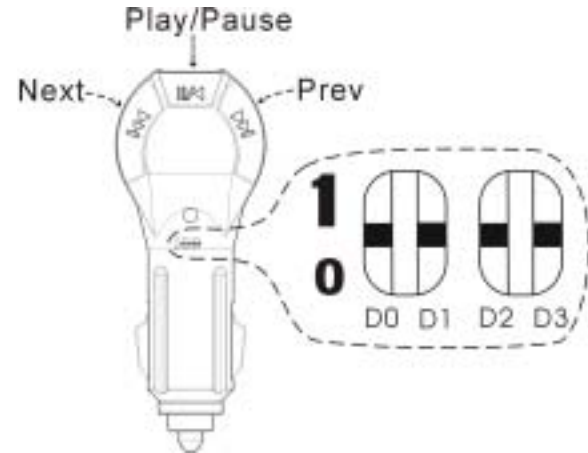
MP3onChannel Player Operation Manual

1. Turn on the car power and then plug the MP3onChannel player into 12V outlet (cigarette lighter) in car. The LED indicator will be blinked (3 seconds each time).
2. Plug any kinds of flash drives into USB connector on the top of MP3onChannel player.
3. Just press the “PLAY” button on MP3onChannel player and adjust the audio channel on car radio set.
4. Press one more time on “PLAY” button to be PAUSE mode.
5. Press NEXT (PREV) button less than 1 second changing to Next/Pervious MP3 song.
6. You can adjust the volume on MP3onChannel player if you press NEXT (PREV) button more than 2 seconds.
7. Adjust the channel setting if the signal is interfered in your area.
