Re #1: The modified block diagram is uploaded.

Re #2: Horizontal Frquency at 1600 x 1200, 75 Hz is about 94 kHz, and 1280 x 1024, 85 Hz is about 91 kHz. This LCD monitor supports the resolution to 95 kHz. But the manufacturer would like to show the optimized resolution to the end users. Then the maximum supported resolution is 1280 x 1024, 85 Hz. As a research engineer, we think that the measurement must be performed at the worst case. Therefore we measured the radiated emission at 1600 x 1200, 75 Hz.
