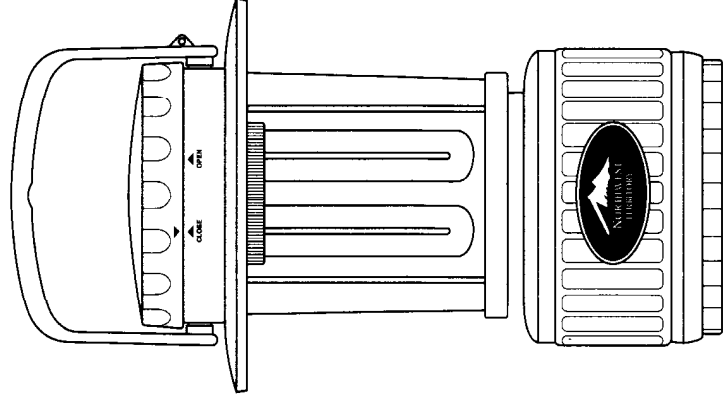




## 5 IN 1 DOUBLE TUBE REMOTE CONTROL LANTERN

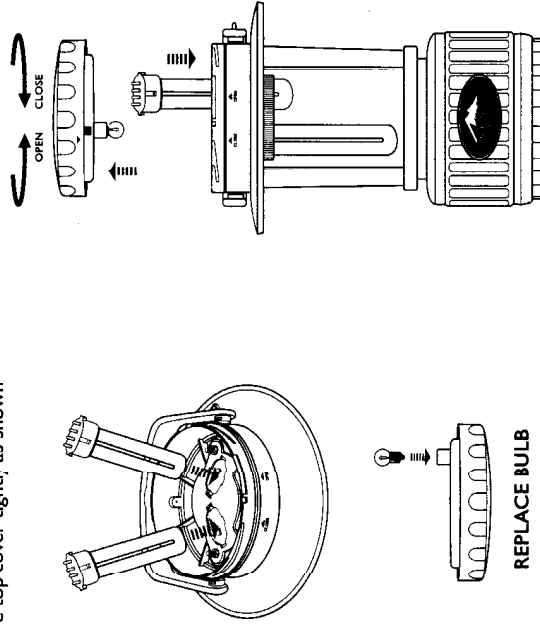
### Operating Instructions

(Please read the instructions carefully before use)



### 9W FLUORESCENT U-TUBE & BULB REPLACEMENT

- Open the top cover as shown
- Remove the old fluorescent U-tube or bulb and replace it with a new 9W U-tube or 12 Volt 0.15A bulb
- Close the top cover tightly as shown



#### WARNING :

- DO NOT MIX OLD AND NEW BATTERIES.
- DO NOT MIX ALKALINE, STANDARD (CARBON - ZINC), OR RECHARGEABLE (NICKEL-CADMIUM) BATTERIES.
- DO NOT DISPOSE BATTERIES IN FIRE. BATTERIES MAY EXPLODE OR LEAK.
- IF LIGHT IS NOT IN FULL BRILLIANCE, BATTERIES SHOULD BE REPLACED. CONTINUOUS USE OF LOW POWER BATTERIES MAY DAMAGE THE LANTERN.

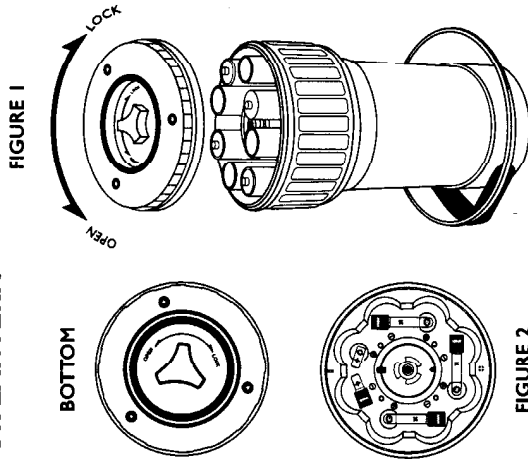

## BATTERY INSTALLATION FOR LANTERN

USE 8 PCS. OF 1.5 VOLT "D" CELL

BATTERIES (BATTERIES NOT INCLUDED). IT IS RECOMMENDED TO USE ALKALINE BATTERIES FOR LONGER LIFE.

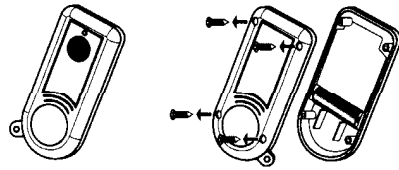
- Turn lantern upside down and open base cover as shown in figure 1
- Insert 8 pcs. of "D" cell batteries with "+" & "-" as shown in figure 1 & 2
- Replace base cover and turn clockwise to close the cover
- Make sure the base cover is closed tightly
- Lantern can be directly used in car with external DC 12 Volt car plug (included)



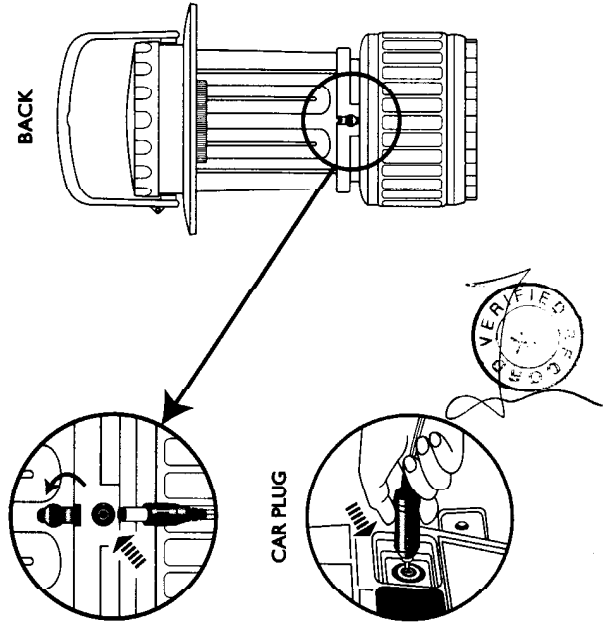
## BATTERY INSTALLATION FOR REMOTE CONTROL

USE 1 PC. OF 12VOLT "A23" ALKALINE BATTERY (INCLUDED)

- Normally, the included "A23" alkaline battery can last for 2 years. However, if the indicator is weak or the remote control is not working, replace it with a new "A23" alkaline battery immediately
- Remove all 4 screws from the 4 corners of the remote control
- Replace the old battery with a new "A23" alkaline battery with correct polarity



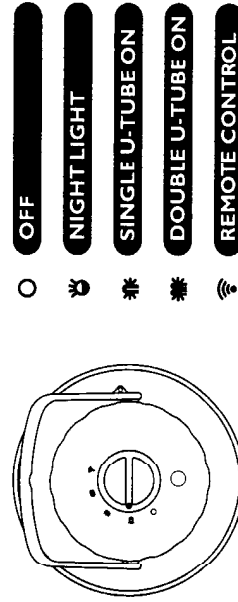
## JET FOR DC 12V CAR PLUG



## OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

Lantern can be operated either manually by turning the switch at the top or by remote control. Signs on top show the "Off", "Night Light", "Single U-Tube On", "Double U-Tube On" and "Remote Control" position.

Switch the lantern to "Off" position when it is not in use. It will consume power continuously if the lantern is switched to "Remote Control" which will reduce the life of the batteries.
