## 1. INTRODUCTION

Congratulations on owning a Bluetooth headset. Now you can enjoy the freedom of making and receiving calls while conducting your daily activities. This Bluetooth wireless headset lets you connect to any Bluetooth enabled device that supports Bluetooth Headset and/or Handsfree profile.

Please carefully read over this user's manual before operating your headset. More detailed information is also provided by your phone's user guide. Both the headset's and phone's manual should be read carefully to understand the operation modes as well as important safety and maintenance information.

## 2. BLUETOOTH

Bluetooth wireless technology allows connection of devices using built-in radio transceivers that operate on a globally available radio frequency without the need to be in direct line of sight. The two devices can easily connect within a proximity of 10 meters of each other, although the connection quality can vary from types of obstructions, such as walls, or from other electronic devices.

Bluetooth profile this headset supports both the Bluetooth Headset and Handsfree profile. A Bluetooth profile means a set of Bluetooth commands that your phone uses for controlling the headset.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTAINS:

Different functions are supported on different profiles and the phone dictates which Bluetooth profile(s) it will support. You may have different experience when connecting this headset with different phones, not all functions described in this user's manual will be supported by all phone models.

In some countries, there may be restrictions on using Bluetooth devices. Please check with your local authorities.

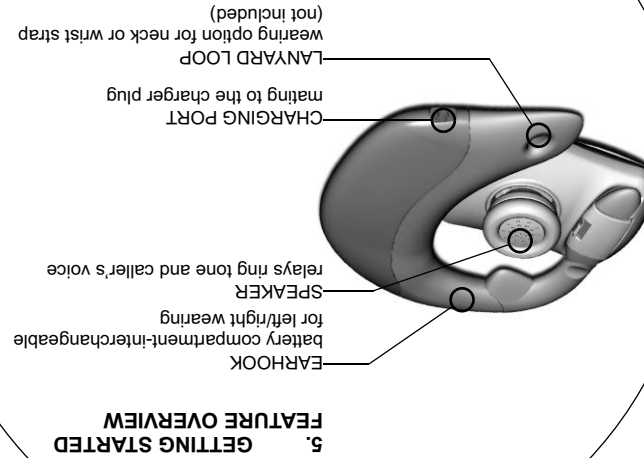

## 5. PREPARING YOUR HEADSET

### Charging the battery

**First-Time Use:** plug the charger into your headset's charger port for at least 3 hours (or until the charger LED turns green). You may charge your battery with or without assembling the earhook onto your headset.

**Recharging:** This headset contains rechargeable lithium polymer battery. Three (3) consecutive beeps are generated in one minute interval to indicate low battery status. Connect your AC charger plug to the charging port of your headset. RED LED on your charger indicates charging while GREEN LED indicates charge complete.

Lithium Polymer batteries have 300 to 500 charge cycles. If you need to replace the battery, you can purchase a new one from your nearest authorized dealer or visit [www.solteras.com](http://www.solteras.com).





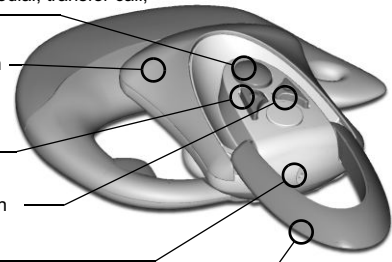

### 11. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you cannot connect your Solteras Halo to your phone, check for:

- Make sure your headset is turned on.
- Make sure your phone is turned on and Bluetooth feature is activated.
- Checked for paired devices if you believe your headset is already paired.
- If "Solteras HALO" does not appear on the paired devices list your must repeat the steps for pairing and connecting.
- If "Solteras HALO" comes up on pair devices repeat connecting the headset to your phone steps.
- If your headset is paired and connected to your phone but does not respond to your actions as you know it should, proceed as follows:
- Power down the headset by holding down on the volume+/- button simultaneously for 3



**Turning Off The Headset** turn off the headset by press and hold the volume buttons (volume + and Volume -) simultaneously for 3 second until LED indicator turns RED.

Your Phone provided in this manual. When you reconnect a paired headset, you will not be asked for its passkey.

### Transferring The Call Between Phone and Headset

while a call is in progress you can transfer the audio link between the phone and your headset. You can initiate transfer function with one short press on the TASK button to transfer call to and from the headset.

**Automatic Answering** If you enabled the automatic answering feature on your phone, the phone/headset will automatically answer your incoming call.

**Adjusting The Speaker Volume** continue short presses on the volume + button to increase your speaker volume or short presses on the volume - button to decrease your speaker volume.

**Muting** during call in progress, short press on the volume+/volume- buttons simultaneously to mute. To **unmute** repeat the same step.

**Disconnecting The Headset** you can turn the headset or the phone off to disconnect the Bluetooth link. When you travel beyond connection distance of your Bluetooth devices, you can also disconnect the Bluetooth link. From your phone menu you can also disconnect or delete your Bluetooth connection.

**Reconnecting The Paired Headset** repeat the steps for Connecting The Paired Headset To

your phone, your phone must support voice dial feature (sometimes referred to as voice tag) and no call in progress. You can short press the TASK button once to activate voice dialing. A tone feedback from the phone will indicate that you can say the desired name (referred to as voice tag in most phone operations). Speak the voice tag clearly you'll hear a play back of your pre-recorded voice tag and the stored number will be dialed automatically.

**Re-dialing The Last Number Dialed** double short press on the TASK button to redial the last number dialed while no call is in progress.

**Phone Keypad Dialing** when the headset is connected to your phone, you can dial any number to make a call as you would normally.

**Answering A Call** short press on TASK button to answer a call. You can also answer the call from your phone's answer button.

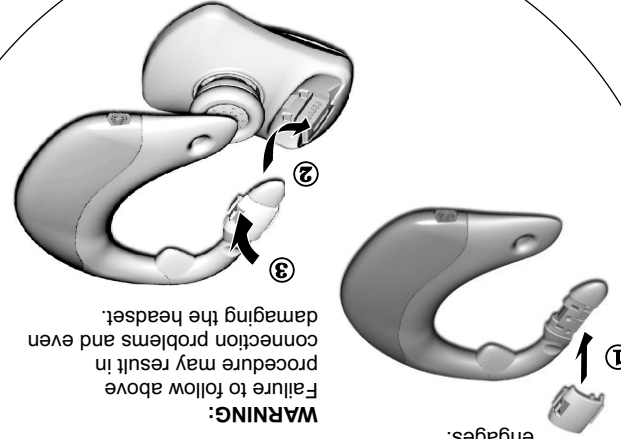
**Ending A Call** PRESS AND HOLD your TASK button for 3 seconds.

**Rejecting A Call** PRESS AND HOLD your TASK button for 3 seconds when you hear the incoming call ring.

### Assembling your headset

#### INTERCHANGING THE TOP COVER

Remove by lifting all 4 corners. Attach by aligning the 4 bosses and press down firmly.



**WARNING:** Failure to follow above procedure may result in connection problems and even damaging the headset.

**1.** Attach the earhook cover to the earhook first.  
**2.** Align and insert the tab on the earhook cover to the contact block.  
**3.** Press down the earhook cover until the latch engages.

#### ASSEMBLING THE EARHOOK

10. Some phones will require authorization options to be set on paired devices. Once authorization is selected, connection between headset and phone will become AUTOMATIC when the two devices are turned on (provided the phone's bluetooth feature is enabled and turned on)

## 9. CONNECTING THE PAIRED HEADSET TO YOUR PHONE

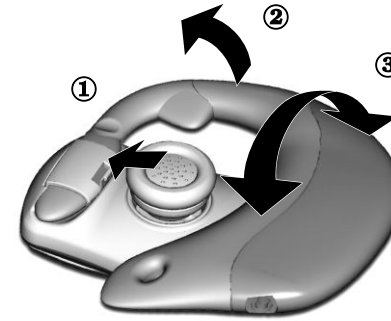
When you turn off either phone or headset or both, you will disconnect your bluetooth link. To re-establish connection, turn the devices on and check for bluetooth feature (ON) on your phone. If you have set the phone to accept Bluetooth connection requests from "Solteras HALO" without your permission, then switching on the headset and phone will AUTOMATICALLY create the connection. If you have not set your "Solteras HALO" as authorized devices without permission requirement, you may need to short press the TASK button or select connect from your phone's menu to enable connection. For details on authorization without permission to your bluetooth devices please read your phone's user guide carefully.

## 10. HEADSET OPERATION/FUNCTIONS

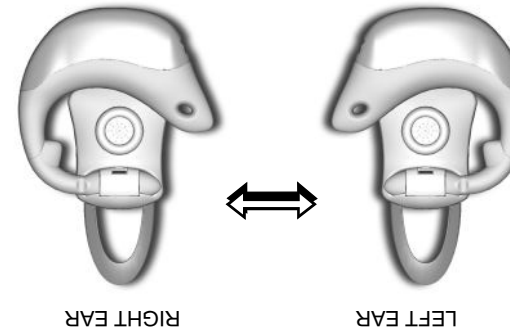
## REMOVING THE EARHOOK (INTERCHANGING FOR LEFT OR RIGHT EAR)

1. Push latch forward to disengage.
2. Carefully lift up entire earhook assembly.
3. To wear on the opposite ear, flip the earhook 180°, and follow the instruction on assembling the earhook.



8. PAIRING YOUR HEADSET AND PHONE

1. Make sure your phone is switched on.
2. Turn on your headset.
3. Put your headset into discoverable/pairing mode by pressing down on volume+ button simultaneously (short press). Flashing Fuchsia LED signals your headset is now ready to be discovered and paired.
4. Go to your phone menu and select Bluetooth connection mode (ON) (follow your phone menu on bluetooth pairing and connecting instruction)
5. Enter Bluetooth submenu on the phone to search or discover bluetooth devices and start searching/discovering. The phone will search and display a list of bluetooth devices within its connection range. "SOLTERAS HALO" will display as device found. This indicates the phone has FOUND your Bluetooth headset.
6. Select "Solteras HALO" from the list.
7. The phone will prompt you to enter the passkey to establish connection.
8. Enter **3434** this is your **passkey**.
9. Once you entered your passkey, your phone will indicated connecting...connected. If your headset has not been previously paired with another device, your phone will become the DEFAULT phone for this headset. Your headset "Solteras HALO" will now appear on your bluetooth paired devices.





## 6.USING YOUR BLUETOOTH HEADSET

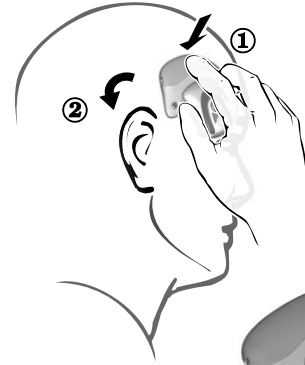
Before using the headset, make sure below conditions are met.

- Turn your bluetooth phone on and make sure Bluetooth feature on the phone is also turned on. (please reference phone's user manual)
- Fully charge the battery for first time use.
- Headset must be turned on.
- The headset is paired and connected to your phone. (paired headset may NOT be connected to your phone at all times. Please read connecting the paired headset to your phone below for connection instruction)
- The headset is within 10 meters proximity from the phone. Please note walls or other obstructions may reduce the RF link distance.

## 7. TURNING ON YOUR HEADSET

-  **ON** short press on TASK BUTTON until you see the RED LED indication on the BOOM. Red LED will quickly turn to Blue.
-  **OFF** press and hold the Volume + and Volume- buttons simultaneously for 2~3 seconds until you see the RED LED indication on the BOOM. LED will remain off until the next time you switch the power on.

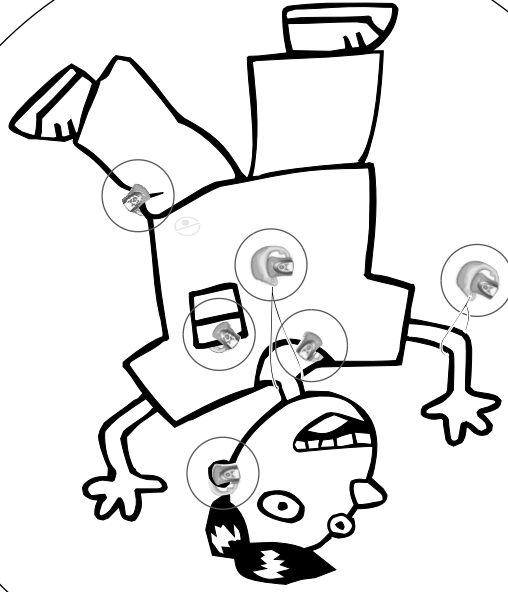
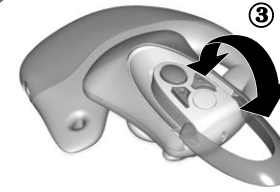
## WEARING AND ADJUSTING THE HEADSET



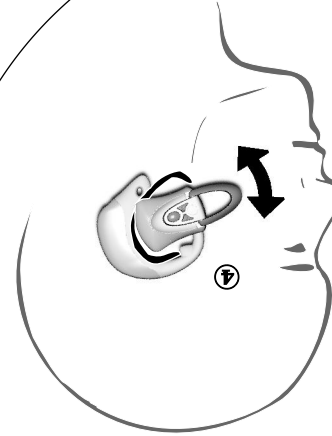
1. Separate the earhook with finger while holding the headset as shown.

2. Slide on the headset in a sweeping motion.

3. Open the boom by pulling on the 2 sides next to the volume buttons.



CARRYING THE HEADSET



4. Adjust the headset by rotating it down for larger ears, and up for smaller ears.

**Note:** make sure the boom is pointing toward the mouth and the speaker is sitting properly inside the ear during conversation to ensure best performance. However, the headset will operate normally with the boom in closed position.
