


Quick Guide

Your KRUSE® Commentary System




KRUSE® Installation Procedure

- 1 Tune the vehicles radio to 107.7 in the FM band and store this setting (refer to the vehicles manual if you need assistance with this).

FM 107.7

- 2 Place the system firmly between the vehicles dashboard and windscreen to prevent movement during normal vehicle operation.



- 3 Connect the power cable firmly into vehicle cigarette lighter or power socket and start the vehicle. The power indicator should illuminate and the GPS indicator will begin to flash.

- 4 You should hear 3 "beeps" through the vehicle stereo as KRUSE® starts up, followed shortly by music.

- 5 When the GPS indicator becomes solidly lit the system has obtained your position and is ready to use.

- 6 If this is the beginning of your holiday press the START button on the KRUSE® system. The power indicator will flash once and an introductory commentary will play.

More Information

- The start button only needs to be pushed at the beginning of your holiday. If you are travelling on roads you have already been on and wish to hear the commentaries repeated, push the start button again.
- If the power indicator fails to illuminate when you start your vehicle, please ensure the power plug has been firmly inserted into the cigarette socket.
- If the GPS indicator fails to illuminate solidly after more than two minutes then please check that the system has been placed upright and has an unobstructed view to the sky through the front windscreen.
- If problems persist please call the toll free number printed on the front of your system.
