


5 AA

batteries not included


3 AA batteries are used to power the main vehicle. 2 AA batteries are used to power the remote control. These batteries are not included.

- For best performance use only batteries recommended.
- Ensure batteries are inserted using the correct polarity.
- Do not mix new and used batteries
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Keep packaging for reference since it contains important information.
- Remove exhausted batteries from unit and dispose of in accordance with battery maker's recommendations.
- Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries should only be charged under adult supervision.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before charging.
- The supply terminals are not to be short circuited.
- Remove batteries if the toy will not be used for an extended period of time.
- Use a screwdriver to open the battery compartment door and replace old batteries.
