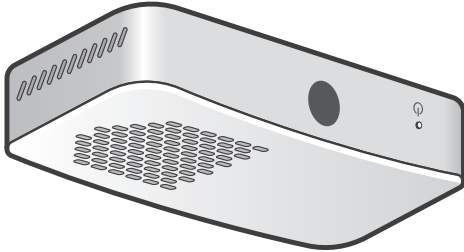

Instructions for the learning function

Learning Keys: TV Mute, TV POWER, TV VOL+, TV VOL-, TV Yellow, TV Green

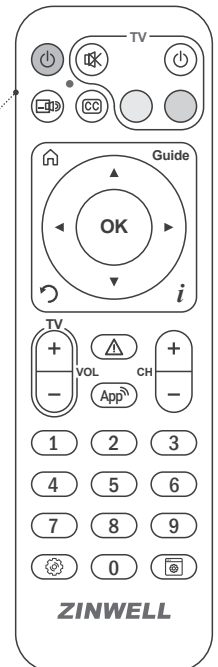
1. Long press the "POWER" button in the TV area for about 3 seconds, and the indicator light will change from off to long on, indicating that it has entered the learning state;
2. Then short press the button that needs to be learned in the learning area, such as power, and the indicator light will change from solid to slow flashing;
3. Aim the transmitting end of the TV remote control to be learned at the transmitting end of the remote control (about 3~5cm), and short press the learned button of the TV remote control. After the signal is learned, the indicator light flashes 3 times quickly and becomes long light state;
4. Repeat steps 2 and steps 3 to learn other keys in the TV area. Press any button outside the learning area to end learning;

Note:

1. During the learning process, if you wait for more than 10 seconds at any time, it will automatically exit the learning state.
2. During the learning process, press any button outside the learning area at any time to exit the learning state directly.
3. The two remote controllers must not shake during learning.

Instruction of the indicators:

1. The indicator flashes when the button is sending code.
2. When entering the learning state, the indicator light is always on.
3. If the learning is successful, the indicator light flashes 3 times.







2.5 Panel Specification



- **1. Antenna port** is to connect the cable from your aerial
- **2. HDMI out port** is to connect the cable from your display
- **3. LAN port** is for Ethernet (RJ45) network or internet access
- **4. USB port** is for peripherals such as thumb drive, storage devices and so on
- **5. DC IN** is to connect the power adapter (12V/1.5A) to provide power to the Broadband Set-Top-Box

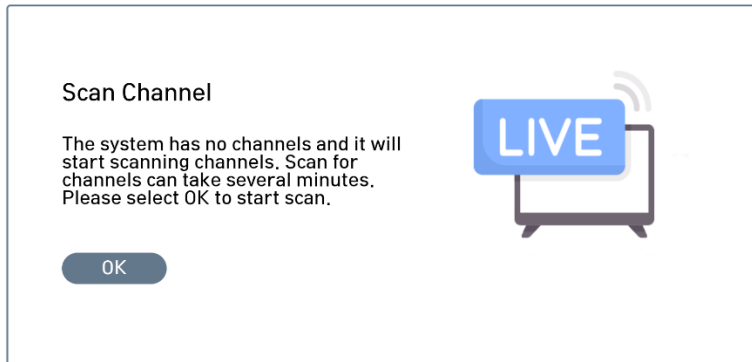
Step 2. Insert your **HDMI cable** from **HD TV** into **HDMI OUT Port**

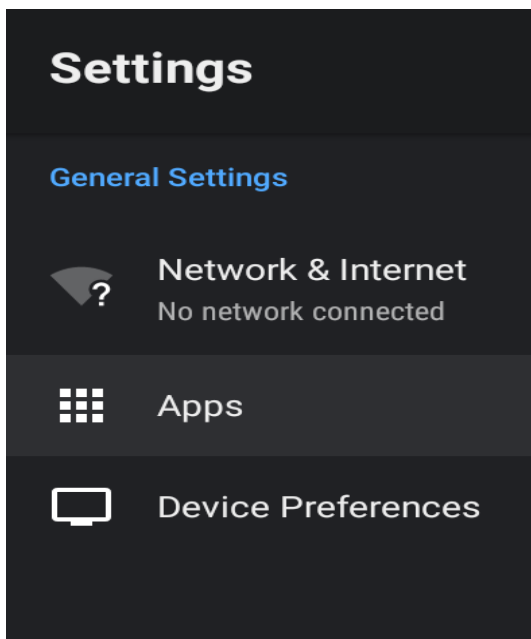
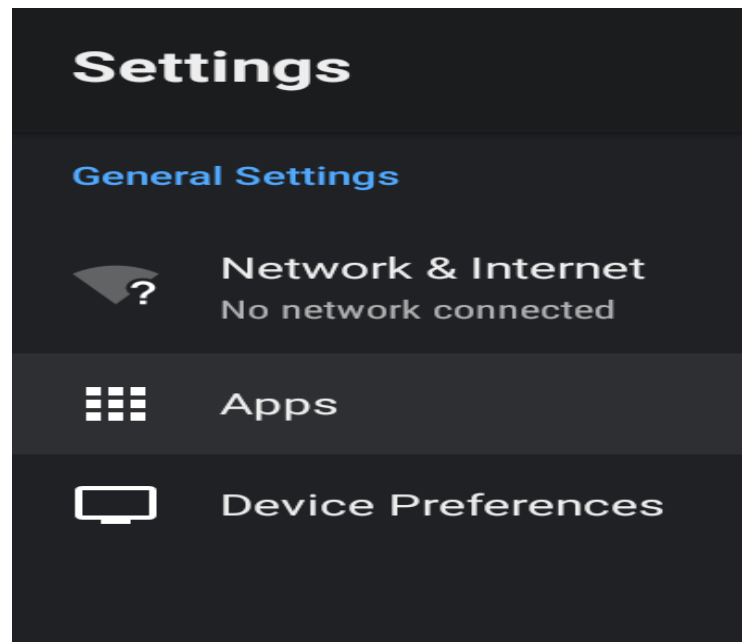
6 (Wi-Fi ON) Connecting to Internet via Your Wi-Fi/AP Router

*Before Reading the Instructions

- The **Wi-Fi** and **Ethernet** functions **CANNOT** be executed **at the same time**. Ensure the Broadband Set-Top-Box is **NOT CONNECTED** to any **Ethernet Cable** before **ENABLING** Wi-Fi function in the Broadband Set-Top-Box.

Turn **ON** the Power of Broadband Set-Top-Box (IF it's the First Time Installation) -> Press the "**SETTING**" button (Android Setting Key) on the remote controller (Refer to the Image on the right side)

(IF Any) Ensure the **Ethernet Cable** is **DISCONNECTED** to the Broadband Set-Top-Box.

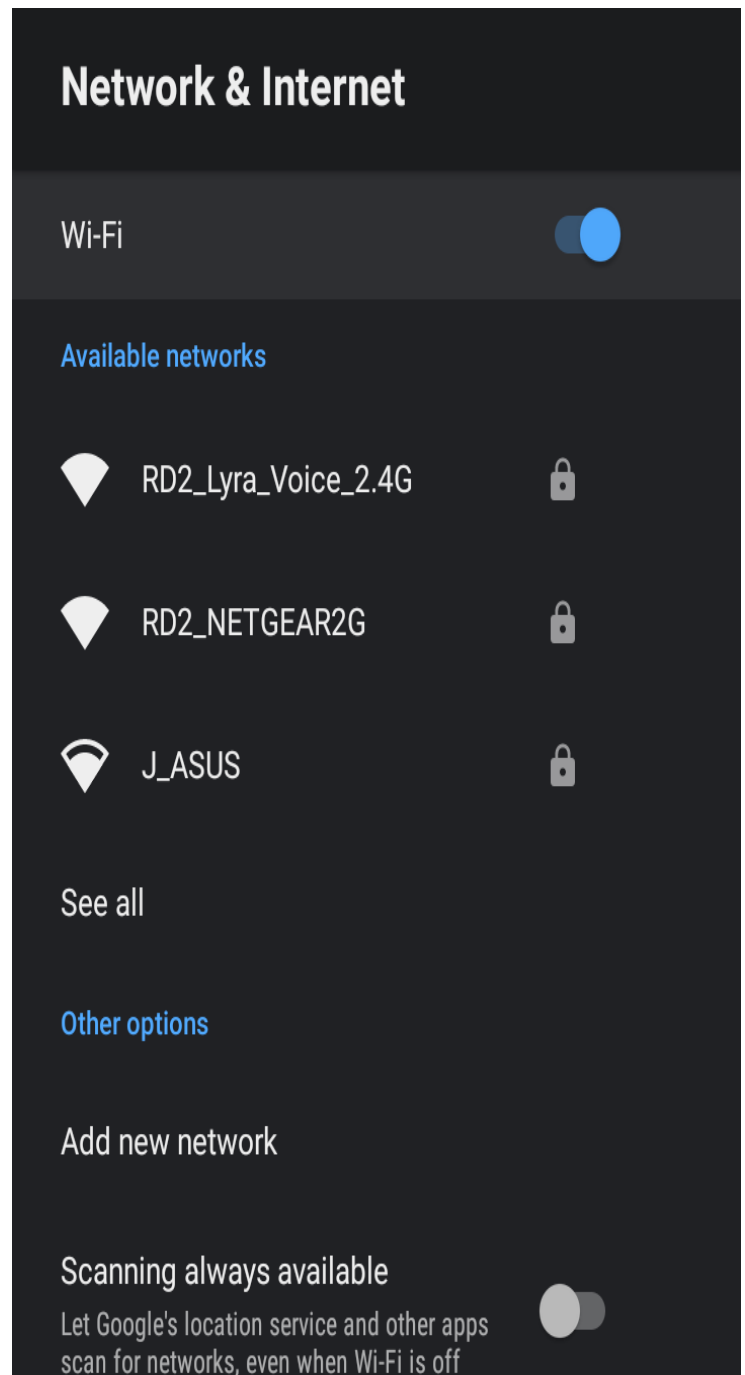


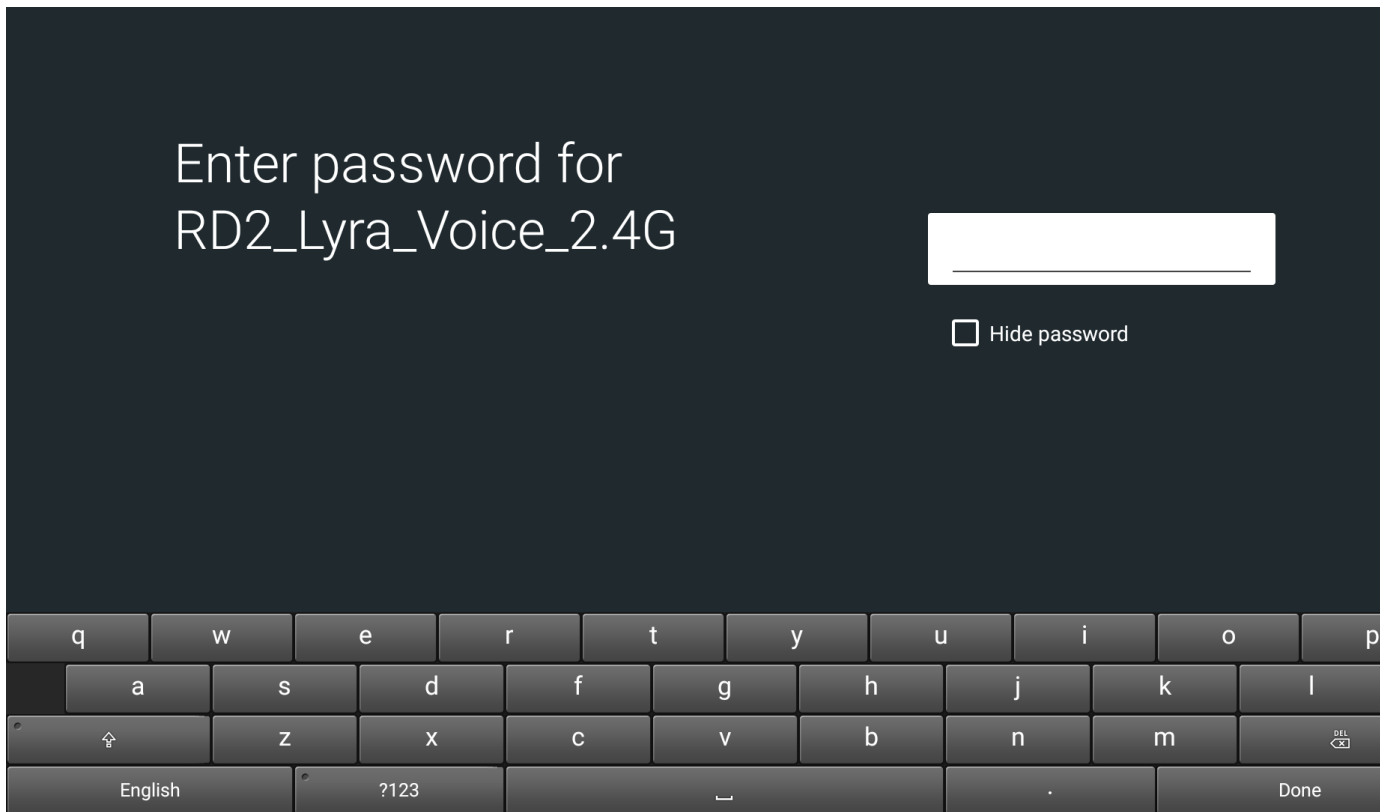

11 Trouble Shooting

Device Failure	Possible Cause	Solution
No Picture	Power is not connected	Connect the power and ensure the device has been turned on.
No Picture but Sound OK	Nil or incorrect video cable connections	Ensure cables are connected correctly.
“No Signal” Appear on the Screen	Antenna cable is not connected	Connect the antenna cable and check the connection to the rear of Broadcast Gateway
Picture is breaking up	Signal is weak and unstable	Check the antenna connection
Remote Control is not responding	Batteries are flat	Replace the batteries. * Do not mix old and new batteries in the IR remote control
USB device is not detected	Not powered correctly	Check the power source (if fitted) or reconnect
