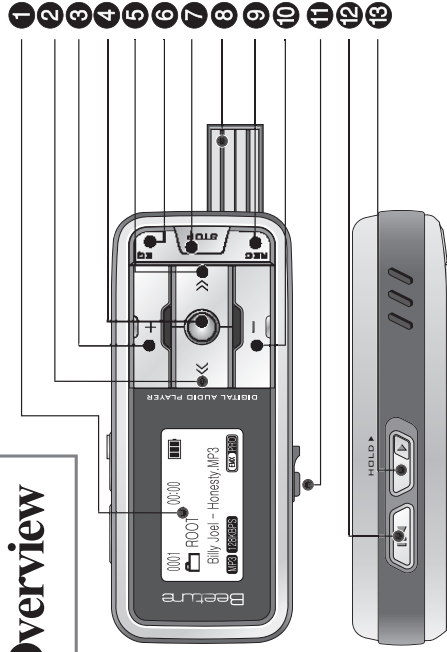

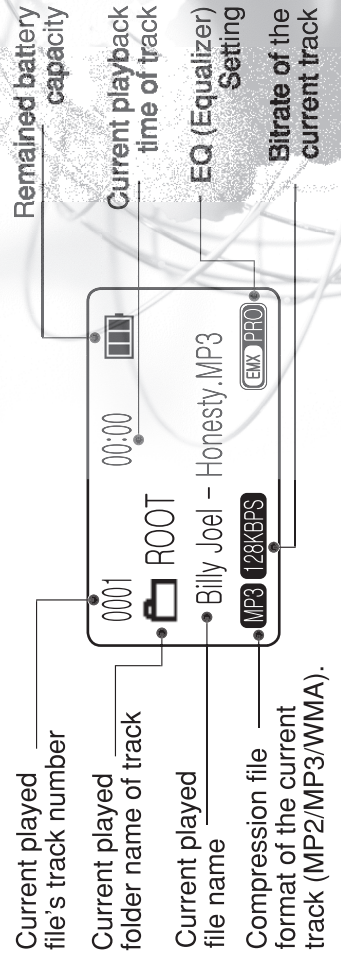

Play Music Mode

How to listen to the music

- Press 'PLAY/ PAUSE' Button for an extended period of time (typically 2 seconds).

How to stop the music

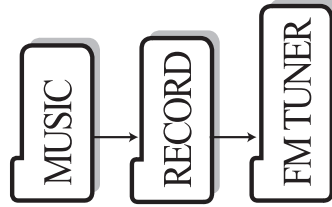
- Press 'STOP' Button shortly.

How to volume up or volume down

- Press '+' or '-' Button to volume up or down shortly during playback.

How to change Mode

1. Press 'REC' Button for an extended period of time (typically 2 seconds).
2. Press 'NAVI/MODE' Button after selecting desired Mode by pressing << , >> Button.



Recording

Voice Recording

1. Press REC Button for an extended period of time (typically 2 seconds).
2. Move 'RECORD' Mode by using << , >> Button.
3. Press 'NAVI/MENU' Button shortly. And then, player is ready to record.
4. Finally, press 'REC' Button to start record.

Line-In Recording

1. Connect the Line-In cable with the output port (earphone port of external equipment) and the Line-In port of the player.
2. Press REC Button for an extended period of time (typically 2 seconds).
3. Move 'RECORD' Mode by using << , >> Button.
4. Press 'NAVI/MENU' Button shortly. Then, player is ready to record.
5. And, press 'REC' Button finally to start record.

How to pause the recording

- Press 'REC' Button shortly during playback.

How to stop the recording

- Press 'STOP' Button shortly during playback.

How to listen to the recorded file

- Press 'PLAY/PAUSE' Button shortly.

FM Radio

1. Press REC Button for an extended period of time (typically 2 seconds).
2. Move 'FM Tuner' Mode by using << , >> Button.
3. Press 'NAVI/MENU' Button shortly.

How to change the FM Radio Mode

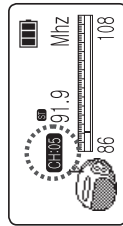
('PRESET'? 'FREQUENCY')

- Users can select 'PRESET' Mode or 'FREQUENCY' Mode by pressing 'STOP' Button consecutively.

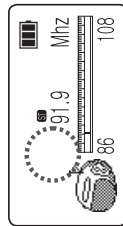
How to change the FM Radio Frequency

- Users can change the CHANNEL or FREQUENCY by pressing << , >> Button.

Auto FREQUENCY Search

1. Press << , >> Button for an extended period of time after selecting 'FREQUENCY' Mode by pressing 'STOP' Button.
2. If available radio frequency is caught during this Auto FREQUENCY Search, once it will stop searching the other available radio frequencies.

Frequency Save

The Frequency Save is the function used for listening to the music easily via channel which is set up previously.

[Manual Frequency Save]

1. Select FREQUENCY Mode by pressing 'STOP' Button.
2. And, select desired channel to save by pressing << , >> Button.
3. Desired channels are saved next previous saved channel in sequence when pressed EQ Button.

[Auto Frequency Save]

1. Select FREQUENCY Mode by pressing 'STOP' Button.
2. The "AUTO MEMORY" is displayed on the player when pressed EQ Button for an extended period of time. And then, each of available Channels are saved to player in sequence.
3. Some channels can not be saved in the place with poor radio reception.

FM Radio Recording

1. Press 'REC' Button to start the recording.
2. Press 'REC' Button again to pause the recording.
3. Press 'REC' Button to release pause status and restart the recording.
4. The recorded file is automatically created/saved from 'F001.WAV' or 'F001.MP3' in the 'FM' folder.
