Question #2: The user manual indicated that the frequency band is 2400-2497MHz ISM band, please note 2483.5-2500MHz is a restricted band as specified in 15.205, no device can be allowed to operate in that band. Please revise the user manual

Question #3: Please update the user manual to indicate channels and operating frequencies that will be allowed to operate in US.

Question #4: The User manual indicated that the device uses indoor omni-directional antenna for 2,5dBi, however the antenna specification and the test report both indicated that a max. 2.4dBi antenna is used. Please clarity which one is correct, and update the document accordingly.

Question #5: The user manual indicated that the power required is 12V/1.25A, but the test report indicated that the device is power from AC/DC adaptor (20A/8A/160W). Please clarify which one is correct, and update the document accordingly.
