

# ***User's Manual***

## **The Device Data:**


1. Model designation: CY-01
2. Power: 12V battery
3. Frequency: 315 MHz

## **Operation instruction:**

Step:

1. Switch on the call unit by on/off volume control.
2. Put the call unit away from the remote unit up to 150 feet
3. Push the button on the remote unit as the illustration on the panel one by one, accordingly the call unit will sound as Buck Grunt, snort, tending grunt, Rattling antler, Doe bleat. No sound will be a cured if two or more buttons were pushed at the same time.
4. The call unit will sound as your need once the button on the remote unit was pushed. When the button released the sound will not stop until the sound cycle end
5. When stop to use the remote deer call, don't forget to switch off the call unit.

While you are calling in that big buck, you will no longer have to worry about giving away your tree stand or ground blind location. The light weight calling unit can be placed up to 150 feet away from your tree stand or ground blind and operated by remote control. This keeps the deer's attention on where the call sounds are coming from, and not on you.

If you are a serious deer hunter, photographer, or nature lover, this remote calling system will have you calling like a pro every time.

# REMOTE DEER CALL

**BUCK GRUNT** - Sound that a buck makes when mating and/or communicating with a doe he is trailing. This call means "come here".

**SNORT** - An aggressive sound usually made by the dominant buck in anticipation of fighting another buck. This call is also used by a buck to merely intimidate another buck in order to avoid a fight.

**TENDING GRUNT** - As the rut intensifies, the buck will use this call as he is trailing a doe trying to mate her. It is the buck's way of asking the doe to stop so he can breed her.

**RATTLING ANTLER** - Rattling antlers signals a fight between two bucks. This often times lures a third buck who is curious, or who is interested in stealing the doe while the fighting bucks spar.

**DOE BLEAT** - The sound a doe makes to signal that her breeding time is near, which attracts bucks to the area.
