



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Connect the AC/DC Adaptor to DC port on the rear of the

unit. Insert the AC/DC adaptor to a wall power port with AC 100-240V; 50/60Hz



7. Tune - / Skip Backward Button

8. Tune + / Skip Forward Button RESET Button 10. BT (Bluetooth) Button Volume - Button

12. Volume + Button

2. Press & hold the Standby button on the unit for about 2 seconds or Press once on the remote controller

4. Press Volume +/- buttons to adjust the volume level

6. Press & hold the Standby button on the unit for about 2 seconds or press once on the remote controller

7. If you do not intend to use the unit for long period, turn off the unit. Slide the Power ON/OFF switch on the rear of the unit to OFF position. All indicators will turn off.

In first time use, slide the insulation film from under the battery cover and discard it, press the LED ON/OFF button on the remote controller. as shown in the figure below. 2. To turn it off, press and hold the "Mode & LED Lights" button on the device or press the LED ON/OFF


When battery is drained, replace battery as shown below: 1. Pull the battery tray out and slide it out as the figure below

2. Install new CR2025 button cell in the Remote Control as per the indicated polarity 3. Close the battery tray

General Operation:

1. Slide the Power ON/OFF Switch on the rear of the unit to ON position to Power ON the unit. The STANDBY/FM Indicator light will turn on.

and then release the button to turn the unit ON from Standby mode.

3. Press the Mode button on the unit or Remote Controller repeatedly to select the desired input source, and the respective Source LED indicator will light up on the control panel.

5. Press the Mute Button on the Remote Controller to turn off the sound temporarily; press again to turn

and then release to turn the unit off (Standby mode)

DECORATIVE LED LIGHTS

1. To turn on the decorative LED lights, press and hold the "Mode & LED Lights" button on the device or

BLUETOOTH CONNECTIVITY

1. For first time use or re-pairing to a new Bluetooth Device, please follow below procedure – 2. Power ON the unit

3. Press the Mode button repeatedly until the Bluetooth Indicator lights up and starts flashing. 4. Turn ON the bluetooth on your Mobile Phone or Tablet or Computer

5. Search for available Bluetooth devices and you would find "SL JUKEBOX" – Pair it with this device 6. If required, enter the password "0000" to pair with the device 7. Once paired, the Bluetooth indicator light will stop blinking.

8. You can now stream music wirelessly through the paired device.

To pair with an existing paired device; follow the below procedure -1. Turn ON the unit

2. Press the Mode button repeatedly until the Bluetooth Indicator lights up and starts flashing. 3. Turn ON the bluetooth on your Mobile Phone or Tablet or Computer

4. Wait for few seconds until the unit is paired to the Jukebox automatically. Once paired, the Bluetooth indicator light will stop blinking.


5. You can now stream music wirelessly through the paired device.

CONNECT THROUGH AUX1

2. Insert one end of the Auxiliary cable (included) to the Headphone Jack or Line Out Jack or AUX Out Jack of an external audio device such as Smart Phone or Tablet or MP3 Player etc. as the photo below. Insert

the other end of the Auxiliary cable to the AUX 1 jack of the Jukebox.

4. Play music from the audio source. Make sure the volume level on the audio source is on highest level, and further control the volume on Jukebox




CONNECT THROUGH AUX2

1. Turn ON the unit


2. Insert one end of the RCA Cable (Not included) to the Audio Out Jack (RCA Type) on external Audio/Video Power Source of Remote Controller: DC 3V, 1 x CR2025 Button Cell FM Radio Band Coverage: 87.5 - 108Mhz

4. Play the music from the external audio device as normal. Make sure the volume level on the audio source
