For the Tune Up information from the applicant, the maximum output power is 11b (12.00dBm) 11g (10.70dBm) 11n HT20 (10.50dBm), 11n HT40 (8.80dBm), so the worst case of Conducted Power and EIRP will be still less than FCC SAR exemption threshold.

Threshold at which no SAR required is 24.37 mw.

Maximum Tx power is 17.66mw EIRP

Conclusion: No SAR is required.
