Battery Installation

ZX-34 Battery Installation
ZX-34 requires 4x AA Alkaline batteries (NOT Included). To install and change batteries, open the battery door (battery door is located on the rear side of ZX-34) with a Phillips head screw driver. Position the batteries as shown above. When the batteries are positioned correctly, close the battery door and tighten the screw with a Phillips head screw driver (not included).

Battery Installation

ZX-34 Z-mote Battery Installation
The Z-mote requires 1x 9V battery (NOT included). To install and change batteries, open the battery door (battery door is located on the bottom side of the Z-mote) with a Phillips head screw driver. Position the batteries as shown above. When the batteries are positioned correctly, close the battery door and tighten the screw with a Phillips head screw driver (not included).

Controller Button Breakdown

BASIC CONTROLLER DIRECTIONS
Push the power switches to ON on the Z-mote and the ZX-34. Point the Z-mote towards ZX-34 and push both CONTROL STICKS forward and backward to make ZX-34 go forward and backward. Make sure to push both CONTROL STICKS at the same time to go in a straight line. Move the CONTROL STICKS in opposite directions to turn. See the "POWER ORB PICK-UP" and "SHOOTING POWER ORBS" pages to see how to pick-up and fire POWER ORBS.

DRIVE OVER THE POWER ORBS
Locate your POWER ORBS and drive your ZX-34 over the POWER ORBS, making sure the POWER ORB goes into the PICK-UP PORT. While driving forward, over the POWER ORB, push and hold the LOAD button. Keep holding down the LOAD button until the POWER ORB is fully picked up. ZX-34 holds up to 3 POWER ORBS.

FRONT

CAUTION: Battery Warnings

- An adult should supervise battery installation.
- Take the batteries out of your ZX-34 when you are not going to use it for a long time.
- Don't mix old and new batteries.
- Don't mix alkaline batteries with standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Don't mix different brands or kinds of batteries.
- Use the type and size of batteries recommended in this instruction manual.
- Match the positive and negative ends of the batteries correctly.
- Take dead batteries out of the ZX-34 right away.
- Don't short circuit the supply terminals.
- Don't attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.

Remember: If you use batteries incorrectly you might cause heat generation, acid leakage, or explosion. You might cause an injury or damage your Zibit.

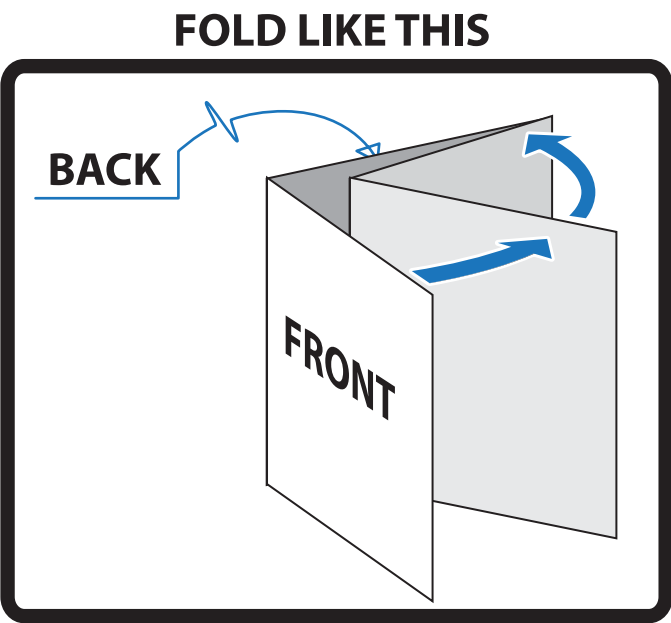
