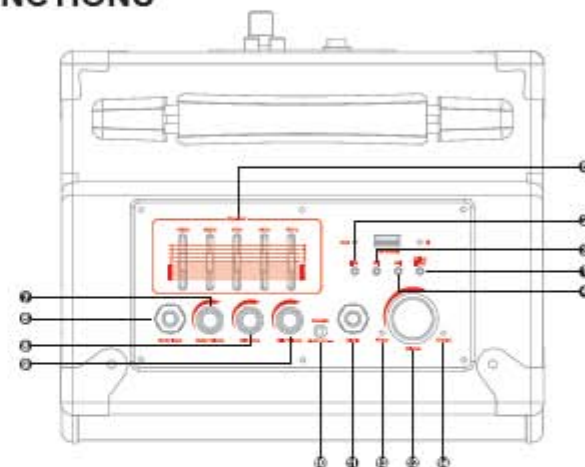
Support Bluetooth, Aux in input. With Li-ion battery inside.

Support AC powered supply. With 12V-30V regulated power output.

When using AC powered or external DC - power supply, the li-ion battery will be automatically charging at the same time.

Inside have protection for Automatic switch, anti - access to prevent the damage to the speaker by misoperation.

BUTTON FUNCTIONS



SELECT INPUT ① : Press to change playing mode – AUX IN, Bluetooth
Under the playing mode of AUX, the AUX LED will light. Under the playing mode of Bluetooth, the Bluetooth LED will be light.

PREV ② : Under the playing mode of Bluetooth, press to previous track.

PLAY/PAUSE ③ : Press to play/pause. Under the playing mode of Bluetooth, Press and HOLD to enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
Under the playing model of AUX, press and HOLD to mute volume. Bluetooth device PBT9010.

NEXT ④ : Under the playing mode of Bluetooth, press to skip to next track.

PANEL SWITCHES AND KNOBS FUNCTION

EQUALIZER ⑤ : The five push-pull type potentiometer is used to adjust the frequency of 100 hz, 500 hz, 1 KHZ, 5 KHZ to 10 KHZ. All push-pull potentiometer default is located in the middle. The speaker

of the frequency response is smooth. The sound is without modification. It also can adjust to their preferences by pushing the potentiometer to adjust the size of the different frequency band.

GUITAR INPUT PORT ⑥ : It is for external electric Guitar for amplification.

GUITAR VOLUME KNOB ⑦ : Adjust the Volume of an electric Guitar.

MIC ECHO KNOB ⑧ : Receiver reverberation depth adjustment.

MIC VOLUME KNOB ⑨ : Microphone Volume adjustment.

MIC PRIORITY SWITCH ⑩ : Microphone priority function switch, play up effective. When inserted into the microphone to the MIC jack, will switch according to the high, in the microphone to sing or talk, Bluetooth or AUX input music signal will automatically become smaller, to highlight the vocals and prevent background music vocal cover. It is useful when meeting or singing.

MIC IN PORT ⑪ : microphone input

VOLUME KNOB ⑫ : volume adjust

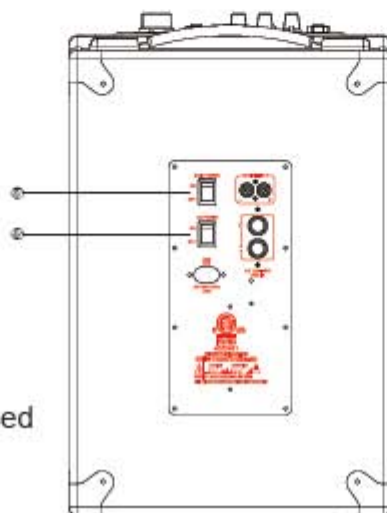
POWER ⑬ : With the POWER indicator light

CHARGE ⑭ : When using the external AC or DC converter, if the battery is not full, it will charge for it automatically. The charging LED will be light.

SWITCHES ON THE BACKSIDE

AC POWER SWITCH ⑮ : This switch is used for external AC switch.

MAIN SWITCH ⑯ : Main power.



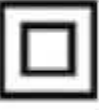
ATTENTION

When open the speaker, EQ default please call center 0 db has card points, according to their own preferences. When the built-in lithium battery voltage is too low, the music will increase the distortion degree. When the battery less than 9v, the speaker will be automatically shut down to protect the battery. Please plug in the AC or DC converter power supply at this time. Normal the charging time is about 4 to 5 hours. The battery is full with the charging light went out.

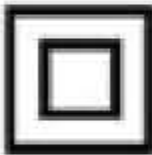
