- 3.) For Section 9, "Field Strength of Spurious Emissions", the FCC accepted methodology for measuring transmitter radiated spurious is to use the substitution method described in TIA/EIA 603. Please review this document and provide revised information.
- 4.) Please provide RF Exposure Information using the antennas selected for this product.
- 5.) Please provide an installation manual or installation instructions for this product.
- 6.) Please provide information required under 2.1033(c)(6), (7) and (8).
- 7.) Please confirm that no digital intelligence or digital data will be transmitted by this device.
