Re: Confidential Protection for Submission Package for FCC ID No. RM4-CO3L

Dear FCC:

Corin LLC and its affiliated companies ("Corin") are seeking equipment authorization for our radio module with the FCC ID RM4-CO3L. Because some of the information we must share is confidential to our company, we request confidentiality protections of our information under the FCC's Public Notice of June 15, 2004 (DA 04-1705) and Sections 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's rules (47 CFR §§ 0.457, 0.459).

Information for Long Term Confidentiality Protection ("Long Term Information"):

- Bill of materials
- Antenna specification
- Device circuit description
- Block Diagram
- Schematic
- Tune-up procedure
- PCB layout (all layers)

Information for Short Term (180 days) Confidentiality Protection ("Short Term Information"):

- User Manual/Specification
- Internal and External Photos
- Test Setup Photos
- Modular Approval Request Letter

Reasons to Request Protections:

If the Short Term Information is shared before Corin begins marketing our product, it could give our competitors early access to non-public information. That could cause them to get an unfair market advantage over Corin and cause money harm to Corin's business.

We ask for protection of the Long Term Confidential Information on an unlimited basis because it contains very sensitive and in-depth information about our secret techniques, development and manufacturing process and how we design our products. We do not share this data even after we start shipping the products. If our competitors learn this data we would be hurt and it would majorly harmfully impact Corin's ability to compete in a very competitive product space. We would also be hurt because we won't have access to similar information about our competitor products. That could give our competitors one-sided help to use from all of our work.

We have not shared the Short Term Confidential Information or Long Term Confidential Information on a public basis. This information is only shared with people who have an obligation to protect this data secret as Corin's confidential information. It is very important to us that we be able to continue to keep this information confidential.
