RF exposure requirements - FCC ID: RW7CRABAT

Dear Application Examiner,

The maximum measured power output is 0,204 mW (-6,9 dBm), the maximum antenna gain is 2.5 dBi = numeric gain 1,78 (see also FCC test report - Exhibit B)

The maximum permissible exposure is defined in 47 CFR 1.1310 with 1 mW/cm². The distance from the EUT's transmitting antenna where the exposure level reaches the maximum permitted level is calculated using the general equation:

$$S = P \cdot G / 4\pi R^2$$

$S_{max} = 1 \text{ mW/cm}^2$, $P = 0,204 \text{ mW}$, linear power gain relative to the isotropic radiator = 2.5 dBi = 1,78 (numeric gain), R = distance in cm

Solving for R , the 1mW/cm² limit is reached in a distance of 0,17 cm to the transmitting antenna.
