**Modular Approval Request Letter
For FCC ID: RM4-CO3L (WWAN MODULE)**

Dear Examiner,

Corin LLC and its affiliates ("Corin") are seeking modular approval for the RF exposure condition in our module with the above FCC ID.

The requirements of Public Notice DA00-1407 have been met as shown in the following summary.

Requirement	How Module Complies
The modular transmitter must have its own RF shielding.	The radio portion of this module has been shielded, please see exhibition EUT Photo.
The modular transmitter must have buffered modulation/data inputs.	The EUT has buffered data inputs; it is integrated in chip RF transceiver (U9006).
The modular transmitter must have its own power supply regulation.	Power regulation performed by PMIC (U10).
The modular transmitter must comply with the antenna requirements of section 15.203 and 15.204(C)	The EUT meets the FCC antenna requirements. The Spurious Emission, the unique antenna connector and photo of antennas are shown in the test reports.
The modular transmitter must be tested in a stand-alone configuration.	The EUT was tested in a stand-alone configuration via a USB extender. See photographs of the test configuration in the test report for more detail (e.g., the EUT was plugged in this extender).
The modular transmitter must be labeled with its own FCC ID number.	See label sample for the FCC ID of this module. The User's Manual also has instructions for how to apply the label the end product.
The modular transmitter must comply with any specific rule or operating requirements	The EUT is compliant with all applicable FCC rules. See detailed instructions for maintaining

The modular transmitter must comply with any applicable RF exposure requirements.	The EUT is compliant with all applicable RF exposure requirements. See RF exposure exhibit.
