### **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. **Turning the Unit On or Off**  
Press the red switch on the receiver. In "on" position, a red LED light for power is lit, and a yellow LED light is also lit indicating the unit is cleared and ready to play.
2. **To Buzz in During Play**  
Each player will have a transmitter to hold. The transmitter will be numbered on the back and correspond to a like number on the hand held receiver (players names can be written on the receiver with a wipe off marker next to their number on the receiver). By pressing a transmitter, the corresponding light/number on the receiver will light up. To turn it off, press the reset button on the receiver.
3. **To Change Batteries on the Receiver**  
Open battery compartment on back of the receiver, and pull out the 9 Volt battery to replace it.
4. **To Change Batteries on the Transmitter**  
Remove the single screw on the back of the transmitter and replace battery with MN21 Battery or a like battery.
