☐ Night mode *

Quick press Power on/off button either on baby unit or on parent unit for 3 times,
Parent unit power indicator turns orange, Baby Unit zero emission when quiet.

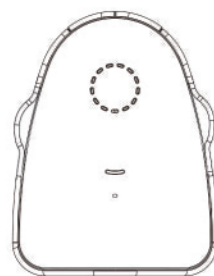
☐ Day mode

Quick press Power on/off button either on baby unit or on parent unit for 3 times,
Parent unit power indicator turns green, out of range function works

* Night Mode will reduce the radio emission to minimum up to zero when it is quiet. However, under Night Mode there is no Range Alarm function. So this mode is recommended to use when Parent Unit and Baby Unit are placed fixed positions such as parents and baby's rooms, typically in the night case. The way to use Night and Day modes is a pending patent of MC Devices.

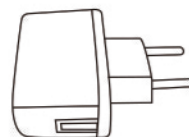

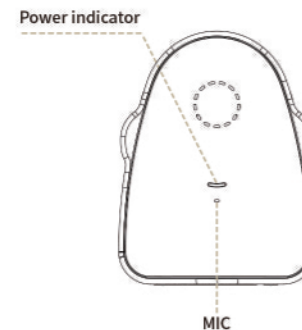

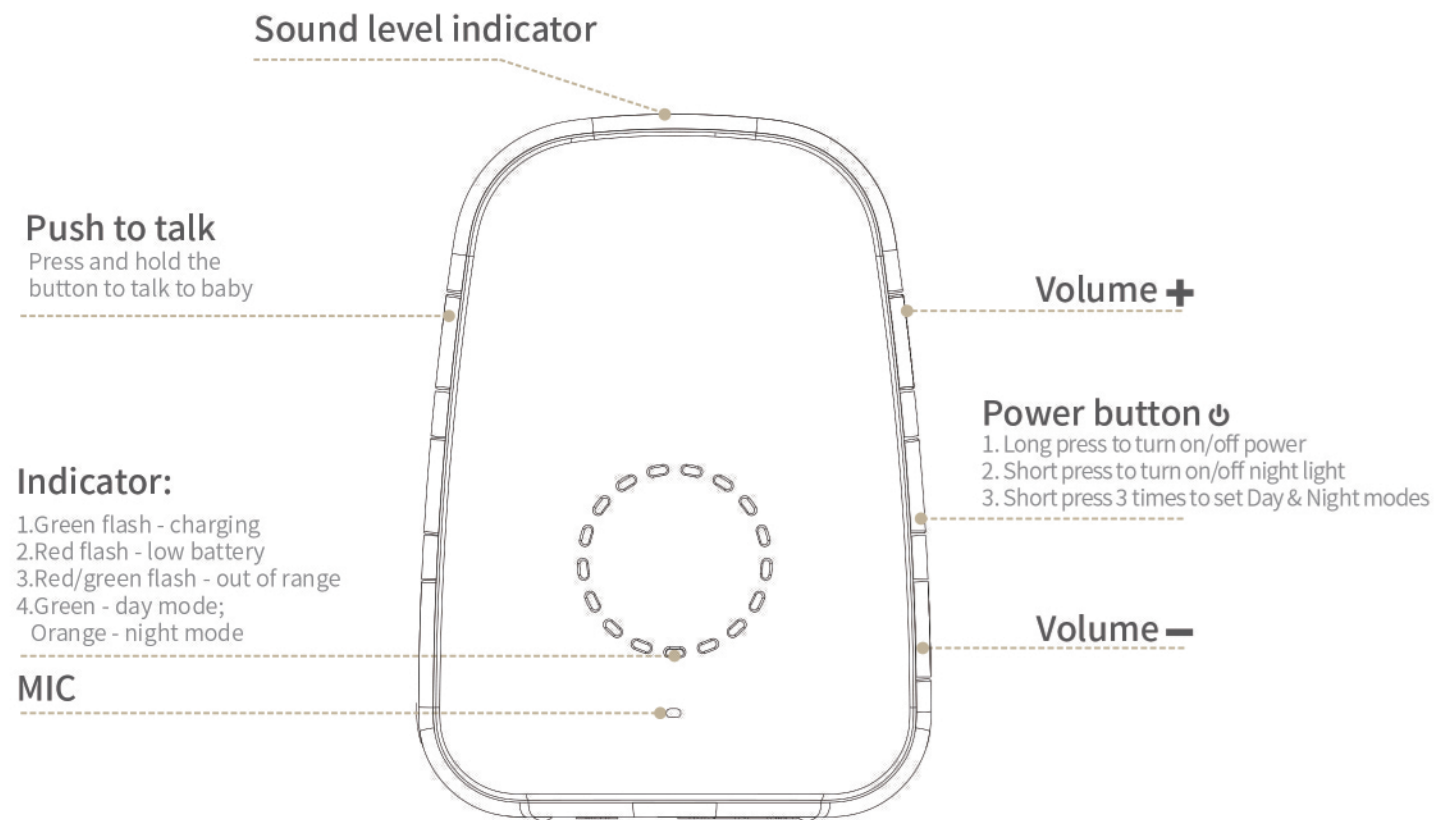


Keep the baby unit 1-3 meters (3-9 feet) away from baby

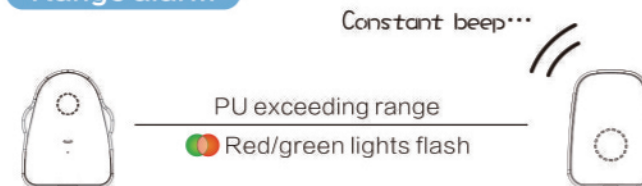

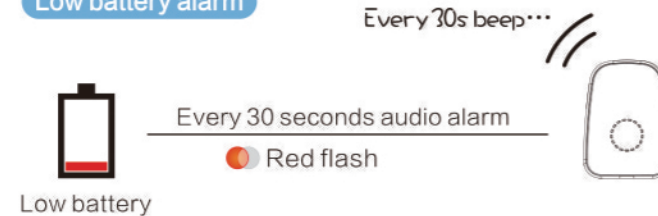

How to use Parent Unit



Parent Unit should be at least 2 meters (6 feet) away from Baby Unit to avoid whistling.
