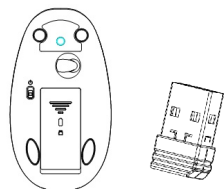

Installing Batteries in the Mouse

Step1. Open the battery compartment.

Step2. Insert the batteries as shown inside the battery compartment.

Step3. Replace the cover.



The receiver is connected to your computer via USB port
USB cable. And it plug to USB port of your computer.

CAUTION:

Windows 98 or higher is required for USB port installation. Connect the receiver cable to the USB port on computer.

For Windows, you may be prompted to insert the windows software CD. Insert this software CD into the computer's CD-ROM driver when asked to do so. Then follow the on-screen instructions.

Software installation

The driver supports Win98/SE, Win2000 and Win XP, Vista

The driver will install automatically if the auto-run is enable in your computer. Otherwise, you can manually launch the installation by double clicking the file setup.exe in the CD-ROM.

The setup applet's icon of the keyboard and the mouse will appear on the windows taskbar after successfully completing software installation.

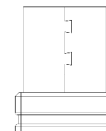
