
## Front panel operation instruction


## Rear panel operation instruction

- 1.External battery terminals.
- 2.Power switch: Used to open or close the speaker power.
- 3.External insurance stand: Used to replace the machine fuse.
- 4.Power socket: Used in power supply to the speaker.
- 5.Audio signal input: Used to connect various signal source.
- 6.AC voltage select switch.




## Remote controller specification

- ① Power : Used to open or close the MP3 player power.
- ② PLAY/PAUSE key: Used to play or pause music.
- ③ MODE: Used to switch the USB/SD/Bluetooth/IPOD reader and other external signal.
- ④ PREVIOUS: Used to select front song
- ⑤ Next: Used to select next song
- ⑥ VOLUME+:Used to increase the MP3 player volume
- ⑦ VOLUME-:Used to reduce the MP3 player volume
- ⑧ ~ ⑩: Digital key:it can used to select repertoire directly or free combination when repertoire more than nine under USB/SD mode.
