Gentlemen:

1. We, E-TECH Co., Ltd., requires the Part 90 FCC grant list frequencies outside of Part 90 assignments because state and local government users specify operation outside of Part 90 so that they can interoperate with Federal agencies. The issue being that user's that are not under NTIA frequency coordination must use radios that have FCC approval.
2. This UHF transceiver that operated using frequency modulation(FM) incorporating traditional simplex transmission protocol (50%) duty and may be marketed to and used by employees for occupational operations, such as Federal and Public Safety agencies, e.g. police, fire and emergency medical, etc.
