About your Phone

### Installing and Removing battery


#### 1. Installing the battery

Insert the battery into the battery compartment at a slant angle and press the top of the battery until the battery locks in the place.



#### 2. Removing the battery

Slide up the battery latch and then pull out the battery from the phone.



**Power on/off****1. Power on**

Press [END] key for a while.

 If PIN is activated, please enter 'PIN code'.

If 'Lock' is activated, please enter password.

Initial password is set to '0000'

If security of SIM card is enabled, the phone requests the PIN code every time when the phone is turned on.

**2. Power off**

Press and hold [END].

** Making an emergency call**

Your phone supports the international emergency number. This means that these numbers can normally be used to make an emergency call in any country with or without a SIM card inserted. If a GSM network is within range.

(Some network operators may require that a SIM card is inserted, and in some cases that the PIN has been entered as well.)

To make an emergency call, proceed as follows.

(1) If the phone is not on, switch it on.

(2) Press [SOS] or dial emergency number when in distress.

**About PIN/PUK****1. PIN (Personal Identification Number)**

It is a personal code (4 to 8 digits) provided by your network operator in order to prevent other people from using your SIM card.

It is usually supplied with the SIM card. The PIN is usually requested each time when the phone is switched on.

If you enter an incorrect PIN three times consecutively, the SIM card is blocked and cannot be used until you unblock it by entering the PUK.

**2. PIN2**

It is a code composed of 4 to 8 digits and is supplied with some SIM cards to access specific function such as setting the charge detail display and access other additional functions. If you enter an incorrect PIN2 three times consecutively, the SIM card is blocked and you cannot access the functions until you unblock it by entering the PUK2.

**3. PUK (PIN Unblocking Key)**

It is composed of 8 digits and used to unblock a SIM card. The PUK may be supplied with the SIM card.

If you forget the code, please contact your service provider.

If you enter an incorrect PUK ten times consecutively, the SIM card becomes invalid.

Please contact your service provider for a new card.

**4. PUK2**

It is composed of 8 digits and is supplied with some SIM cards to unlock PIN2. If you forget the code, please contact your service provider. If you enter an incorrect PUK2 ten times consecutively, you will not be able to access the additional functions provided by PIN2. Please contact your service provider for a new card.

**5. Change PIN or PIN2 code**

You can change the PIN or PIN2 code to any 4 to 8 digits number.

**6. Set PIN Check**

This feature asks for the PIN code whenever the phone is powered on.

Note: If you enter the wrong PIN code three times consecutively, the SIM card is automatically blocked.

**7. PUK/PUK2 Code**

The PUK and PUK2 codes are 8-digit codes that usually provided by your service provider along with the SIM card. Their purpose is to unlock SIM cards after wrong PIN has been entered repeatedly.

**Making a call****1. Using Digit Keys**

Enter the phone number in Idle mode, then press [SEND].

**2. Using Turbo Dial**

Press and hold a location number in Idle mode to connect a call to the corresponding number of the appropriate location.

If the location number is '2', press and hold [2].

If the location number is '21', press [2] and press and hold [1].

Ø It is possible to use Turbo dial numbers stored in your SIM card. You can switch Turbo dial settings between Phone entry and SIM entry.  
Please see details for Turbo set in phone book.

**3. Using Phone Book entry**

Search for a number in the phone book, then press [SEND] to make a call.

Ø Use Redialing: If the connection of the call fails, your Phone will redial the number automatically.  
Press [END] to abandon Auto-calling attempt.  
(if Redial is set to 'On')  
In Idle mode, press [SEND] to review the Call list.

**Receiving a call**

When you receive a call, the phone rings or vibrates and displays an incoming call notice.  
Flip open to receive the call. (if [Folder open] is selected)  
When the flip is opened and the phone rings, press any key to answer. (if [Anykey press] is selected)

\*Except [END] key

! You cannot receive calls when PIN is locked.

**Missed a call**

If you are unable to answer a call, the number of missed call is displayed.

1. Time and number (if CLI is supported) is displayed.
2. The latest call information appears on the display.

**In call menu**

You can access different menus during a call. Press [Menu] (left softkey) during a call to connect some of the In-call menu. Menu selection depends on the state of the call, the type and setting of your SIM card and subscription to these services.

**I. Phone book**

This option displays the Phonebook menu.

1. Press [Menu], then move to "Phone Book".
2. Press [OK].
3. Scroll to the desired item and press [OK]. All the phone book functions are displayed.  
(see "Phone Book" on Main Menu)

**II. Message**

This option displays the Message menu.

1. Press [Menu], then move to "Message".
2. Press [OK].
3. Select the desired item and press [OK].

**III. Mute On/Off**

You can mute any active call. Muting means that you can hear the other person's voice but he/she cannot hear your voice.

During a call, press [Menu], then scroll to 'Mute on'. Press [OK]. 'Mute' icon appears on screen.  
To unmute the call, press 'Mute Off' and press [OK]. 'Mute' icon disappears.

## Basic Function

### IV. Hold

You can put a current call on hold and accept an incoming call, or start a second call.

1. During a call, press [ANS].
2. Select "Hold & Ans", then press [OK].

To return to the first call, press "Switch".

Ø During a call, press [right soft key], then popup menu appears. It shows "End on call / End held call / End all" options.

You can select the following items:

- End on call : End a call you put on hold.
- End held call : End the current active call.
- End all : End all connected calls.

If supported by service provider, more people can take part in a call.

1. When there is an incoming call, press [SEND] to enter into Answer mode.(select "Reject" to reject the incoming call)
2. Press [Menu], it has 'Drop & Answer / Hold & Answer/ Reject' menus.  
Select 'Hold & Answer', the screen will display both 'In call' and 'Held call'.
3. Press [Menu], then Select "Join".
4. The phone displays active call indicator with the new active call.

### V. Hold & Switch

Switches between the active call and the held call.

1. When there is an incoming call, press [SEND] to enter into Answer mode.

## Basic Function

(If you selects 'Reject', the call will be rejected and the phone will return to Idle mode.)

2. Press [Menu] to display 'Drop & Answer / Hold & Answer / Reject' menus.  
Select 'Hold & Answer', then the screen displays both 'Active call' and 'Held call'.
3. Press "Switch" to switch between the active call and the held call..

### Ø Reject Waiting Call

You can reject an incoming call by pressing "Reject".

- During a call, press "Reject" to display the pop-up menu.
- Move to the desired item and press [OK].

### VI. Split

Allow you to talk privately with one of the persons in a conference call.

1. During a conference call, select "Menu".
2. Press "Navigation key" to move to the desired call, then press [OK].

Ø To end a connected or held call etc.. press right softkey to select 'End a call' option.

For ending a call, press [Menu] to select the desired item, then press [OK].

Ø It has "End on call / End held call / End all call" options.

## Basic Function

### Sub LCD

When there is a new message or an incoming call, you can see caller number on sub LCD.  
When the flip is closed, press the side key to turn the sub lcd light on.  
After backlight is turned on, press upper or lower volume key to toggle different clock types.




\* Press and hold camera button to enable camera preview through Sub LCD.  
Press camera button again, then picture is taken.

## Basic Function

### Quick access in Idle mode

In Idle mode, you can access designated menu by pressing designated navigation key.



### Storing a number

You can store phone numbers in your phone or SIM card. It is possible to store up to 300 phone number entries in your phone book.

\* The total number of entries in your SIM card are dependent on your SIM card capability.

1. Enter a number in idle mode

2. Select [Save]

3. Select [SIM] or [Phone]

4. Press [Save]

5. Enter content and then press [Save]

Also, you can store phone numbers through the 'New entry' of "Phone book" or "Call logs" .

### Selecting main menu item

Press 'Main'

You may select the following 9 menus with navigation keys:

<b>1. Phone book</b>	<b>4. Setting</b>	<b>7. Entertainment</b>
<b>2. Call logs</b>	<b>5. Data folder</b>	<b>8. Utilities</b>
<b>3. Camera</b>	<b>6. Scheduler</b>	<b>9. STK</b>

You may also select the desired menu by pressing the corresponding number of the desired menu.

Once you select the menu, then press [OK] key.

## Phone Book

### Phone book

You can store phone numbers and names in the memory of your SIM card or your phone.

You can store up to 300 numbers in your phone.

SIM card memory size depends on your SIM card capability.

#### I. Access to Phone book

1. By scrolling
  - (1) Press [Main].
  - (2) Scroll to [1.Phone book] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (Or press digit 1 )
2. By shortcut
 

Press the [Right side navigation key] in idle mode.

#### II. Storing Number

1. Through the Phone book menu
  - (1) Press [Main].
  - (2) Scroll to [1.Phone book] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (Or press digit 1 )
  - (3) Enter the [1.Phone book] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (Or press digit 1 )
  - (4) Press [Menu]. then select [1.New Entry].
  - (5) Please select your storage memory, either SIM or Phone
  - (6) Enter contents and then press [Save].

#### 2. Through the idle mode

- (1) Enter a number in idle mode.
- (2) Press [Save].
- (3) Select an icon.
- (4) Enter contents and then press [Save].

### Ø Phone book Edit Details

- 1.Name: Enter the name
2. Location: Enter the location
3. Avatar / Picture: Change Avatar or Picture
4. Number(Home/Cellular/Office/Other):
 

Enter the contact numbers
5. E-mail: Enter e-mail address
6. Group: Select the group type
7. Bell: Select the desired ring tone when there is an incoming call

\*For reference..

In case of phone stored over 250 phone numbers, your phone requires a little time during loading information of phone memory

8. Indicator: Select the incoming call light
9. Anniversary: Enter the anniversary date (e.g. birthday, wedding anniversary. etc.)

**iØ About Phone book ' Menu'**

(The 'left soft key' menu includes the following options)

1. New entry: Add new entry
2. Send a MSG : Move to "New Message" part
3. Send a MMS: Move to "MMS Message" part
4. Copy to SIM (or Phone): Allow you to copy the selected item to another location. (SIM card or Phone)
5. Delete: Delete the selected item
6. Delete all: Delete all entry which is displayed in the selected group
7. Find by name: Allow you to the entry or the item by name
8. Find by number: Allow you to the entry or the item by number

**Group edit**

You can arrange names and phone numbers saved in the phone book into groups.

For each group, you can set the specific ring tone when receiving a call. Basically, 7groups are provided. 4 groups of them (General, Family, Work, Friend) have fixed group names while the group names of the other 3 groups can be changed.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [1.Phone book] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 1 )
3. Scroll to [2.Group edit] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 2 )
4. Select the desired group and press [Edit].

(1) If 'Rename' select : It will be able to change the name of group.(It is not indicated in case of General, Family, Friend and Work)

(2) If 'Group bell' select : It will be able to change the ring tone of the group.

**Turbo set**

Once you have stored phone numbers in the SIM card or Phonebook, you can easily dial them without having to remember the numbers. You can set your SIM or Phone as the default location for using turbo dial.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [1.Phone book] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 1 )
3. Scroll to [3.Turbo Set] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 3 )
4. Select [SIM] or [Phone]
  - (1)For memory location 001~009 :  
Press and hold the last digit.
  - (2)For memory location 010~300 :  
Press the first and/or second digit(s) and hold down the last digit.

**Memory status**

You can check the status of SIM card and phone book memory. If memory full appears, you cannot save any more numbers until you have deleted an item.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [1.Phone book] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 1 )
3. Scroll to [4.Memory status] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 4 )

**My number**

Phone numbers saved in your SIM card are kept in My Number if it is allowed by your SIM card. Scroll to the desired name or number, and press [OK].

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [1.Phone book] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 1 )
3. Scroll to [5. My number] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 5 )

**My profile**

You can enter your personal information in My profile.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [1.Phone book] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 1 )
3. Scroll to [6. My profile] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 6 )

**\* My Profile Details**

1. Name : Enter name
2. Picture / Avatar : Change picture or avatar
3. Job title : Enter job title
4. Address : Enter address
5. Home : Enter home number
6. Cellular : Enter cellular phone number
7. Office : Enter office phone number
8. Other : Enter other number
9. E-mail : Enter e-mail address
10. Birthday : Enter birthday

**Call logs**

You can check the record of missed, answered and dialed calls only if the network supports CLI(Calling Line Identification) within the service area. In the Idle mode, you can access the this menu by pressing [SEND]key then call list will appears.

**Dialed calls**

This menu lets you view the last 30 dialed call numbers. In the idle mode, press [SEND]key then dialed call list will appears. Time and date when the call was answered are displayed with the name and number.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [2.Call logs] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 2 )
3. Scroll to [1.Dialed call] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 1 )

**Answered calls**

This menu lets you view the last 30 answered call numbers. Time and date when the call was answered are displayed with the name and number.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [2.Call logs] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 2 )
3. Scroll to [2.Answered call] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 2 )

**Missed calls**

This menu lets you view the last 30 missed call numbers. Time and date when the call was answered are displayed with the name and number.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [2.Call logs] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 2 )
3. Scroll to [3.Missed call] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 3 )

*Ø* You may also choose the following options when 'Menu' (Left softkey) is pressed in the call logs menu.  
1. Save: It stores the selected number.  
2. Delete: It deletes the selected item after confirmation.  
3. Delete All: It deletes the entire Dialed call list after confirmation.

**Call time**

It displays the total call time starting from using the phone and the last call time.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [2.Call logs] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 2 )
3. Scroll to [4. Call time] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 4 )

- Total call time : It shows the cumulative call time.  
- Last call time : It shows the duration of last incoming call or outgoing call in hours,minutes and seconds.

\* Pressing "Reset" will reset all the call timers.

# Camera

You can take pictures and send them to other people via MMS or e-mail attachment.

You can also use a picture as background image, or save it together with a contact in phone book so that the picture appears when that person calls. Pictures can be saved in JPEG format.

## Access to preview mode

### 1. By scrolling

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [3.Camera] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (Or press digit 3 )
3. Scroll to [1.Shooting] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (Or press digit 1 )
4. Scroll to [1.Photo shot] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (Or press digit 1 )

### 2. By shortcut

1. Press [3.Camera] key in idle mode when the flip is opened.
2. Press and hold [External Camera] key when the flip closed.

**i** Press and hold camera button to enable camera preview through Sub LCD.  
Press camera button again, then picture is taken.

## Shooting

In this menu, you can take pictures and record a video clip.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [3.Camera] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 3 )
3. Scroll to [1.Shooting] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 1 )
4. Scroll to desire item, then press [OK].

### 1. Photo Shot

This feature enables you to take a picture and save it.

#### **i** About 'Menu'

When the camera is activated, press [Menu] for the following options.

1. Set Flash : You can set the flash status.

**[** On : Turn on the flash.

**[** Off : Turn off the flash.

**[** Auto : The flash is set on or off according to light sensor. Even though when the flip is closed, camera flash can still operate.

#### **i** Light sensor :

You can specify the time for which the backlight is to be used. This feature helps to reduce the battery power consumption.

## Main Menu

2. Self timer : When you take a self-portrait, it automatically takes a photo after specified time.  
Camera operates automatically.  
"5 sec / 7 sec / 9 sec / 12 sec / 15sec"
3. Mode: Change the mode.  
"Auto / Sunny / Cloudy / Fluorescent / Tungsten"
4. Size: Select the image resolution.  
"Resolution: 64x96, 160x120, 176x144, 320x240, 640x480"
5. Quality: Select image quality.  
"High / Mid / Low"

### Ø Taking a photo using Sub LCD

1. During preview mode, press [Sub] then sub LCD will be in active mode.(The main LCD light will go out.)  
Press [External Camera] key to take a picture.
2. When the flip is closed, press and hold [External Camera], then sub LCD operates.  
Press [External Camera] to take a picture.  
Press [External Camera] again to save a picture.

### 2. Serial Shot

This feature enables you to take serial shots.

### Ø About 'Menu'

When the camera is activated, press [Menu] for the following options

1. Serial Count: Select the number of serial shot.  
"3 times / 5 times / 7 times / 9 times" Camera operates automatically.

## Main Menu

2. Self Timer: When you take a self-portrait, it automatically takes a photo after specified time. Camera operates automatically. "5 sec / 7 sec / 9 sec / 12 sec / 15 sec"
3. Mode : Change the mode.  
"Auto / Sunny / Cloudy / Fluorescent / Tungsten"
4. Size: Select the image resolution.  
"Resolution : 64x96, 160x120, 176x144, 320x240, 640x480"
5. Quality : Select the image quality. "High / Mid / Low"

Ø Frame function is not supported during serial shot

### 3. Video Shot

You can store moving picture up to 10 seconds.  
Default record resolution is preset to "160x120".

### Ø About 'Menu'

When the camera is activated, press [Menu] for the following options

1. Self Timer : When you take a self-portrait, you can select the shooting time and the camera will operate automatically.  
"5 sec / 7 sec / 9 sec / 12 sec / 15 sec"
2. Mode : Change the mode.  
"Auto / Sunny / Cloudy / Fluorescent / Tungsten"
3. Size: Select the image resolution.  
"Resolution : 64x96, 120x160, 176x144"
4. Quality: Select the image quality.  
"High / Mid / Low"

Ø Frame function is not supported during video shot

## Main Menu

### Ø Details on preview mode

Moving each item using a left/right navigation key, then pressing upper/lower navigation key to adjust.

1. Zoom: It adjusts zoom level by using upper/lower navigation key.  
Upper key : Zoom in.  
Lower key : Zoom out
2. Brightness: Adjust brightness level by using upper/lower navigation key.  
Upper key : It makes the display more brighter.  
Lower key : It makes the display more darker.
3. Effect: Select different effects.
4. Frame: Change the frame of the image.

## Album

This feature enables you to manage your photos and images.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [3.Camera] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 3 )
3. Scroll to [2.Album] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 2 )
4. Scroll to desire item, then press [OK]

### 1. Photo Album

You can review or delete stored photos. You can also change the photo name.

## Main Menu

### Ø About photo album 'Menu'

1. Large view : It shows photos as large images.  
Album view : It shows photos as thumbnail images.  
In this mode, use upper/lower navigation key to scroll through the photos .
2. List view : It goes back to list mode.  
(This menu only appears in the photo view status)
3. Send a MMS : It sends a photo as a MMS to other people.
4. Save to idle : It sets a photo as idle screen.
5. Photo editor : It sends the selected photo to Photo editor to edit picture.
6. Rename : You can change the name of the photo.
7. Delete : It deletes the selected photo.
8. Delete all : It deletes all of the photos saved in the phone.
9. Information : It shows the information of stored photo about file name, format, size, etc.

### 2. Video Album

You can review, delete and change the filename of the stored video files.

### Ø About video album 'Menu'

1. Send a MMS: It sends the video file as MMS to other people.
2. Rename: You can change the name of the file.
3. Delete: It deletes the video file.
4. Delete all: It deletes all the video files saved in the phone.
5. Information: It shows the information of stored video files such as file name,format, size, etc.

**Photo editor**

You can make various effects for the stored or new photos. When you enter into photo editor, menu bar is in active state while toolbar is inactive state.

**Details of Photo editor**

"Normal / Mono / Sepia / Moon / Fog / Negative"
7. Text : It enters text on the picture

\*\* The 1~4 menu appears horizontally on the upper portion and the 5~7 menu appears vertically on the left side

**Setting**

You can choose to adjust various phone settings, shutter sound, image quality and size, etc. to suit your own requirements.

You can set the flash status.

**6. Display mode**

You can select the display mode.

If 'On' is selected, it will display the photo information with icon on the photo screen.

If 'Off' is selected, it will not display the photo information with icon on the photo screen.

**7. Lock album**

This feature enables you to lock the album. If you want to show the album in lock mode, you have to enter the password.

**Memory**

You can check how much space is left. If memory full appears, you cannot save any more pictures until you have deleted an item from the phone memory.

#### 3. Send key answer: Only answer the incoming call by pressing [SEND].

### 6. Auto redial

If you fail to connect a call, the phone will attempt to connect it again.

### 7. Data mode

It allows user to enable or disable the date mode.

### 8. GPRS set

It enables you to set the GPRS network.

1. Auto : It searches GPRS network automatically anywhere.
2. Manual : It searches GPRS network in the place where GPRS network is existed.

### Security set

This feature locks your phone to prevent an unauthorized person from using it.

#### 1. Press [Main].

2. Scroll to [4.Settings] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 4 )

3. Scroll to [4.Security set] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit4 )

4. Scroll to the desired item, then press [OK].

#### 1. Phone lock

This feature enables you to prevent an unauthorized person from using your phone. When the phone is in lock status, you have to enter the 4-digit phone password. The password is set to '0000' by default.

To change the phone password, refer to the 'Change PWD' menu option.

(1) Lock Now : After entering the correct security code, the phone will lock after going into the idle state. If you want to disable this phone lock, you should enter the right security code. If you power off in the phone lock state, when the phone is next powered on, the phone is the lock state.

This feature formats the file system and deletes all the saved data such as phone book entries, call history list, etc.

\* If you enter the password incorrectly, 'Invalid password' will appear. You should try again to enter the correct one. If the correct password is entered, the phone will display 'Waiting...' message and the master clear operation is in progress. After the master clear operation has finished, the phone will be restarted.

**5. Change PWD**

This feature enables you to change the current phone password to be a new one. You have to enter the current password before entering a new one.

Ø The default password is set to "0000"

**6. FDN (Fixed Dial Number) (SIM dependent)**

You can restrict your outgoing calls to selected phone numbers, if this function is supported by your SIM card. You can set the following submenu by PIN2 code. The PIN2 code is required.

Enable : You can restrict your outgoing calls to selected phone number.

Disable : You can call without restricting phone number.

**Network set**

Various features are provided for you to set up the network services. Before using the network services, you have to subscribe them through your service provider and obtain user instructions from your service provider.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [4.Settings] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 4 )
3. Scroll to [5.Network set] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit5 )
4. Scroll to the desired item, then press [OK].

**1. Call divert**

You can direct your incoming calls to another number. For details, please contact your service provider.

- Divert Always : All calls are diverted.
- On Busy: Calls are diverted if are currently on another call.
- No Reply: Calls are diverted if you have not answered the call.
- Unreachable : Calls are diverted if are not in an area covered by your service provider.
- Cancel : Call diverting options are cancelled.

**2. Call barring**

This service allows you to restrict outgoing calls and incoming calls.

- All outgoing : All calls cannot be made.
- Int'l Call : International calls cannot be made.
- Int'lExpHome : When you are abroad, calls can be made only to numbers within the current country and to your home country, which is the country where your home network provider is located.
- All Incoming : All calls cannot be received.
- In.At Abroad : Calls cannot be received when you use your phone outside of your home service area.
- Cancel all : All call barring settings are deactivated.
- Change PWD : User can change the call barring password.

**3. Call waiting**

This service enables you to be informed when you receive a second call during an ongoing call.

- Enable : Activating the corresponding service.
- Disable : Deactivating the corresponding service.
- Check status : Checking the status of the service.

**4. Caller ID**

You can prevent your phone number from being displayed on the phone of the person being called.

- Default: The default setting provided by the network is used.
- Hide Number: Your number will not be displayed on the other person's phone. (network dependent)
- Send Number: Your number is sent each time when you make a call.

**5. Network setup**

- Select Mode : User can select available network.  
(Auto select / Manual select)  
Please be careful that the phone may not operate properly if you change the network set up.
- Preferred NET (Preferred network)
  - 1. Add  Add from available : Add preferred network from available network.
  - Add from known : Add preferred Network from known network.
- 2. Display : It shows the network which it prefers
- Known NET (Known network)  
You can select a network in the known network lists.

**Net account**

You can save the network settings in Net account in order for you to access the WAP and MMS services. Some settings are not mandatory. Please consult your network operator or service provider for more information.

After inserting your SIM card into your phone, your phone will automatically detect and assign the corresponding network settings into your phone according to your SIM Card. If your network operator is not on the list of Net Account, please enter or modify the settings of WAP and MMS according to the following.

2. Homepage: Input a URL. It is different for each service provider.
3. Gateway: Gateway address in "xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx" format.

3. Scroll to [1.Download] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 1 )
4. Scroll to the desired item, then press [OK].

**1. Image**

This folder is used to store the image contents that you have received or downloaded through the WAP browser.

**2. Sound**

This folder is used to store the sound contents that you received or downloaded through the WAP browser.

**3. Others**

This folder is used to store the other contents that you have received or downloaded through the WAP browser.

**Photo**

This folder is used to store the photos that you have taken using a camera.

1. Press [Main].
2. Scroll to [5.Data folder] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 5 )
3. Scroll to [2.Photo] using upper/lower navigation key, then press [OK]. (or press digit 2 )

This folder is used to store the video files that you have taken using a camera.

## Battery

**About the battery**

The battery pack is not fully charged when purchased. Fully charge it for 8 hours the first time before using. Use only batteries approved by the phone manufacturer. Recharge battery only with the charger approved by the manufacturer. Unplug the charger when not in use.

Also do not leave the battery in microwave, pressure pot.  
If the battery is heated in the closed space, it may cause fire, smoke or broken. Always try to keep the battery between -10~55°C
- Do not shock to battery extremely.  
It is very dangerous to disassemble a battery or to give a strong shock to the battery with the nail or the hammer.
- Keep the battery away from babies or pets.



### Troubleshooting

Check these questions first if you experience problems with your phone :

**Q : I press the Power / End key, but nothing happened.**

A : Be sure to press and hold [END] (the END/Power key) until the display appears. You will hear an audible alert. If nothing happens, check the battery pack.

**Q : The display says "Insert SIM Card" or "Check SIM Card" even though I have inserted my SIM card in the phone.**

A : The SIM card may be incorrectly inserted. Check the SIM card to make sure that it is inserted properly. Be sure to turn your phone off and turn it on again after your re-insert the SIM card.

**Q : The display says "Locked." . How do I unlock my phone?**

A : Try entering the 4 digit lock code 0000.

**Q : The display says "SIM Blocked". How do I unblock my SIM card?**

A : Call your service provider to obtain the PIN unblocking key(PUK) code.

**Q : My phone does not ring.**

A : If you see "Silent / Vibrator icon" in the display, then the ringer is turned off. Also, the ringer may be set to "Silent" even though your phone is set to a ring alert profile.

**Q : I cannot send/receive calls.**

A : Make sure that you have a phone network signal. Avoid electrical or radio interference, and obstructions such as bridges, parking garages, or tall buildings. Your phone also may have the "Call Barring" feature turned on. If you know the password, you can change this setting in the network setup menu. Also check and make sure your SIM card is installed and working properly.

**Q : My battery didn't last as long as I expected.**

**What can I do to extend battery life?**

A : Your battery's performance is affected by charging frequency, feature use, temperature changes and other factors.

**Q : I tried to place a call and heard an alternating high/low tone.**

A : Your call did not reach the wireless system.

You may have dialed the number too soon after turning the phone on. Wait until the display shows the name of your service provider before making a call.
