

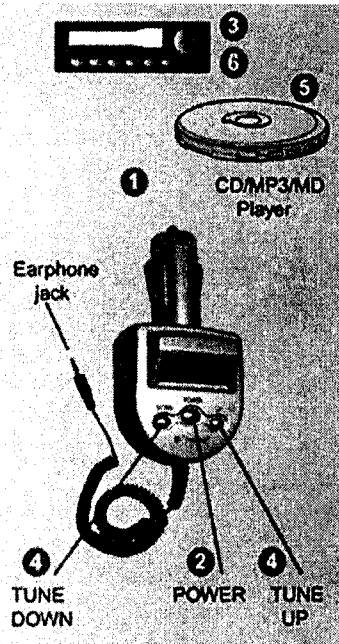

Operating Instruction



1. Plug the FM-812 Wireless Music adapter into cigarette lighter in the car.
2. Turn on the FM-812 Wireless Music adapter by pressing the POWER button.
3. Select a free FM channel on the car stereo between 88.1 and 90.1 Mhz.
4. Select the same channel on the FM-812 Wireless Music adapter by pressing the UP and DOWN buttons.
5. Connect the earphone jack into portable CD/MD/MP3 Player.
6. Press PLAY on the portable CD/MD/MP3 Player.
