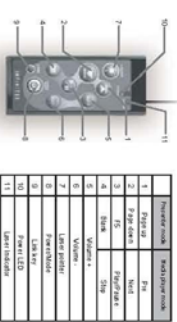

## Operational Functions:



- Note :**
1. Press the "Power / Mode" button for 2 seconds which controls the power on/off of the device.
  2. Press the "Power / Mode" button for only one time which controls the Presenter and Media Player Mode.
  3. When the battery is low, the Power LED will blink slowly.
  4. After you press the Link button a will enter to the Discovery Mode, then the Power LED will blink slowly.

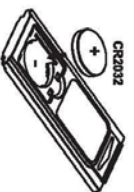

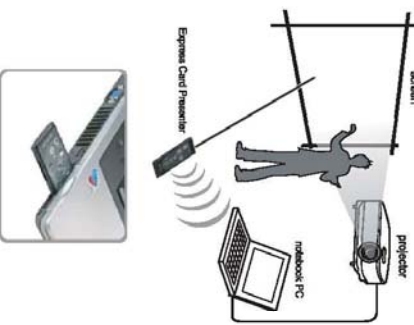
## Power Management:

- In order to prolong the life time of the battery
1. EP1 will be turned off automatically if it is disconnected with the computer within 3 minutes.
  2. If EP1 is inactive in 15 minutes, the power will be turned off automatically even the EP1 is connected with computer.

## Troubleshooting:

- The Express Card Presenter is not working.
- + Make sure that the polarity of the battery is correct.
  - + Verify that the computer is Bluetooth enabled.
  - + Paired devices are always displayed in My Bluetooth Places, even if the Express Card Presenter is out of range or not powered up.
  - + Verify the Express Card Presenter of the pair is within remote range, and powered up, then attempt the connection again.
  - + If Express Card Presenter is not work correctly or malfunction , like skip pages while touch of page up or page down button , try to decrease remote distance.

**Initial Configuration**

The Express Card Presenter is designed to work with the four major software stacks (protocol) standards: WIDCOMM, for Toshiba, NT and Mac OS X. Please check your computer which software stack your computer has. Please contact your system vendor if your system does not support one of the following Bluetooth software standards

1. Double click the Bluetooth icon located on your desktop or in the system tray, then click Bluetooth setup wizard.
2. The Bluetooth configuration screen will prompt. Click Next to continue.
