- 2.) Form 731 only shows voice modulation F3E. This is an incomplete emission designator. We must have it in a the form which includes the necessary bandwidth [i.e: 16K0F3E]. In addition, the Manual per page 4 indicates this device can also transmit data. Please provide an appropriate emission designator for data transmission.
- 3.) A Tune Up procedure is required for all Licensed transmitter submissions.
- 4.) The label and location exhibit indicates the label will be attached to the face of the EUT with adhesive. Please note the label must be permanently attached. Kindly indicate the method for insuring this label will be permanent.
- 5.) There are several documents which are identified as Confidential at the AmericanTCB.com website that are not identified in the Confidentiality Request letter. Please resolve this discrepancy.
- 6.) Please provide an RF Exposure estimation exhibit.
- 7.) Please note that additional information may be requested upon receipt if the Test Report.
