The purpose of this letter is to request a Class II Permissive change for FCC ID: RAS-MT7925B22M, granted on 09/28/2023. The major change field under this application is:

- 1. The subject approved module is being used in a portable configuration- a Notebook PC (Brand name/Model: RAZER/ RZ09-0530), the distance between antenna and human body is 0mm. SAR testing was performed to demonstrate RF compliance. Because the antenna gain is lower than that of the module, RF testing was also performed to demonstrate RF compliance.
- 2. The difference compared with the original module design is antenna change. Two groups antennas are used for the subject approved module in the Notebook PC as below listed.
