

## 2. Connecting USB Jack

### Connecting USB Jack (USB Cable)



- 1. Press the green button of CYPOSE's back side and Push it out. And the built-in USB jack appears.
- 2. Connect the USB jack to the USB port of your computer. (Or You can use USB cable(provided).)
- 3. "Connection icon" will appear on the LCD of CYPOSE.



[PC <-> CYPOSE Connection]

❖ When downloading the file, "Don't remove USB" displays on the LCD and backlight turns on.

[Caution !!] When downloading the file, do not remove the USB jack of the player from the PC




When download complete, "Don't remove USB" disappears on the LCD and the backlight turns off.

❖ For Windows XP, it is ok to disconnect the USB jack after the transfer window is closed. For Windows 2000, however, you should run 'Safety Remove Hardware' before disconnecting USB jack.


Music Player Mode consists of 'Music File Player' playing the music file and 'Playlist Player'. Playlist Player is the function you can specify your preferred music to playback.

- 1. Press the MODE Key.
- 2. Select the Music Player Mode
- 3. Press the Jog Switch after selecting either 'Music File Player' or 'Playlist' mode.








❖ Music File Player Screen









- Deleting file and folder
  - 1. Select the file you want to delete.
  - 2. Press and hold the MODE key.
  - 3. Select 'YES' using the Jog Switch and Press the Jog Switch

- ❖ Block Repetition: Use the 'REC' key during playback.
- 1.Press the 'REC' key shortly at the beginning position of the block you want be repeated. (A-)
- 2. Then press the key again at the ending position of the repeat block. (A-B)
- 3. Press the key again to release this function.



❖ Bookmark Function: Use the 'POWER' Key during playback.

If you press the POWER key at the position of the tracks that you want bookmark, that position is bookmarked.

You can move to the bookmarked position by pressing the Jog Switch to the left/right direction.





### To add to playlist




- 1.Select "< Add File >" using the Jog Switch and press the Jog Switch or press it to ▶ direction.
- 2. When the navigation screen appears, Select the file you want using the Jog Switch
- 3. Press the Jog Switch or press it to





Voice Recording (Recording voice with the built-in microphone)




- Do not connect anything to Line-in jack.
- Enter the 'Recording Mode' using the Jog Switch.
- 3 When you press the 'Jog Switch' or 'REC' key, Recording starts.
- Press the key again to stop the recording.

  Then the file is recording in the preset recording quality as the file name VOC-NNN.MP3 in the REC folder.

## 4. Recording Mode Usage

### Line-In Recording (Direct Encoding)



Line-In Recording is the function recording the audio signal from the audio device or PC

- 1. Connect the headphone jack of the CDP and the Line-in jack of the CYPOSE with two-way stereo cable.
- 2. Enter the 'Recoding Mode'. (Automatically recording source is changed VOC to LINE.)
- 3. When you press the 'Jog Switch' or 'REC' key, line-in recording starts.
- 4. Press the key again to stop the recording.

  Then the file is recording in the preset recording quality as the file name Line NNN.MP3 in the REC folder.
- \* Line-In Recording provides the CD-Sync function.




This is the feature to automatically detect the sound input from the Line-in jack and recognize blanks between tracks to save the tracks separately as individual files.

Select the 'FM Radio Mode' after pressing the 'MODE' key.




When you select the searching screen, the text file appears in the whole screen.(4 line supports)

#### [Stopwatch Screen]



- The screen of stopwatch shows a timer at the top of the right.
- It can indicate 1/100 seconds and up to 99hour 59minitues 59 seconds and 99.
- Lap times also appear at the bottom of the screen
   3 Lap times appear at once; it shows the Lap time up to 99th.


#### **Key Operation**

- Stopwatch is controlled by two keys
- REC has the functions of a timer, stop and initiation
- Press MODE key, then Lap time will be recorded


#### Note

- 1. Only when stopwatch action is stopped by REC key, you can escape from the stopwatch screen by pressing the Jog switch to the left direction.

#### Setting up Backlight Color





#### How to install the latest Firmware

- Enter menu Mode by pressing the Jog Switch longer
- 2 Select 'FW upgrade' menu by pressing the Jog Switch upward/downward
- 3 When the message of "Disconnect" appears on the player screen, connect USB jack into PC
- When The screen is changed into the message "Connect", execute the program of Firmware upgrade.
- 5 After selecting Firmware file through program, press the button of Firmware download
- 6 Progress bar is moving up to 100% and completed, remove USB jack from PC
- After taking out a battery and put it again, press power key long to turn on.
