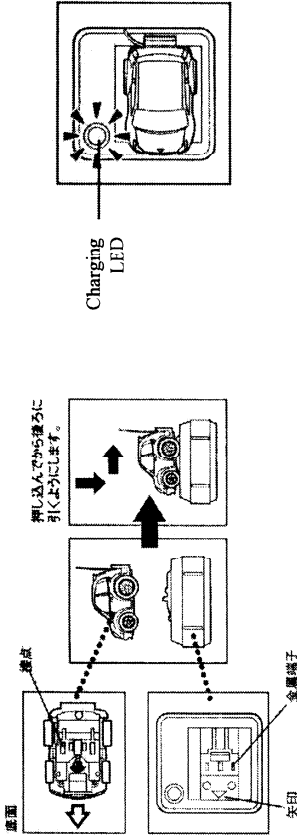


CHORO MODE

Cellular-phone radio control

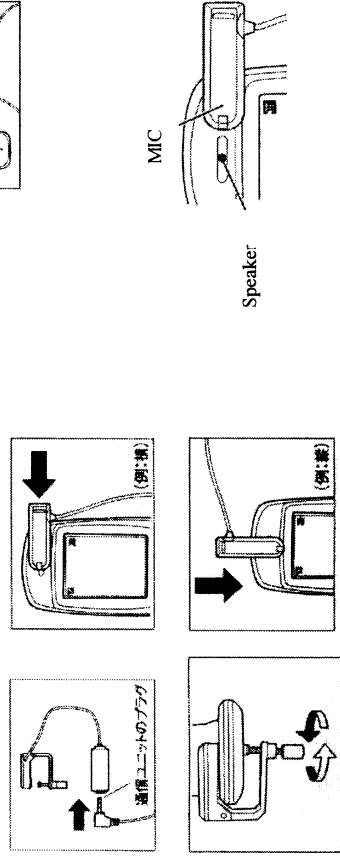
Instruction

1. Set mobile phone Earphone volume output to maximum.
2. Set mobile phone Key Tone output to DTMF mode.
3. Insert battery (AAA size x 3) into Car Charger's battery compartment.
4. Mount Choro Car on Charger in correct position.
 - The charging LED will light up in red color when it is in charging mode. It will take around 1 minute for power charging.
 - The charging LED will change to green color when it is finish charging



Charging LED

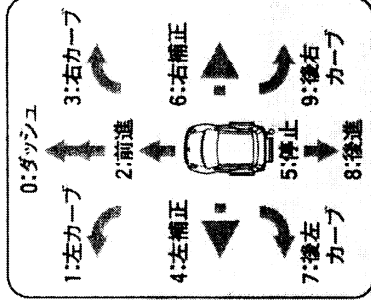
5. Plug Transmitter cord to your mobile phone earphone output.
 - If your mobile phone earphone system is different from Japan phone system.
 - Plug Transmitter to MIC adaptor.
 - Set MIC clip to your mobile phone speaker position.
 - Tight fitting your MIC adaptor by adjusts screw clip.



6. Slide Transmitter power switch to ON position.

7. Press mobile phone Key button to control your Choro Car.

- Key 1 – Turn left running 3 seconds.
- Key 2 – Forward running.
- Key 3 – Turn right running 3 seconds.
- Key 4 – Turn left 0.5 seconds.
- Key 5 – Stop.
- Key 6 – Turn right 0.5 seconds.
- Key 7 – Turn left backward 3 seconds.
- Key 8 – Backward running 3 seconds.
- Key 9 – Turn right backward 3 seconds.
- Key 0 – Dash forward running 2 seconds.



8. Mail Mode

- Key in the correct magic word, Choro Car will follow your input to running.

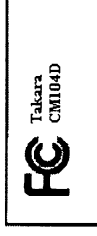
9. Mail Mode magic word List

- まる (**7999#) Circle running
- にち (**644#) Running like number "eight"
- なみ (**577#) Running like Wave
- りたあん (**9941000#) Running forward and backward
- ちよろ (**448899999#) Running like ChoroQ
