

FCC Question: When the client is turn off, does the charging session continue? If so, which provide the worst condition? The applicant also did not address the concern that the probe may be picking up emission from the handset (when powered on) or the base emulator (if applicable).

Response: The charging session takes place whether the client is turned on or turned off. As explained in the previous response, the measurements were checked both with the client turned on and turned off. There was no difference in the measured E & H fields between the two test conditions. The emissions measured were strictly from the EUT / charging device.
