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## For Your Safety

## ■ Index of the Mobile Key

<b>1</b>	<b>Receiver</b>	Phone answering
<b>2</b>	<b>LCD</b>	260K TFT
<b>3</b>	<b>Number Key</b>	Input number and characters, or swiftly shift to menu
<b>4</b>	<b>Mouthpiece</b>	Phone speaking
<b>5</b>	<b>Left/Right function key</b>	Performs the function indicted at the bottom left corner of LCD.
<b>6</b>	<b>Navigation Key</b>	Left/Right/Up/Down
<b>7</b>	<b>OK Key</b>	Select the highlighted manual or item by pressing this key to confirm; for detailed functions refers to the following manual
<b>8</b>	<b>Dial Key</b>	Dial numbers and answer a call
<b>9</b>	<b>Power Key</b>	Long press to switch on/off the mobile; short press to end or reject a call & exit from any functions at any time

## SIMPLIFIED MANUAL

### ■ BEFORE USING

1. Insert the SIM card into mobile  
**Support the SIM Card with a voltage of 1.8V and 3V**
2. Please charge the battery for 12 hours without break before using the phone for the first time.
3. At stand-by mode or in main menu, making a call by pressing numbers, and then press **Dial Key**.
4. Press **Power Key** or close the slide to end up a call.

### ■ SLIDING AND LOCKING KEYPADS

1. Move up the slide to unlock the keypad automatically.
2. Move down the slide completely to lock the keypad automatically.
3. Long press **Left Function Key** to lock/unlock

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the keypad when the slide is closed.

**Note: Please move up and down the slide properly. Do not press the bottom battery cap hardly.**

## ■ CALL FUNCTION

1. Press **Dial Key** or **OK Key** to receive an incoming call.
2. When the slide is closed, press **Side Key** to reject calls; when the slide is open, press **Power Key** or simply close the slide to end calls.
3. Adjusting speaker Volume during a call: Press **Left/Right Navigation Key**.
4. Redial number: Press **Dial Key**, then use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the number you are looking for. Press **Dial Key** to connect the call.

## ■ NAMES

1. Under the sleep mode (slide is open or unlocked),

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press **Right Function Key** to bring up names list. Scroll **Up/Down** by using the **Navigation Key**, or you can use the **# Key** and **\* Key** to turn the page up and down, then press **OK Key**.

2. If you would like to use names during a call, press **Left Function Key** to get into the next menu. Using **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **Names** and press **OK Key**.

## ■ QUICK ACCESS TO MENU

1. Under the sleep mode (slide is open or unlocked), press **OK key** to enter main menu and press the “up”, ”down”, ”left” and “right” **Navigation Key** to enter into **Audio Setting**, **Camera**, **Media Folder** and **SMS**
2. press **Left Function Key** to surf **Wap** and press **Right Function Key** to bring up **Names** entry. Press **Dial Key** to check the latest dialed numbers and long press **# Key** to switch on/off the speaker.
3. Under main menu, use **Up/Down Left/Right Navigation Key** to select icons you want and press **OK Key** to enter. Press **Dial Key** to see the dialed

- number. Short press **Power Key** to return to main menu directly.
4. Press **Left/Right Navigation Key** to select among the 2nd level menu while **Up/Down Navigation Key** for the 3rd level menu. Press **OK Key** to enter the 3<sup>rd</sup> level menu.
  5. Press **Right Function Key** to return to the previous Menu or short press the **Power Key** to return to the main menu directly.

### ■ ONE KEYPRESS TO WAP

Under sleep mode or the slide is closed but unlocked, press **Left Function Key** to menu of wap.

### ■ ONE KEYPRESS TO V-MEMO

Under sleep mode, long press Number Key 1 to record voice. When record, press Left Function Key to play or save.



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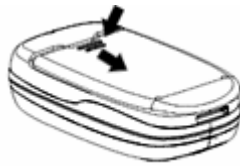
## ■ QUICK ACCESS TO CAMERA

Under sleep mode or main menu, long press **Side Key**, activate viewfinder(general mode) and press **OK** to capture the picture, then press **OK** to store the picture.

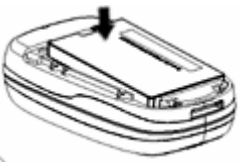
## GETTING START

### ■ INSTALLING/CHANGING BATTERY

1. Make sure the phone is switched off before changing battery.
2. Change Battery

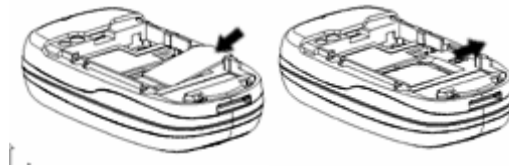


3. Install Battery



## ■ INSERT/CHANGE SIM CARD

1. Make sure your phone is switched off and the battery is removed before you insert/change the SIM card.
2. Face the gold color contact point of SIM card towards the cellular phone and push in the SIM card into the slot.



**This phone only supports 1.8 volt and 3 volt SIM cards.**

## ■ CHARGING THE BATTERY

1. Make sure the battery is inserted into the phone correctly before charging.

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2. Connect the lead of the charger to the socket on the bottom of the phone and plug to an AC wall socket

**Warning: Please DO NOT remove the battery while charging!**



3. The animation **charging** is displayed when the phone is turned off. The phone can work while charging. Please keep charging the battery continuously for 12 hours when you use the phone for the first time and make sure the battery has been fully charged.
4. Black screen will appear during charging if the voltage of the battery is too low (e.g. Not in use for a long time, etc.).The animation Charging will appear after several minutes.

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## ■ SWITCH ON / OFF

1. Long press the Power Key to turn on or off the mobile phone.

Enter PIN code if asked (shown as \*\*\*\*). Please refer to [Settings/Network Security/PIN](#) for more information.

## MAKING AND ANSWRING CALLS

### ■ MAKING CALLS

#### Making Calls by Pressing Number Key

1. (Slide is open or unlocked) Press the phone number by using **Number Key** under sleep mode or main menu mode. To edit the number, press “up” & “down”, and “left” & “right” **Navigation Key** to move the cursor and then press the **Erase** one time to clear one number left to the cursor. Or long press this key to delete all numbers left to the cursor in this line. For International Call, long press the \* **Key** until change to “+” and then follow by entering the number. To reach an extension number, enter the switchboard number at first, long press # **key** until it changes to “P”, and then enter the extension number. ).
2. Press **Dial Key** to make the call.
3. To end up the call, short press **Power Key** or simply

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close the slide.

4. Press Dial Key to bring 20 records of the dialed numbers under sleep mode or main menu mode. Select a number, press **OK Key** and then press **Dial Key** to make the call. If you want to [Dial /Send Message / Erase / Save](#), press **Option**.

### **Making Calls by Using Names**

1. When the slide is open or unlocked, enter into the names by using Right Function Key, then select the name by using **Navigation Key**, press **OK** to bring up the names entries.
2. When you enter into names entries, you can press **Dial Key** to call the default number, or select another number by using **Up/Down Navigation Key**, press **Dial Key** to call.
3. You can also enter [Names/Search](#) menu to find the number you are looking for.

### **Redial the last Dialed/Received/Missed**

1. In the main menu mode, use **Up/Down Navigation**

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**Key** to select last Calls and press **OK Key** to enter.

2. Press **Left/Right Navigation Key** to select among [Dialed/Received/Missed](#).
3. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to the number you are looking for and press **Dial Key** to connect.

### **Speed Dial**

1. Long press **Number Key** 2-9 in the main menu for speed dialing. Numbers are requested to be pre-set to different number Key before dialing. (Please refer to [Names/Speed Dial](#)).
2. After pressing a number key, the phone will connect it automatically.

### **■ ANSWERING CALLS**

1. Press the **Dial Key** to answer calls.
2. Short press **Power Key** or **Reject** to end or reject calls.
3. Adjusting Receiver Volume while speaking on the phone: press **Left/Right Navigation Key**.



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## ■ OPTIONS

This mobile phone provides various functions during calls (many of them are based on Network Service which must be applied from Network Operators firstly). Below are the functions that the phone provides by pressing **Option** during a call. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the following functions. Press **OK Key** to confirm.

1. **Hold**: To select this function, user can receive another incoming call or dial another number without hang up the current call.
2. **Dial New**: Select this function to make another call while you are on the phone. (The current calling will be held automatically).
3. **End this call**: Select this function to end the current call.
4. **End all calls**: Select this Function to end up all the calls.
5. **Send DTMF**: DTMF means double tone & multiply frequency. If this function is selected, the dialed number will be sent as DTMF meaning that you will

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be connected to the number with extension # automatically (Refer to Making a Call).

6. **Mute**: Select this Function to switch on/off the sound of the microphone.
7. **Names**: Enter into names to select the number needed.
8. **Main Menu**: Select this Function to display the main menu during a call.
9. **Conference Call**: This option appears when there are more than three phones being connected with. Select this Function to enable call conference function. (This function requires network support, please apply with the Network Operators.

## NAMES

You can save the name, default number, cell phone number, office number, home phone number, and email address to your mobile phone in the Phone book record. But you can only save one phone number to your SIM. There are totally 500 entries you can save to your mobile phone.

User can use the following function to operate the phone.

When **Fixed Dialing** is **on**, **Names** can not be entered.

Under the sleep mode, press **Right Function Key** to show the name list under **Fixed Dialing**. Details of Fixed Dialing please refers to **Call Setting/Fixed Dialing**.

## ■ SEARCH

Under the main menu, use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **Names**.

1. **By Name**: enter a name or the first letter of a name, then press **Search**. Or find by Group, press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to the group needed and press **OK** to find. Press the # \* to change the page.
2. Scroll to select a names entry and press **Dial**, the number will be connected automatically.
3. Press **Option** to dial, send message, edit, erase, group,

and etc.

4. Press Exit to return to the above menu or short press Power Key to return to the main menu.
5. Press Ok to select the phone number under Fixed Dialing, which you can make a call or send SMS only.

## ■ ADD

Under main menu mode, scroll **Up**、**Down**、**Left**、**Right** to select **Names**, press **Right Navigation Key** once to see the menu **Add** containing following choices:

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **To -> Phone To ->SIM Card**. Press **OK Key** or **Left Function Key** to bring up the new record that you can input the following info. Please also input the area code when you entry the numbers by using the Number Key.

### **To save in the phone:**

1<sup>st</sup> Line: To enter a name.

2<sup>nd</sup> Lind: To enter default number (This number will be recognized by the mobile when you select

the record and press **Dial Key**

3<sup>rd</sup> Line: To enter a mobile number.

4<sup>th</sup> Line: To enter an office number.

5<sup>th</sup> Line: To enter a home number.

6<sup>th</sup> Line: To enter an email address.

#### **To save in the SIM card**

1<sup>st</sup> Line: To enter a name.

2<sup>nd</sup> Line: To enter default number

2. When finishing the entry, press **Save** or **OK** to store the record.
3. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu or short press the **Power Key** to the main menu.

## **■ EDIT**

You can edit your entry by pressing the **Right/Left Navigation Key** under the menu of [names](#).

1. All the records will be listed under the screen of [Edit](#). Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the record you want to edit. You can use the “#” **Key** and “\*” **Key** to turn page down and up to select the records.

Press **OK** to get into the record screen and scroll up and down to select the info you want to change.

2. Use **Save** to store the edited information.
3. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu or short press **Power Key** to the main menu.

## ■ ERASE

You can erase your record by pressing **Left/Right Navigation Key** under the menu of **Names**.

1. **One by One**: Press **OK** to get into **Erase** menu. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the record you want to delete. Press **OK Key** to confirm.
2. **SIM Card**: If you want to erase all the records in you SIM Card, select SIM Card and press **OK** to confirm.
3. **Phone**: To erase all the records that saved in your mobile phone, select **Phone**, and Press **OK** to confirm.
4. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu or short press the **Power Key** to the main menu.

## ■ SPEED DIAL

Select [Names](#) under main menu and press **Left/Rightt Key** to view [speed dial](#) menu. You can set up 8 speed dial numbers from #2 to #9.

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the speed dial number you would like to set up. The number has not been set up will be displayed as “Empty”, press **OK Key** to bring up the name list. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select a name entry in which you will select a number as Speed Dial number. Press **OK Key** to confirm.
2. If you select the number that has been set up before, press [Option](#) to edit or erase.
3. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu or short press **Power Key** to the main menu.

## ■ SETTING

You can set up your names by pressing the **Left/Right Navigation Key** to get into the [Setting](#) menu.

1. [Status](#): You can check your names status by pressing **OK**.



2. **Own Number:** You can find out your own number by pressing **OK**.
3. **Group Tone:** You can set up 4 group Ring tone by pressing **OK**. After you get into the **Group Tone** menu, use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the group name, press **OK** to bring you to the next menu, select the incoming tone by use **Up/Down Navigation Key**. Press **OK** to confirm.

## ■ COPY

Select **Names** under main menu and press **Left/Right Navigation Key** to view **Copy** menu.

1. Choose **SIM → Phone** or **Phone → SIM**, press **Ok** to enter
2. You can choose **One By One** or **All** from SIM card to Phone, or from Phone to SIM Card.
3. Press **Ok** to enter **One By One**, all names will be shown. Choose the one you want to copy and press **Ok**.
4. Press **Ok Key** to enter **All**, all default numbers can be copied from SIM card to Phone or from Phone to SIM card.

## ■ Move

Choose Name under the main menu, press **Left / Right Navigation Key** to see the menu of **Move**. Press **Up/Down Key** to select:

1. Choose **SIM → Phone** or **Phone → SIM**, press **Ok** to enter
2. You can choose **One By One** or **All** from SIM card to Phone, or from Phone to SIM Card.
3. Press **Ok** to enter **One By One**, all names will be shown. Choose the one you want to move and press **Ok**.
4. Press **Ok Key** to enter **All**, all default numbers can be moved from SIM card to Phone or from Phone to SIM card.

## MESSAGE

### ■ SMS

Scroll **Up/Down** to select **Message** under the main menu mode, press **OK** to get into the 3rd level menu of **SMS**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the wanted sub-menu. Press **OK** Key to confirm. Password is needed to get into a certain number of 3<sup>rd</sup> level menus if you have set up **Phone Lock** in **Settings/Network Secu.**

When **Fixed Dialing** is **On**, please note:

1. Please add SMS info center number to the list of **Fixed Dialing**. SMS info center number can be found under **Message/Setting/Info Center**.
2. When you need to enter the call number after entering the message, press **Ok** only to show the name list of **Fixed Dialing**.

Fixed Dialing please refer to **Call Setting/Fixed Dialing**.

### **New**

1. You can enter no more than 160 English letters (space

included) for each message if **New** is selected This mobile supports continuous SMS sending up to 6 items including 912 English letters.

2. Press **Option** to **Send**, **Save to SIM**, **Send to Group**, **Save to Phone**, **Insert Name**, **Insert Number**.
3. Short press **Erase** to delete the letter left to the cursor; long press **Erase** to delete all letters. Short press **Power Key** to return to the Main Menu without saving the SMS.

### Received

All the SMS received are shown in this menu (including messages that been read and not been read). Select **Erase All** to delete all messages received

1. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the **SMS** and press **Read** to read its content, the sender's number (or name), date and time. If the message is too long and you cannot read them all in one screen, use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to turn the page up and page down.
2. **Reply**: To reply this SMS by pressing **OK Key** or **Left Function Key**.

**Erase:** To delete this message.

- **Forward:** To send this message out again.
  - **Edit:** To edit the content of the message and save it
  - **Call:** To call the sender
  - **Extract:** to extract useful data such as number and URL from the message.
  - **Send to Group:** To send this message to a number of people.
  - **Save to SIM:** To save the message to SIM card.
  - **Save to Phone:** To save the message to the phone (this does not work if the SIM card is with big capacity).
3. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu or short press **Power Key** to the main menu.

## Saved

All the saved message (**In SIM Card** and **In Phone**) are shown in this menu (with either saved or sent status). Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the menu and press **Option** to enter.

Press **Navigation Key Up/Down** to select messages stored

in SIM card or Mobile. Press **OK Key** to enter into list.

1. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select one to read. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to page up and page down the content of the message. (All the message will be saved **In SIM Card** but not **in Phone** if the SIM card is with big capacity.
2. Press **OK Key** or **Left Function Key** to bring up the next menu. Use the **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select functions including **Erase**, **Send**, **Edit**, **Extract Sent to Group**, and **save to phone**. (Please refer to the same function in Received SMS). Press **OK** to confirm. The SMS **In SIM Card** can be saved to the phone. You can pick up numbers and URL from message in Extract.
3. Press **Right Function Key** to return to the previous menu or short press **Power Key** to the main menu

### Setting

1. **Info. Center** is a set number for receiving or sending SMS from the network. This number must be set before using SMS. Press **OK** to get into this selection and save the number after setting.

2. **Delivery Rept.:** Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **On** and **Off** to turn the function of **delivery report** on or off after you sent the message. Press **OK** to confirm.
3. Select **Validity** to set the saving period of the message.
4. **Memory Status** shows the SMS memory space in SIM card and phone
5. Press **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## ■ MMS

Select **Message** under Main Menu mode, press OK and then the “right” **Navigation Key** once to get into **MMS** menu. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the sub-menu you want and press **OK** to confirm. MMS requires network support. Please make sure your SIM card supports MMS or consults your network operator before using this function. Password is needed to get into some 3<sup>rd</sup> level menus if you select **Phone Lock** in **Settings/Network Secu.**

## New MMS

Select **New MMS** to create a new MMS by typing in words directly or press the left function key to select the following **options**: (please press **# key** to choice the way of input)

1. **Send**: Type in the recipient's phone number and other relative information, e.g. Cc., Bcc. Use comma between numbers or e-mail addresses. Press **send** to send the MMS.
2. **Insert**: Select this option to insert **Images**, **Sound**, **New Image** and **Slide** to the current MMS. Press **OK** to get into the option you want and press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to scroll in relevant listings, and then press **OK** to confirm.
3. **Template**: This function is to set the display mode of words and images by **above/below** or **Auto**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to confirm. All the words and images will be displayed the way you select.
4. **Preview**: Select this option to preview the new MMS. You can also use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to turn the page up and down.



5. **Save:** To save the new MMS.

## **Inbox**

Newly received MMS is saved to the **Inbox**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the one you like to read and press **OK** to confirm. Then you can select from the options below to operate.

1. **Read:** To read the current MMS, press **Up/Down Navigation key** to change the page; or press the **Option** to do the following option:
  - **Extract:** To pick out images, sound, etc. from the current MMS and **save** them. Pictures and voices are stored in picture folder and voice folder respectively in Multimedia Folder.
  - **Erase:** To delete the current MMS.
  - **Forward:** Type in the recipient's mobile phone number and other relevant info. Such as Cc., Bcc. and press **OK** to forward the MMS.
  - **Reply:** Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to scroll and press **OK** to select between reply by SMS mode or by MMS mode. Then type in the content and press

**OK** to send.

✦ **Dial**: to dial the number of current MMS sender.

2. **Erase**: To delete the current MMS.
3. **Details**: Information of the topic, sent date, number and size, etc. of the current MMS.
4. Press **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## Outbox

All the MMS you haven't sent out are saved this this outbox. Please refer to the [Saved MMS](#)..

## Sent MMS

All the Sent MMS are in this menu, press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to read. Then you can select from the options below to operate.

1. **Read**: To read the current MMS. After you read your MMS, you can simply Exit by using **Right Function Key**; or use the **Left Function Key** to do the following option:

- a) **Extract**: To pick out images, sound, etc. from the current MMS and **Save** them.
  - b) **Erase**: To delete the current MMS.
  - c) **Forward**: Type in the recipient's mobile phone number and other relevant info. Such as Cc., Bcc. and press **OK** to forward the MMS.
  - d) **Reply**: Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to scroll and press **OK** to select between reply **By SMS** mode or **By MMS** mode. Then type in the content and press **OK** to send.
2. **Erase**: Press **OK** to delete the current MMS.
  3. **Details**. Information of the size or other aspect of the current MMS.
  4. **Edit**: Similar function to the same option in SMS.

Press **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

### **Saved MMS**

All the Saved MMS are in this menu, press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to read.

1. **Read**: To read the current MMS. Long press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to change page. Press **Option** to

extract, erase, forward and reply.

2. **Erase**: To delete the current MMS.
3. **Details**: Information of current MMS including size and etc.
4. **Edit**: Similar function to the same option in SMS.
5. **Send**: Edit or enter recipient's mobile number and other information, say forward or cc. Then press Confirm to send MMS (only for files in folder Outbox/Saved MMS).

## Setting

1. **MMS profile**: Get into this option to select the relevant WAP information
2. **Delivery Rept.**: Includes **Send Rept.** and **Read Rept.**, and each of them has two statuses **ON** and **OFF**. Select to set the display of the sending and reading information of the MMS. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to confirm.
3. **Validity**: To set the saving period of the MMS.
4. **Download status**: This option includes **Deferred Dld** and **Immediate Dld**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key**

to select and press OK to confirm.

5. **Slide Duration:** Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to confirm the slide duration of the MMS.

Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## ■ BROADCAST

This function requires network support, please contact the network operator.

1. Press **OK** to get into **Read**, then the activated Broadcast message will be displayed. “No Message” is displayed if there is no broadcast message available in the activated topic. Press **Next** to show another message.
2. Select **Topics** to do the **User Defined** or **Activate** the set topic. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select between the following function if you selected **User Defined**.

- **Add:** To add the topics;
- **Edit:** To edit the current topic;

- **Erase:** To erase the current topic.

3. Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## ■ VOICE MAIL

**Voice Mail** is based on network service, so please contact the relevant network operator to apply for this service. Select **Message** in Main Menu, press **Left/Right Navigation Key** three times to select **Voice Mail**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select between **Get V-mail** and **V-mail Box No.**

1. Press **Ok** to get into **Get V-mail** and dial the V-mail box number.
2. Press **OK** to get into the **V-mail Box No.** to edit the number. Use **Left/Right Navigation Key** to move the cursor. Press **Right Function Key** to Clear the number left to the cursor. Press **Left Function Key** to Save after the editing.

Press **Right Function Key** to Exit to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## MULTIMEDIA

### ■ CAMERA

#### Take Photo

Shortcut—When the slide is open under standby mode, from home screen, long press **Side Key** to activate the Camera (general mode) and viewfinder. Press **OK** to capture and again **OK** to store the picture.





Choose **Multimedia** under Main Menu, press **Left/Right Navigation Key** to see the third menu of **Camera**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to enter.

**Note: It is impossible to take a photo when the slide is closed.**

#### General Photo

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to zoom in and zoom out ( When the size of the photo is set as 640\*480, the focus of the camera can not be adjusted by

pressing UP/Down Navigation Key ), press **OK** key to take and save the picture.

2. Press **Left Function Key** to get into [setting](#) screen and **Right Function Key** to quit, press **Left /Right Navigation Key** to change the picture size , quality , brightness , effect ; Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to change the current setting. Press **OK Key** to take a photo.
3. After action above, press **OK Key** to save the picture. Then it will return to home screen automatically. Or press **Right Function Key** to abort saving and return to the viewfinder.
4. Under viewfinder, press **Right Function Key** to quit.

### **Sticker Photo**

1. When you get into Sticker photo viewfinder, press **Left/ Right Navigation Key** to change the frame. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to zoom in and out. Press **OK Key** to take photo.
2. Setting is the same as in General Photo.(The size doesn't adjust.)



3. After action above, press **OK Key** to save the picture. Then it will return to the viewfinder automatically.

## Album

Scroll **Up/Down** by using the **Navigation Key** to select between **General Photo**, **Sticker Photo** Press **OK Key** to get into next sub-menu. But if you have used the phone lock function (**Settings / Network Security / Phone Lock**), you have to enter your password to get into the 3rd level menu. Press **Option** to:

1. **Rename**: Change the name of current photo.
2. **Erase**: Erase selected photo.
3. **Erase All**:Erase all photos.
4. **Set As Wallpaper**: You can settle the photo as wallpaper.

## Setting

1. You can set up default 1. **Size**, 2. **Effect**, 3. **Quality**, 4. **Brightness** by using **Up/Down Navigation Key**. Press **OK Key** to confirm.
2. Press **Exit** to return to the upper menu or short press

**Power Key** to return to main menu

## ■ V-memo

Choose **Multimedia** under Main Menu, press **Left/Right Navigation Key** to see the third menu of **V-memo**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to enter.

### Add New

Under this menu, press **Up / Down Navigation Key** and **OK** to choose and select **Voice Memo** and **Ring Tone**.

### Voice Memo

Under this Menu, it shows the Total time that you can use to record on the menu, and the Recorded time which you have already taken. Press **OK Key** stop the record and brings you the next menu for to **Play** and **Save**. Select the function and press **OK** to confirm:

1. **Play:** To play the current recording.

2. **Save:** To Save the current recording.
3. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu, or short press the **Power Key** to return to the Main Menu.

## RING TONE

Same as V-MEMO.

### Saved

Under this menu, press **Up / Down Navigation Key** and **OK** to choose and select **Voice Memo** and **Ring Tone**.

### Voice Memo

Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the record that you have already saved. Press **OK** to play the record. Select the function during play:

1. **Rename:** To edit the title of the current saved record.
2. **Erase:** To Erase the current saved record.
3. **Erase ALL:** To Erase all the current saved record.

4. **Detail**: Display the title, length, and record date of current record.
5. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu, or short press the **Power Key** to return to the Main Menu.

## RING TONE

Same as the **Voice Memo** , additionally add following operation:

1. **Incoming tone** : Set saved ring tone as **Incoming Tone**.
2. **Message Tone**: Set saved ring tone as **Message Tone**.

## ■ Media Folder

Select Media Folder under the main menu and press **Right/ Left Navigation Key** to see the third menu. Press **Up /Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to enter.

Enter **Media Folder** can browse multimedia files saved in

the phone, such as: [Album](#), [Download Image](#), [Download Midi](#), [PC Image](#), [PC Midi](#), [Voice Memo](#). Also, you can erase them. Because the memory of the phone for the files are shared, the space of file in every folder will be changed according to the arrangement

Password is needed to get into some 3<sup>rd</sup> level menus if you select [Phone Lock](#) in [Settings/Network Secu.](#)

## ■ FM Radio

Select [Multimedia](#) under the main menu and press **Left / Right Key** to choose “[FM Radio](#)” and **OK** key to enter the third menu.

### [Listening](#)

Listening the channel stored last time under the [FM Radio](#). Short-press **Side Key** to tune the saved channels.

### [Adjust Volume](#)

Short Press **Left / Right Navigation Key** to adjust the volume.

### Automatic Search

Long press **Side Key** to search all channels from 87.5MHz ~ 108Mhz and save the channels automatically.

### Search By User

Short Press **Up/Down Key** to search the channels between 108MHz and 87.5MH and press **Left Function Key** to save the channel.

**Note: When listen to the radio, the earphone must be connected with the phone always, acting as the antenna for tuning the channel. It can save 40 channels altogether.**

## RECORD

The phone will keep the record of the [Dialed](#), [Received](#) and [Missed](#) number. To find this record by select [Record](#) under the main menu mode or simply press the **Dial Key** under the sleep mode.

Each record includes dialed times, the name of incoming calls (if they are saved in the names), the numbers, time of dialed and missed, and lasting time of the call.

After get into the Record Menu, you can use the **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select one of the record by using **OK Key** or **Left Function Key** and follow the operations: [Dial](#), [Send Message](#), [Erase](#) and [Save](#) (if the name has not been saved before), or Press **Dial Key** to call the number in the record.

### ■ DIALED

There are 20 dialed records can be saved to [Dialed](#). Each record can show 5 call history. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the record you like to use. Or press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## ■ RECEIVED

Similar with [Dialed](#), 20 of the last received numbers can be saved in [Received](#). Each record can show 5 call history. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the record you need. Or press **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## ■ MISSED

20 of the latest missed numbers can be saved to [Missed](#). Each record can show 5 call history. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the record you need. Or press **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## ■ ERASE

Select [Erase](#) to delete the [Dialed](#), [Received](#), [Missed](#) or [All](#) records. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to confirm. Then press **OK** again to delete the record or press **Exit** to quit.



## ■ TIME INFO

1. Select **Time Info.** to view the time information of the calls, includes Total calling time, Outgoing calling time and Incoming calling time.
2. Select **Erase Time Info.** to delete the information above. Press **OK** to delete or press **Right Function Key** to exit.

## ■ COST INFO

Select **Cost Info.** to view the information of the call cost. (This function requires network support, please contact the network operator). Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to get into each Info.. Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

1. To select **Last Call** menu and press **OK** to see the cost for the last call.
2. To select **ALL Calls** menu and press **OK** to see the cost for all the calls you made.
3. Select **Clear Logs** and input the correct PIN2 code to delete all the cost records.

4. Select **Cost Units** to check the cost rate. Input the correct PIN2 code to re-set the cost rate.
5. Select **Max Cost** to check the maximum cost available. Or re-set the Maximum cost after inputting the correct PIN2 code

(The above options can be set or deleted without inputting PIN2 code for some SIM cards).

## ■ GPRS INFO.

Select GPRS Info. to view the data flow information of the internet browsing (this function requires network service support, please contact the network operator). Under the menu of **GPRS Info.**, you can find **Current Conn.**, **All Conn.**, and **Last Conn,Clear Logs**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to confirm. Select **Clear Logs** to delete relevant information. Press **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

## SERVICE

Select **Service** under the main menu; use **Left/Right Navigation Key** and press **OK Key** to get into the next menu:

### ■ CALL DIVERT

You can divert the incoming calls to a number you have set by using this function. (This function needs network support, please contact with network provider to apply for this service.) When **Fixed Dialing** is **On**, calls can not be diverted.

There are several conditions to divert incoming calls. And each condition has three selections: **On**; **Off**; **Status**. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select and press **OK** to confirm. Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

### **Unconditional**

To select **Unconditional** you can divert all the incoming

calls to a number you have already set on any conditional. Press **OK** to get into next sub-menu which has **On/Off/Status**.

1. **On**: Press **OK** to bring you to the next sub-menu **Set Number/Voice Mail**.
  - a. **Set Number**: Enter the number or using **Light Key** to search the record from your phone book. Press **OK** after you finish entering the number to confirm.
  - b. **Voice Mail**: To select **Voice Mail**, your phone will search the voice mail number automatically for you if you have already have this service. If not, it will bring you to the screen that you can enter the voice mail number. Enter the number press **OK** to save.
2. **Off**: Select **Off** and press **OK** to turn off this function.
3. **Status**: To select this menu, you can check out that you have turned on or off this function.
4. Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main menu

### **No Reply**

To use this function, if there is no answer during the period of time (which you have to set the time range), the

incoming calls will be diverted to another the number that you have already set.

### **Busy**

To use this function, if the line is busy, all the incoming calls will be diverted to another number that you have already set.

### **Not Available**

To use this function, if you are in the network service area or you turn the power off, all the incoming calls will be diverted to another number that you have already set.

### **Cancel All**

Select this function to cancel all the above divert settings.

## **■ CALL BARRING**

You can use this function to set up the numbers that you like to forbid to dial or to bar the numbers you don't like to receive. (This function requires network service support, please contact the network operator).

Select **Service** under the main menu, press **OK** and **Right Navigation Key** once to get into **Call Barring**. Under this menu, you can use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the

followings. Get into each of the following menu; you will see three of the sub-menu **On/Off/Status**. After you finish the setting, press **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

### **Outgoing**

By using this function you can forbid to dial all the numbers. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **Outgoing** and press **OK** to the next menu that you can turn **On** this function by select **On** and press **OK** follow by entering the network password. You can also turn **Off** this function by selecting **Off** and Press **OK** follow by entering the network password. To check out whether you have turned on or off this function, select **Status** and Press **OK**.

### **Intl. Out**

By using this function, you can forbid to dial all the international calls.

### **Dial Local**

To set up this function, you only can dial the local numbers.

### Incoming

Select this function to bar all the numbers that you don't like to receive.

### Roaming In

Turn on this function; the mobile will not receive any calls when it is roaming.

### Cancel All

Select this function to cancel all the above setting after entering the password.

### Password

To select this function, you can change the password (If user apply for the relevant service, the network provider will give you this password.)

## ■ CALL WAITING

In this menu, user can set the function on or off. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** to the item you want to choose. Finish the operation, press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

Choose **On** to turn on the call waiting function. If there is

an incoming call while you are on the phone, the incoming number will be displayed on your screen..

Choose [Off](#), the call waiting function will be deactivated.

Choose [Status](#), the mobile will tell whether the call waiting function is active or inactive.



## SETTINGS

### ■ AUDIO SETTING

Under the main menu mode, use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **Setting**. Press **OK** to bring up the **Audio Setting** Menu. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the sub-menu. Press **OK** to confirm.

#### Set Profile

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select between **Normal**, **Meeting**, **Outdoor**, **VIP**, and **Silent**. Press **OK** to confirm the select.
2. Press the **Right Function Key to Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

#### Edit Profile

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the item you like to edit. Press **OK** to enter to the next sub-menu.
2. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the following menu by pressing **OK** to enter and press **Exit** to return to the above menu or short press **Power Key** to return to the main menu:

## Incoming Tone

1. After get into this menu, use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the tone. Press **OK** to confirm the incoming tone
2. Press the **Right Function Key to Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

## Message Tone

You can select one of the message tones by using **Up/Down Navigation Key** after you get into this Menu. Press **OK** to confirm. Press the **Right Function Key to Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

## Volume:

You can adjust the volume of the [Speaker](#), [Ring Tone](#), and [Message Tone](#) by select the menu of [Volume](#).

- 1). Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select between the

menu of [Speaker](#), [Ring Tone](#), and [Message Tone](#). Press **OK** and use the **Left/Right Navigation Key** to adjust the volume. Press **OK** to save.

- 2). Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

### [Keypad Tone](#)

To select the [Keypad Tone](#) by using **Up/Down Navigation Key**, you can turn the volume [On](#) or [Off](#).

### [Power On Tone](#)

To select the [Power On Tone](#), you can turn [On](#) or [Off](#) the tone when you turn on your mobile phone

### [Slip Tone](#)

To select the [SlipTone](#), you can turn [On](#) or [Off](#) the tone when you move up the slide.

## System Tone

You can turn the system tone that includes when the system has been set up successfully, failed, saved, or deleted [On](#) or [Off](#).

## Vibration

To turn the Vibration [On](#) or [Off](#) when you receive an incoming call.

## ■ PHONE SETTING

Under the Main Menu mode, use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select [Setting](#). Use **Left/Right Navigation Key** to select [Phone setting](#) menu. Press **OK** to bring you to the next sub-menu.

### Language

Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select different [Language](#) press **OK** to enter. From this sub-menu you can select the language. Press **OK** to confirm. Press the **Right Function Key** to Exit to the previous menu, or short press

**Power Key** to the Main.

### **Back Light**

Select this option by using **Up/Down Navigation Key**. Press OK to bring up the following menu.

#### **a. Backlight Timer**

Select backlight timer by using **Up/Down Navigation Key**, press **OK Key** or the **Left Function Key** to confirm. To select the timer between **5 Sec.**, **10 Sec.**, **15 Sec.**, **25 Sec.** and **Always On** by use **Navigation Key**. Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

#### **b. Backlight Level**

The backlight level of the screen and keypad can be adjusted by entering to this menu.

1. Use **Left/Right Navigation Key** to adjust.
2. Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

### **Input Methods**

Select input methods which are in common use from all methods provided. Then you can switch among these

selected input methods by short press the **# Key**.

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the input method press **OK** to confirm. User can have the multiple choices.
2. Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

### Wallpaper

Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select Bitmap or Flash. Press **OK** to enter. Use the **Navigation Key** again to select the one and press **OK** or **Left Function Key** to view. Press **OK Key** or **Left Function Key** to save the one as your wallpaper.

- 1 Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select Bitmap or Flash. Press **OK Key** or **Left Function Key** to save the one as menu background.
- 2 Press the **Right Function Key** to **Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main.

### Time & Date

Select this option to edit the time and date on the phone.

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **Time &**

Date, press **OK** to bring you up next menu, **Set Time** and **Set Date**.

2. Select **Set Time**, press **OK** to bring you a screen that you can input the time. Press **OK Key** or the **Left Function Key** to save and return to the previous menu.
3. Select **Set Date**, press **OK** to bring you a screen that you can input the year, month, and date. Press **OK Key** or the **Left Function Key** to save and return to the previous menu.
4. Press the **Right Function Key to Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

### **Auto ON/Off**

Activate this function to pre-set the time to turn the **Power On/Off** Automatically.

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select between **Auto On** and **Auto Off**. Press **OK** to confirm.
2. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **ON** or **Off**, press **OK** to confirm the selection.
3. If the user selected **On** from the menu of **Auto On** or **Auto Off**, it requires to input the time that you like to

turn the power on or off each date automatically. After finish the input, press **OK Key** or **Left Function Key** to save and return to the previous menu.

4. Press the **Right Function Key to Exit** to the previous menu, or short press **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

### Factory Settings

You can use this function to reset your mobile to the Factory Setting (default setting). If you set up your system to the default setting, you will lose all the settings your made before. So please carefully use this function.

1. When you select [Factory Settings](#), press **OK** to enter. It will ask you [Restore Factory Settings?](#) Press **OK** or the **Left Function Key**.
2. Press **Right Function Key** to give up or the short press the **Power Key** to return to the previous menu.
3. It will not delete your phone book or the other info which you have saved to your phone when you use this function.
4. The time and the date you have set up will also not be changed when use this function.



## ■ CALL SETTING

Under the main menu mode, use up and down **Navigation Key** to select **Settings**. Press right **Navigation Key** twice to the sub-menu **Call setting**.

### Outgoing ID

To set up this function, you can choose to show or block your ID from the receivers. But it needs your local network support.

1. Under the **Call Setting** menu, Select **Outgoing ID**, press **OK** to enter to the next menu. Select **On** or **Off** by using up and down **Navigation Key**.
2. Press **OK** to confirm.
3. To return to the previous menu or to the main menu, press **Right Function Key** or short press the **Power Key** to return to the Main Menu.

### Minute Reminder

To use this function, you will hear a reminder sound for each minute. To set up the function, please refer to the above.

## Fixed Dialing

1. To use this function, you only can dial the specified number. Enter the PIN2 number (which you need to order the service from your local phone company), press **OK** to confirm.
2. If you have entered correct PIN number, it will bring up a sub-menu. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** and press **OK** to select the followings.
  - ◆ **Phone Number List**: Listed all the numbers that have already set up with. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the number. Press **OK** to confirm.
  - ◆ **Add**: You can add more numbers from this menu. Press **Save** to confirm after you finish entering the number.
  - ◆ **Edit**: You can edit the names and numbers on the list.
  - ◆ **Erase**: Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the number you want to erase from your **Fixed Number List**. Press **OK** to confirm.
  - ◆ **Status**: Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **On** or **Off**, and press **Ok** to turn this function on or off.

3. Press **Exit** to return to the previous menu or short press the **Power Key** to return to the main menu.

### Ejected Calls

You can refuse to receive the number by using this function. Enter the password (default password is 1234), press **OK** to enter the sub-menu to set up this function.

1. **Number List**: Select this and press **OK** to bring up the Ejection Number List which you have already set up. You can select number to edit. Press **OK** to confirm.
2. **Add**: To add a new number that you want to eject. Enter the number or use **Left Function Key** to bring up your phone book list. Press **OK** to confirm after finish the entering the number.
3. **Erase**: If you want take the number out of your ejected number list, select the number by using **Up/Down Navigation Key**, press **OK** to confirm.
4. **Status**: Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **On** or **Off** to turn this function on or off.
5. To return to the previous menu or the main menu, press **Right Function Key** or short press the **Power**

**Key** to return to the main menu.

## ■ NETWORK SECU.

Under the main menu mode, use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **Settings**. Press “right” **Navigation Key** three times to the sub-menu **Network Security**. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select between the followings, press **Enter** to bring up the next menu.

### Choose Net

You can choose the net **Automatically** or **Manually**.

1. **Automatic**: Select **Automatic**, press **OK**. The net will search the best network service automatically for you.
2. **Manual**: Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select **Manual**, press **OK** to confirm. The net will search the entire available networks in your area. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the one you want, press **OK** to confirm.
3. To return to the previous menu or the main menu, press **Right Function Key** or short press the **Power Key**.

## Choose Band Mode

You can choose EGS/DCS or PCS only.

1. Press Up/Down Navigation Key to select, and then press Ok Key.
2. Press Exit to return the above menu or short press Power Key return to the main menu.

## PIN

You can set up your PIN number from here. There are normally 4 numbers. After you finish entering the number press **OK** to confirm and return to the previous menu. Press **Right Function Key** or short press the **Power Key** to return to the previous menu or the main menu.

**Warning: If you continuously enter the wrong PIN three times, your SIM card will be locked. (You have to contact your local phone company to unlock the phone). If you continuously enter the wrong number ten times, your SIM card will be damaged and no long to can be used. (You have to buy a new SIM Card from your local phone company).**

## Phone Lock

You can turn on or off, and change or setting your phone password from this menu. You need enter the password to get into some of the menus (such as [SMS](#), [MMS](#), [Album](#), and [Film](#)) when you set up this phone lock function.

1. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select between the sub-menu, press **OK** to confirm.
2. Input password, press **OK** to confirm.
3. If the password is correct, you can turn on or off of this function. You also can edit your password; you need enter your new password twice, and then press the **OK key** to confirm.
4. To return to the previous menu or the main menu, press **Right Function Key** or short press the **Power Key**

**The default of the password is 1234.**

## EXTRAS

### ■ TOOLS

Select **Extras** under the main menu, and press **Left / Right Navigation Key** to enter the third menu of **Tools**. Press **Up/Down Navigation Key** and **Ok** to enter.

### Alarm

Enter the menu and press **Up/Down Key** to select **Set time** and **Alarm Status** and press **Ok** to enter.

#### Set Time

1. Press **OK** to select **Set Time**. Input the time (24 Hours) by using the **Number Key**. Moving the cursor by using **Left/Right Navigation Key**. Press **OK** to Save and bring you to the next menu.
2. It will bring you to the menu that you can set up the alarm to the status of **Repeat off**, **Repeat Daily**, and

[Repeat Weekly](#) after you finish entering the time by pressing **OK**. Use **Up/Down Navigation Key** to select the function you like. Press **OK** to confirm and return back to the previous menu.

3. After finishing the setting, press **Right Function Key** to return to the previous menu or short press the **Power Key** to the Main Menu.

### Alarm Status

1. Press **OK** to enter this menu. It shows the alarm status. You can press **Left Function Key** to enter to the next menu to [Modify / Reset](#) or turn the [Alarm Off](#).
  - ◆ [Modify/Reset](#): To modify or reset the current alarm.
  - ◆ [Alarm Off](#): Select Alarm Off and press OK to turn off the alarm.
2. After finishing the setting, press **Right Function Key** to return to the previous menu or short press the **Power Key** to the Main Menu
