To whom it may concern:

This letter serves as an official request for confidentiality under FCC Rule Section 0.459. We are requesting that the schematic diagrams, Eagle block diagram, all internal product photographs, and operational document (file name: Eagle summary.doc) required to be submitted with this application be withheld from public review. These documents and photographs are company proprietary information that could reveal specific competitive and proprietary design and construction details should they be in the possession of our competitors. Internal photographs are included in this request since the interior of the product is partially potted and therefore not visible, and, in order to ensure user safety and maintain a Pollution Degree 1 interior environment as required to meet certain UL standards, the enclosure lid is sealed shut at the factory as a matter of standard procedure to ensure a watertight enclosure. The product interior is therefore not accessible by the user, unless accessed by forced and unauthorized entry. A statement to this fact is included in the user's manual.
