- ▶ Qvix internal circuit does not have any parts that users can repair at will. If a fault occurs, please do not disassemble the unit at will. Such act may become a cause for fire.
- ▶ Do not install the unit in places with much oil, smoke, humidity, water and dust or in places exposed to rain and wind. The installation in those places may become a cause for failure.
- ▶ Make sure to install the unit in places with proper ventilation. Otherwise, it may be overheated causing a failure.
- ▶ Do not touch the power plug by wet hands. Do not use a damaged power cord or a loose outlet. Such use may become a cause for electric shock and fire.

1. Put off the Qvix and TV power, when connecting any cables.

2. If the USB cable is connected to the Qvix with its power turned off, the Qvix is set to run in a storage mode.

Before watching movies, please make sure to remove the USB cable from the Qvix mainframe.

3. If a newly purchased hard disc is mounted, please make sure to set its partition and format it before using it.

4. As for the hard disc formatted in an NTFS mode, it cannot be recognized by either Windows 98 or Windows ME, which does not support the NTFS. In this case, use it after deleting the partition of the hard disc, setting the partition to FAT32 again, and formatting it.

5. Protect the mainframe against heat fully before replacing or separating the hard disc in use. Some hard disc may generate much heat, causing a danger of getting burned.

6. Never turn off the power of the unit during its firmware upgrade.

If the power turns off during firmware upgrade, the unit cannot run normally.

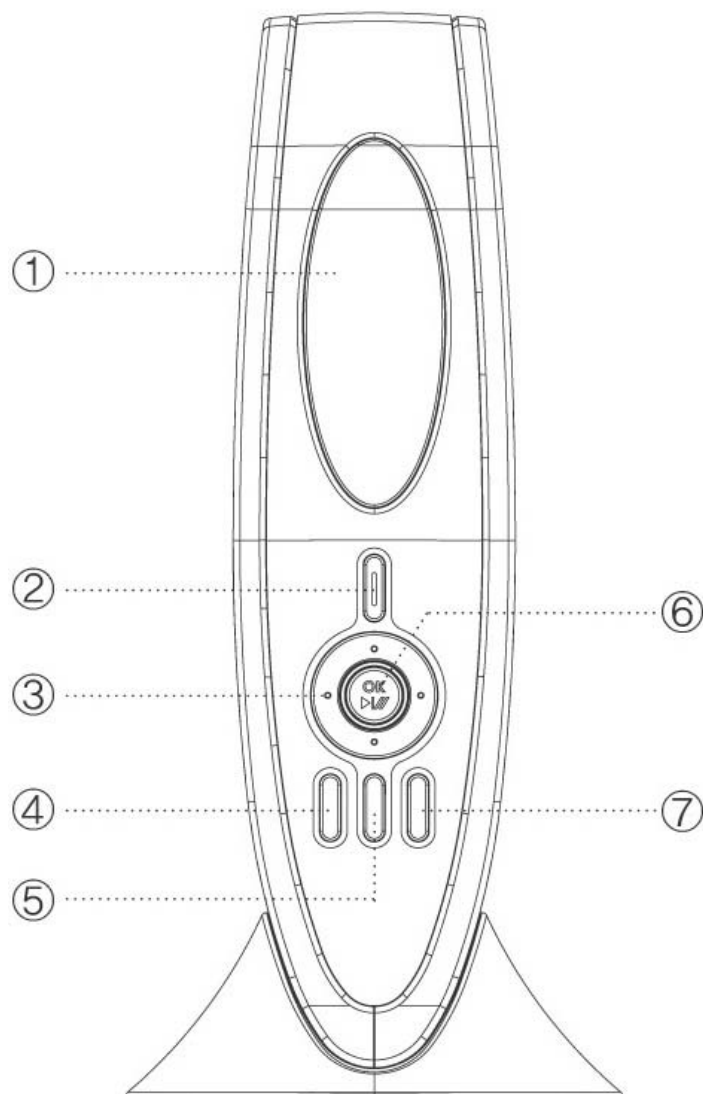

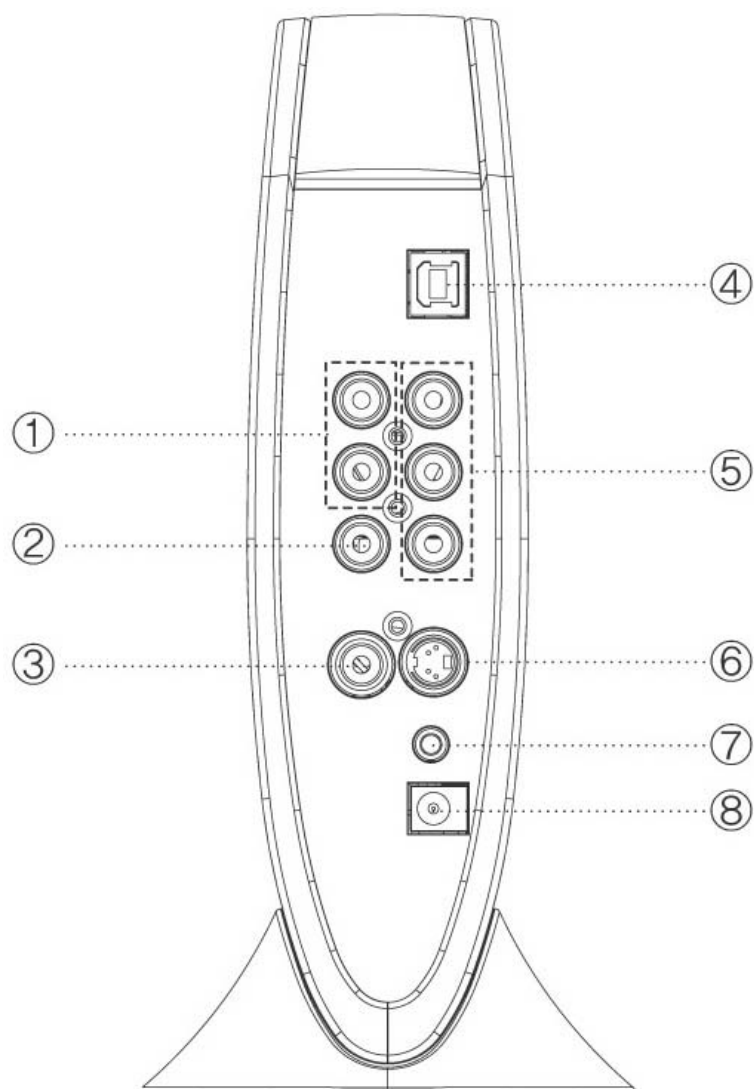

### 3. Qvix Installation

#### Mount the Hard Disc

- You can mount the hard disc in the following order. Follow the procedure below step by step while looking at the pictures.

1. Disassemble the fastening screw under the left cover of the mainframe.



Use the (+) driver to turn the fastening screw on the left cover of the mainframe in a counterclockwise direction.

2. Separate the left cover of the mainframe.



Separate the side cover by lifting it slightly as shown on the picture.

3. Connect the hard disc.



Connect the power connector and IDE connector to the hard disc, and rest the hard disc on the bracket.



4. Close the cover.



If you are to close the cover, please fix it from the left side first and close the lower side. And use the (+) driver to connect the fixing screw in the opposite direction of opening the cover first.

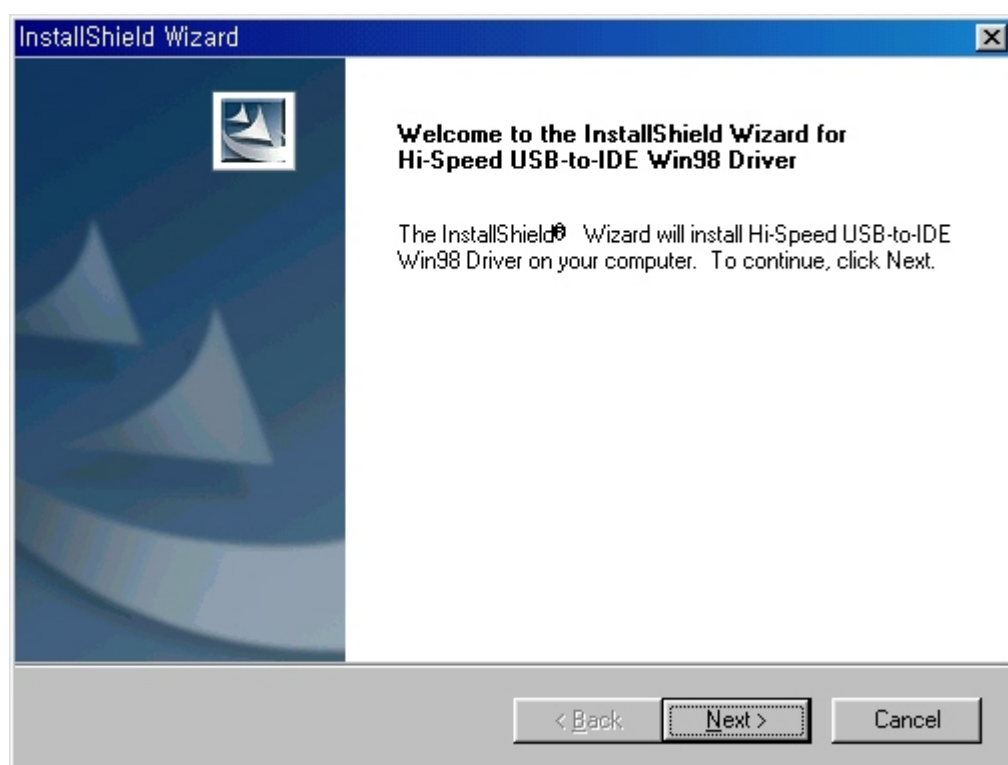
\* Attention

1. The mountable hard disc refers to the 3.5" IDE hard disc (for desktop).
2. Set the jumper of the hard disc **to** the master before mounting the hard disc. However, when it comes to the hard disc supporting the single mode, it is sometimes necessary to set it not **to** the Master but **to** the single mode the.

## Connect to and Disconnect from PC

### Install the USB driver on WIN98SE/ME

Install the Windows98-only driver included in the install CD while the Qvix is not connected to PC. The driver name is the Win98\_QVIX\_BDP3500. If you execute the driver program, the install wizard will appear. Select the [NEXT] button to complete the driver installation.



### TIP

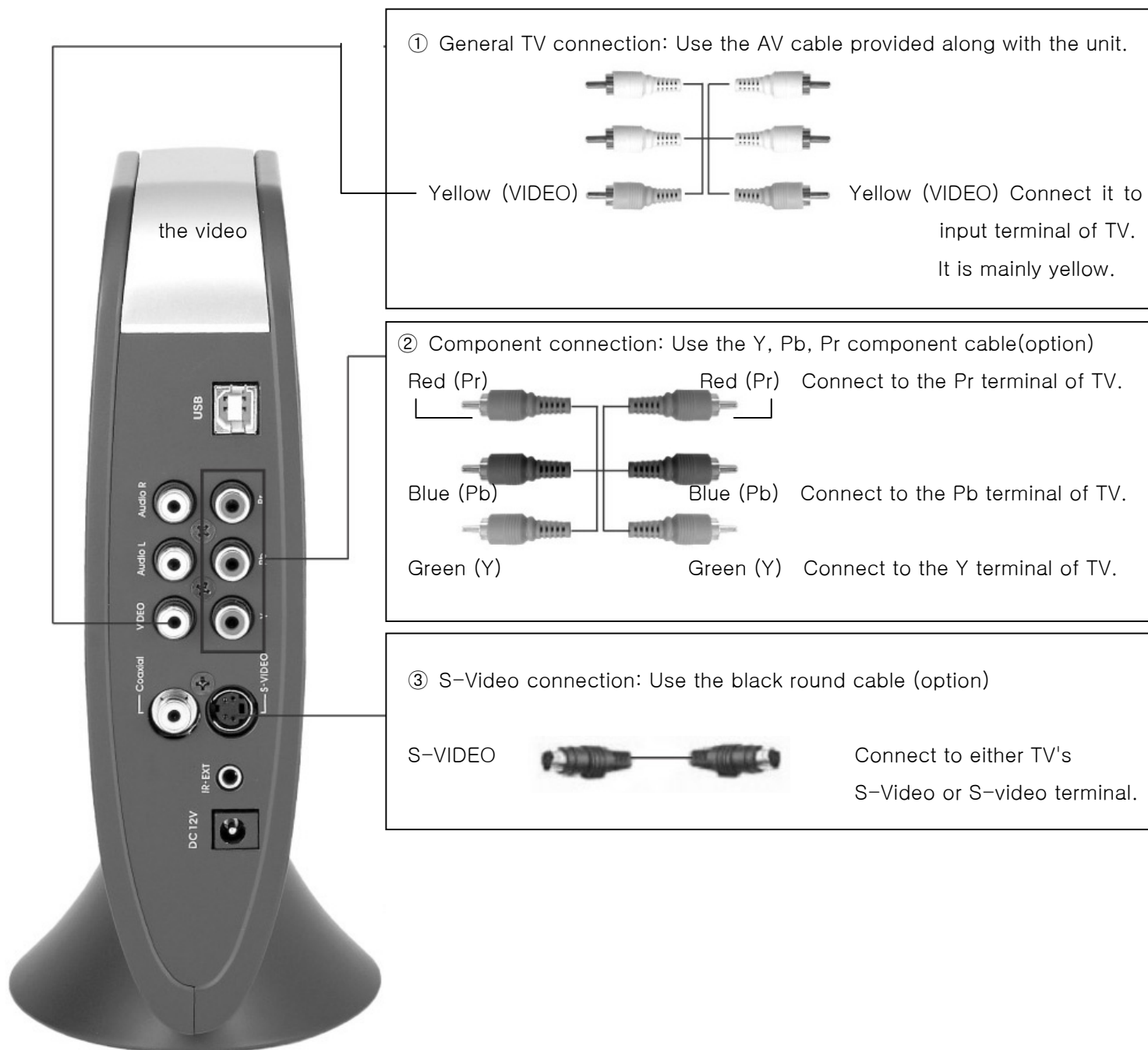
1. If you fail to generate the driver yet, please check whether the FAT32 of the hard disc is formatted or not. The 98SE/ME operating system can recognize the FAT32-formatted hard disc only, while it does not recognize the NTFS-formatted hard disc.
2. Windows2000, XP offers the driver in its own OS, so you do not need the install program. Only if you connect it to PC, the Windows2000, XP will recognize it automatically (Plug & Play). And you can see that the hard disc USB device is mounted on the device manager's disc drive.

## 4. Qvix Use

### Connect the Cable

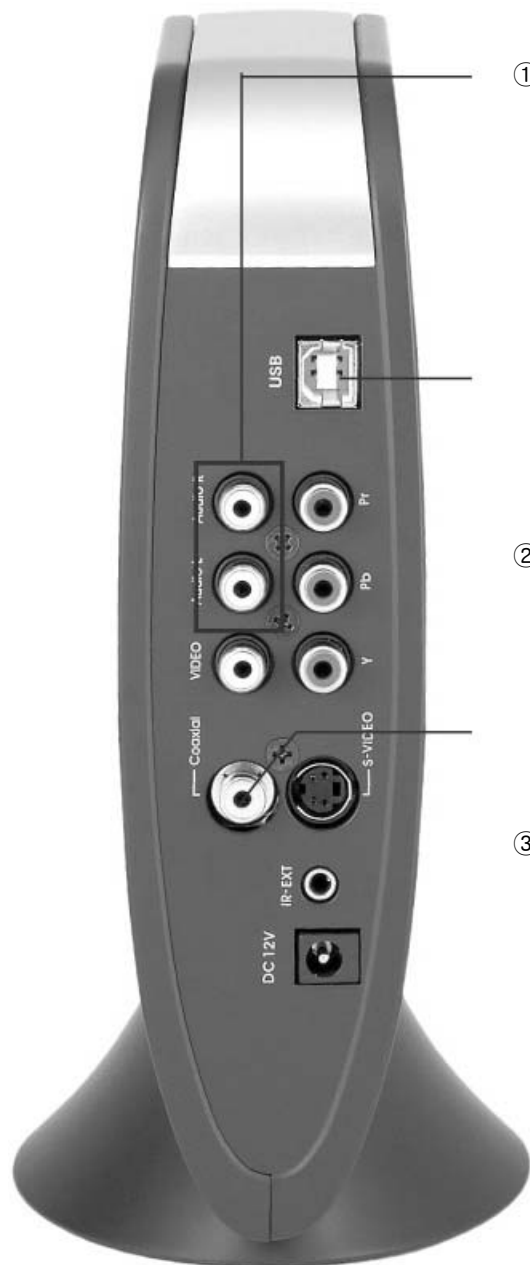
1) Connect the video cable and View the TV screen

Connect the cable according to the three video output procedures below.

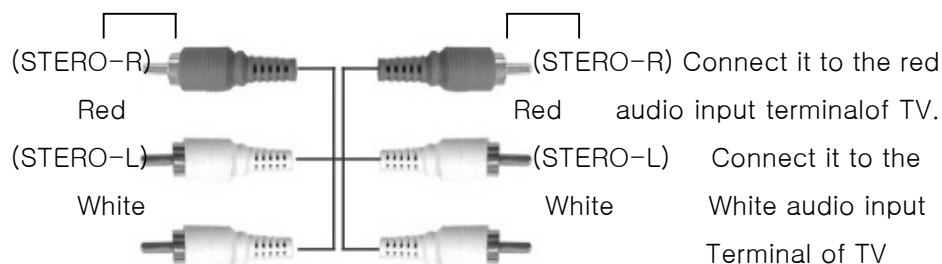


## 2) Connect to the audio cable and PC

Connect the cable according to the two audio output procedures below.



- ① General TV connection (composite): Use the AV cable provided along with the unit.



- ② USB connection: Connect the USB cable to PC.

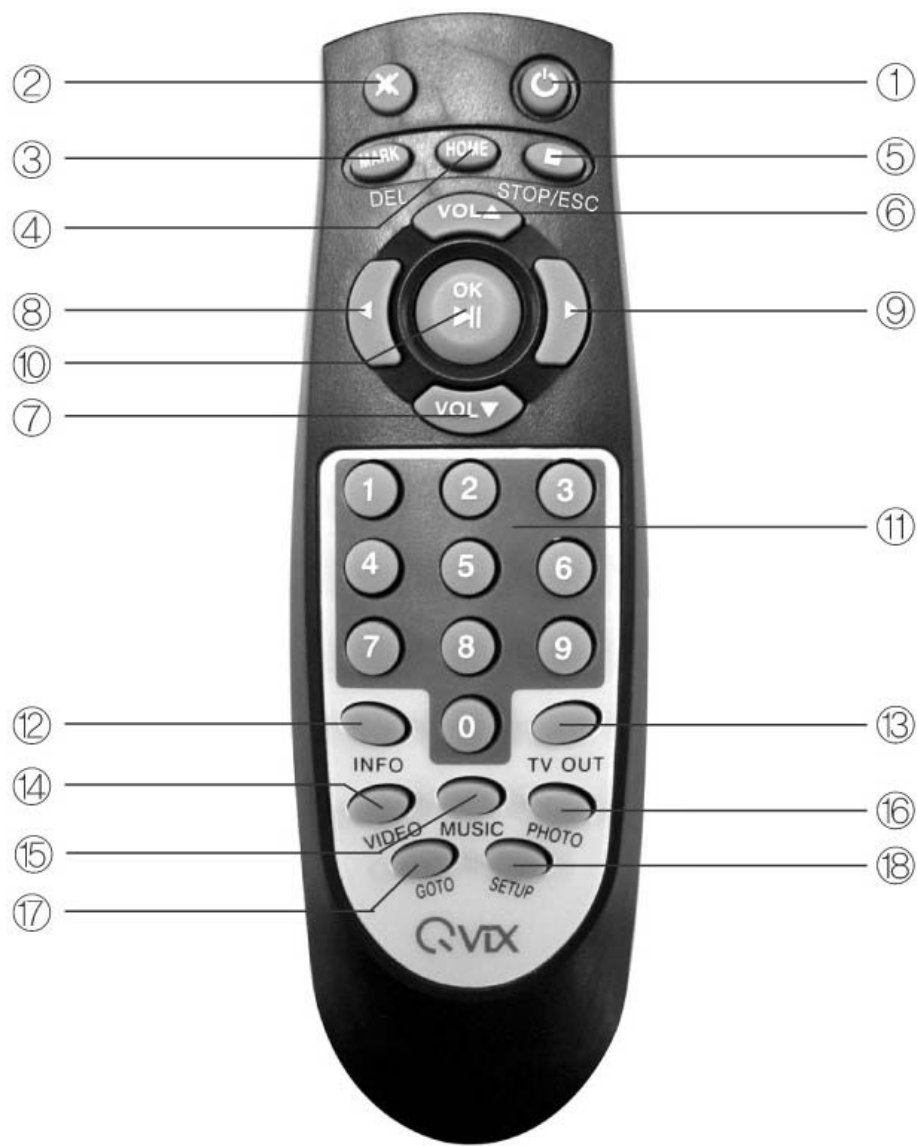


- ③ COAXIAL cable connection: 5.1 channel digital audio (option)





















After plugging the USB cable provided into the USB socket placed on the back of the unit, connect its opposite side to PC. At that time, make sure that the adapter is connected to the unit. The Windows ME/2000/XP will be connected immediately without a separate driver.

Use the Remote Controller

No.	Button	Function
1		Turn on or off the power.

2		Turn off the volume temporally.
3		Add or delete the play list on the Music Player / Return to the original screen size while viewing movies and photos.

## 5. Qvix Screen Configuration

### Media Explorer

- If you turn on the Qvix power, the Qvix logo screen will appear temporally and the Media Explorer window will be displayed as shown in the picture below.
- The Qvix offers a simple and intuitive user environment for the sake of user convenience.
- In the Media Explorer mode, all the available media files will be displayed on the screen at once. If you want to have only the video, music and photo files displayed on the screen, select the desired file and press the OK button on the remote controller or press the VIDEO, MUSIC, or PHOTO button.
- If you want to have all the files displayed from the current folder, press the Stop/ESC button.
- If you want to return to the initial screen, press the Home button.



Each item can be described as follows.

1. Display mode – The Media Explorer displays all the available media files on the single screen.
2. Selection bar – Indicate the currently selected item.
3. Folder list – Show the list of the currently stored folders.
4. File type



– This icon indicates all the available video files.



This icon indicates all the available music files.

The file extension is MP3, WMA, OGG, and AC3.



This icon indicates all the available picture files. The file extension is JPG.



This icon indicates all the available movie title files. The file extension is SMI, SMIL.



This icon indicates other file formats.

5. Current path – Indicate the currently selected path.

6. File information – Indicate the current selected file's format, extension and size.

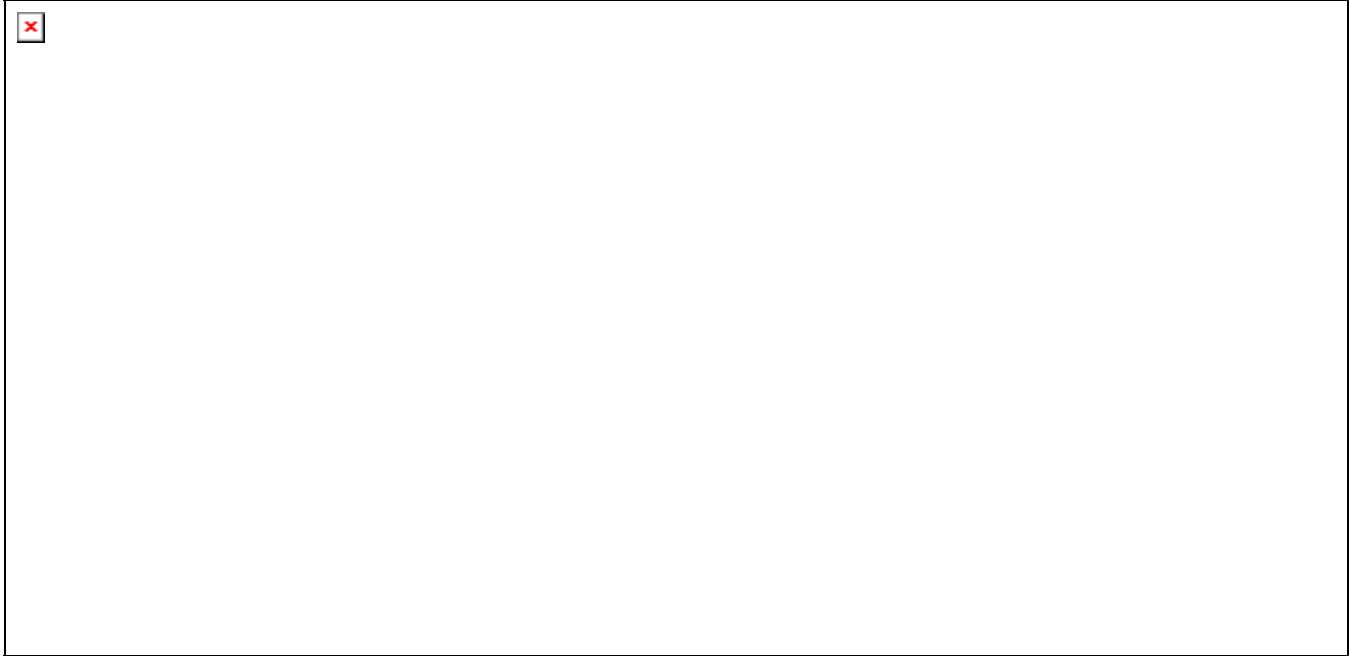
#### TIP

- The screen reappears if you press the number 0 (hot) button when the screen turns black.  
(Press the Home button to get back to the initial screen.)
- The specifically selected folder music is automatically played when turning the power on and pressing the OK button for a long time. (But, there should be a folder named QVIX (capital and small letters identified))



## MOVIE PLAYER

### Screen Configuration



- If you select a video file from the Media Explorer window or press the VIDEO button on the remote controller, the Movie Player window will appear as shown in the picture above.
- The available folders and file list will appear on the left side of the screen.
- The selection bar–indicated file extension and size will appear on the right side of the screen.
- After selecting the file you want, press the OK button of the remote controller to execute the file.

## How to Use

Play the video files like AVI, MPEG1, 2, 4 DAT, M2V and VOB.

You can display the list of video files saved by selecting a video file from the main screen or pressing the VIDEO button of the remote controller.

After selecting the file to play, press the OK/PAUSE button.

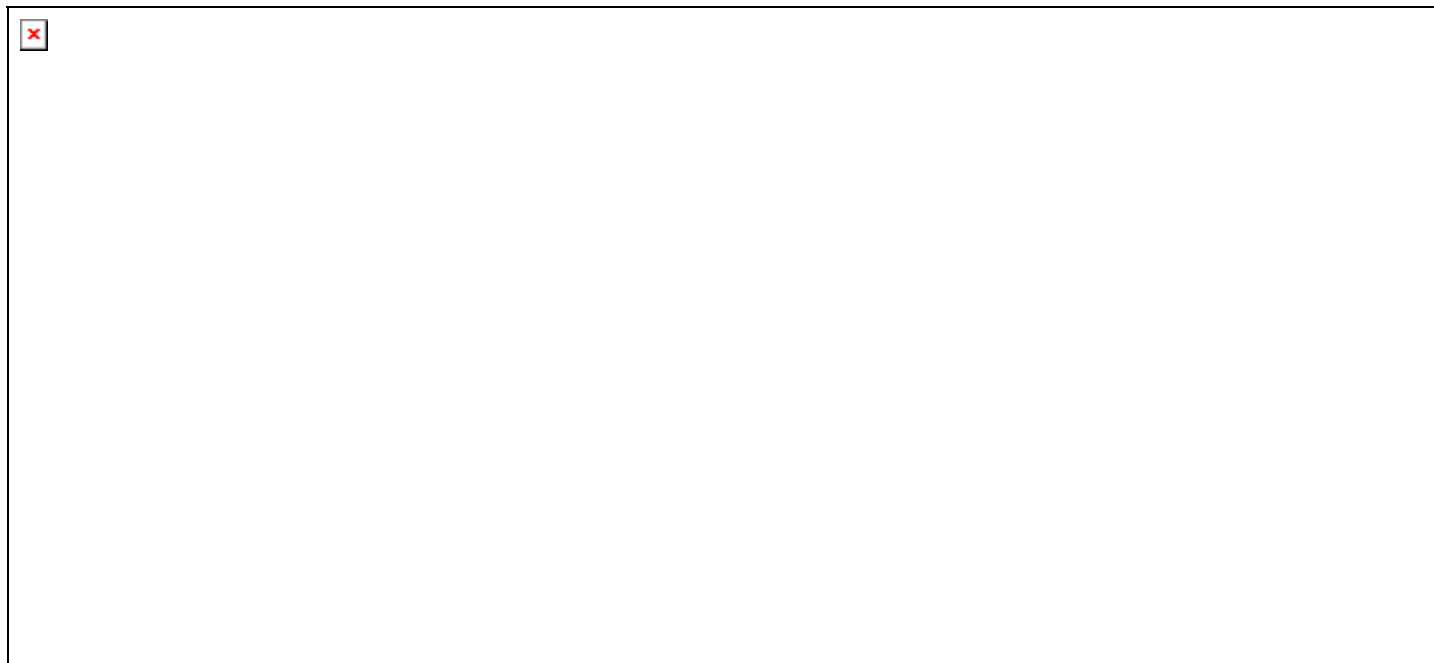
### <Available Buttons and Functions upon playing the VIDEO files>

Function	Remote Controller Button	Description
Pause	OK/PAUSE	If you press this button during playback, you can pause temporarily. If you press it again, the file will be played again.
Stop	STOP	Stop the file playing and go to the Movie Player. If you stop a file by pressing the STOP button, next time you will find the message asking whether to continue the file or not.
Rewind	LEFT	Whenever pressing the button, you can move a file in the opposite direction at 8, 16 and 32 speed.
Fast forward	RIGHT	Whenever pressing the button, you can move a file in the right direction at 8, 16 and 32 speed.
VOLUME +	UP	Turn up the volume.
VOLUME -	DOWN	Turn down the volume.
No sound	MUTE	If you press this button, the sound will be muted. If you press this button again, the sound will be heard again.
File information	INFO	Show the information on the current playing file.
Quick move	GOTO	Go to the desired time position temporarily during the playback based on the current time set.
① ZOOM	SETUP	You can zoom in and out the image with the direction keys ▲ ▼ ◀ ▶. Press the MARK/DEL button to return to the original status.
② SCROLL		You can move the image position in four directions with the direction keys ▲ ▼ ◀ ▶. Press the MARK/DEL button to return to the original status.
③ Screen setup		You can change the luminosity, brightness, color depth with the direction keys ◀ ▶. You can save the setup with the OK button.

④ Title setup		You can change the title size, location, color and sync with the direction keys ▲ ▼. You can save the setup information by pressing the OK button.
⑤ Screen ratio		Once you select the screen ratio you want, it will be applied immediately. If you are to return to the original status, press the MARK/DEL button.

## Music Player

### Screen Configuration



- If you select a music file from the Media Explorer window or press the MUSIC button on the remote controller, the Music Player window will appear as shown in the picture above.
- The available folders and file list will appear on the left side of the screen.
- After selecting the file you want, press the OK button of the remote controller to execute the file. In addition, you can transfer the songs you want to the Selected Play List window by using the MARK button of the remote controller.
- You can use the following play options by using the numeric buttons of the remote controller.

0. CLEAR ALL – Clear all the files on the Selected Play List.

1. PLAY ALL – Play all the songs.

2. RANDOM – Play randomly.

3. REPEAT – Repeated the song selected.

The picture above shows an example of selecting the repeat option for all the songs by means of the No. 1 and 3 buttons.

## How to Use

Play the music files like MP3, OGG, WMA, and AC3.

You can display the list of music files saved by selecting a music file from the main screen or pressing the MUSIC button of the remote controller.

After selecting the file to play, press the OK/PAUSE button.

### <Available Buttons and Functions upon playing the MUSIC files>

## PHOTO ALBUM

### Screen Configuration



- If you select a photo file from the Media Explorer window or press the PHOTO button on the remote controller, the PHOTO Album window will appear as shown in the picture above.
- The available folders and file list will appear on the left side of the screen.
- If you move the selection bar to the file position you want, the photo of the selected file will appear on the right Preview window.
- If you press the OK button of the remote controller at that time, the file selected will appear as a full screen.
- If you press the button No.1 of the remote controller from the PHOTO Album mode as an option, the slide show will be displayed from the selected file.

## How to Use

Play the JPG picture files.

You can display the list of photo files saved by selecting a photo file from the main screen or pressing the PHOTO button of the remote controller.

After selecting the file to play, press the OK/PAUSE button.

## 2. HD Component – 480P

Display the component by 480 progressive. At that time, it does not support the component and S-Video output.

- 720P

Display the component by 720 progressive. At that time, it does not support the component and S-Video output.

- 1080i

Display the component by 1080 interface.

## 3. Video output – NTSC C/S-VIDEO (DEFAULT)

Display the NTSC-mode composite and S-Video signal.

- NTSC C/YPbPr

Display the NTSC-mode composite and component (Y, Pb, Pr) signal.

- PAL C/S-VIDEO

Display the PAL-mode composite and S-Video signal.

- PAL C/YPbPr

Display the PAL-mode composite and component (Y, Pb, Pr) signal.

## 4. Audio output – Stereo

Select it when connecting the AV audio cable (red, white) directly to TV.

- 5.1 channel

Select it when viewing the 5.1 channel DTS/Dolby digital through amp or receiver by connecting the coaxial cable.

## 2. Other Setup



Each option's available options and descriptions are as follows.

### 1. Language selection – Korean

Display the contents in Korean on the setup screen or various UIs.

Display the contents in English on the setup screen or various UIs

### 2. Title color – Letter/outline color

Indicate the letter and outline colors in order. You can select the following combinations.

White/black, black/white...

### 3. Title size – You can select a big or small title.

### 4. Slide show interval – 3, 5, 7, 9 seconds.

You can set the time interval of the slide show when playing an ipg image file.

### 5. Setup to initial value – Return all the setup information to the initial value when released from the factory.

The following Qvix structure will appear upon selecting the third icon of Setup.

The ABOUT screen will help users have an easy grasp of the manufacturer information related to the product and Qvix structure.



## 6. Directions for Other Use

### 1. One-touch MP3 play (Listening to music without TV screen)

Save the music file after making a Qvix folder in the root directory of the hard disc embedded in the Qvix. However, if it is divided into various partitions, please make the Qvix folder in the first partition.

If you press the OK button after turning on and off the Qvix power, the music files saved in the Qvix folder will be played automatically.

\* Attention – It is necessary to make a folder name in the capital letters of English.

### 2. Firmware upgrade

① After downloading the upgrade file (Qvix\_FM\_v1.o.update) from the Qvix homepage [www.e-qvix.co.kr](http://www.e-qvix.co.kr), save the file into the Qvix with PC connected.

② If you connect the Qvix to TV and select the downloaded upgrade file (Qvix\_FM\_v1.o.update), the window will appear to ask you whether to try upgrade or not.

③ If you select YES, the upgrade will be executed automatically.

④ Once the upgrade is completed, the Qvix will be off automatically and start again so that the firmware upgrade will be completed. If you press the Setup button after upgrade is completed, the firmware version will be displayed on the lower part of the setup screen.

\* Attention – Never turn off the Qvix power during firmware upgrade.

If the power is off during firmware upgrade, the product may not run normally.
