2. Using with Windows98/SE

*The driver program should be installed in Windows98/SE OS. It is required only one time when you first connect the product to PC with Windows98/SE OS.

(The installation is not required for higher Windows version than Windows98/SE)

1. Insert the CD supplied with the product into your PC CD-ROM driver
2. Click on Win98 Driver in initial set up screen
3. Driver will be installed showing the following screen. (Fig. 2-1)
4. At the completion of installation Fig. 2 will be displayed on the screen to confirm if you want restart the system.
5. Click on FINISH button to restart the system.

3. Connecting with PC

1. Connect the product with PC with the USB cable supplied with the product.
2. USB driver will be automatically identified following the message of "searching for the new device." (Verifying box may not appear according to the system setting. Verify it by visiting "My Computer - Resource - Hardware - System manager")
3. When the device is identified 'Removable Disk' is created in 'My Computer' as shown below. LINE, LOGO, RADIO and VOICE folders are created in Removable Disk.

* My-1020 will be converted to 'Recharge Mode' following the connection to PC.

4. Disconnection

* Use 'Hardware remove or disconnection' function to remove My-1020 from PC.

1. Point on 'Hardware remove or disconnection' icon () with mouse pointer on the right bottom of the screen.



2. Click on the icon and the following message will pop up.



3. Click on the above message to display the following message.



* My-1020 will return to previous mode with the power on when it is safely removed from PC.

4. Remove My-1020 from the PC USB port.
('Removable Disk' in 'My Computer' will disappear when My-1020 is removed.)


* Warning 1- Don't remove USB cable in the program process to avoid any unexpected PC error.
* Warning2- Remove the device from PC only after My-1020 LCD displays 'READY' or, otherwise, data loss or damage may occur.

•Basic Functions

Once the power is on, music files will be played after displaying following screens in sequence. 'NO FILE' will be displayed if there is no file existing in the memory





2. File Download/Upload


1. In your PC, select files you desire to download to your MP3 player



6. Recording (REC)

My-1020 supports recording function for voice, line-in or FM radio. Press **A+B** button for longer seconds to record the sound source. Press **■** button shortly to pause the recording. Press **A+B** button to halt the recording and return to previous mode.

* It does not support Pause function in FM Radio recording

* When the memory gets full it displays 'DISK FULL'

Voice Recording – you can record your voice with built-in microphone

Press **A-B** button for longer seconds to start the voice recording.

Line-in recording – Sound sources from other audio player can be saved in My-I020 in WMA format

Press **A-B** button for longer seconds by connecting the device to other audio player with the Line-in cable supplied with the product to start the recording

Radio recording – Press **A-B** button for longer seconds in FM listening to start the recording.

Advance-recording is available by setting the time period.



7. Recharge

My-I020 supports the new recharge system using USB connection with computer.

When connecting My-I020 to PC with USB cable the recharge of the battery automatically starts with 'CHG' displayed on the product.

CHG will disappear at the completion of recharge and will be changed to OK.

*When 'OK' disappears it is not recharging any more to protect the product from the excessive recharge.

8. HOLD



Set the HOLD key to hold all functions in the product and no button are functioning under this mode.
Release the function to enable all buttons again.

9. Reset

Press reset button with an aid of pointed device such as a clip or pin when the product is in trouble temporarily.

At resetting, all preset values will be initialized without having any change in data.
It does not effect product's life span

• Convenient Functions**1. Section-repeat Function**

1. Press **A-B** (A<->B) button shortly at the starting point from which you desire to repeat in playing the file to set the starting point for Section-repeat displaying 'A' on the screen.
2. Press **A-B** (A<->B) button shortly once again at the ending point to which you desire to end the repeat to set the ending point for Section-repeat displaying **A-B** on the screen.
3. **A-B** mark will disappear when moving the file to other place or once again pressing **A-B** (A<->B) button shortly. Until **A-B** disappears the function repeatedly continues

**2. SOUND Function**

EQ can be set as per your taste for music tone. Press **EQ** button shortly to choose desiring tone.

2. Install 'LYR3 EDITV122.EXE' in the CD supplied with the product.

● Creating lyric files

1. Double-click on Lyrics3 Editor icon on desktop.

2. Open a MP3 file by selecting Open F3 or  icon from File menu on top of the current window.



3. You may type in lyrics Lyric editor window by opening a MP3 file.

You may also copy & paste the lyric



4. Click on Play  button from Lyric editor to play the file with the aid of Winamp installed in PC.
5. Click on Timestamp mode  button to align the lyric streaming with the music and elapsing time indication such as [00:05] will appear on the left side of each line.

Keep this job until the end of the song.



6. Click on button to complete lyric writing.

7. At the completion of the writing, select 'Export to LRC' file to download the lyric to MP3 player
