
<div><p>Introduction</p><p>Thank you for purchasing Imego bluetooth BTH-318 Your Imego bluetooth is a sleek cordless headset that enables comfortable handsfree communication with your bluetooth cell phone.</p><div></div><p>(A) Headset</p></div> <div>4</div>	<div><p>Imego Bluetooth Wireless Headset User Guide for BTH-318</p><p>Charging your headset</p><p>Before using headset, you must charge the headset for approximately two hours. when fully charged, the battery provides up to 4 hours of talk time and up to 100 hours of standby time.</p><div><p>To charge the headset</p><ol style="list-style-type: none">1. plug AC adapter into headset charging point (as shown here).2. plug AC adapter other end into a wall outlet.3. When the headset is charging, the amber LED will light.3. Unplug the charger cable from the wall outlet and the headset after charge finish, the amber LED will dim out.</div><div></div><p>Battery indication: The amber LED will turn off after charging, this indicated user can use this headset. However, it needs to take two hours to fully charge the battery.</p></div> <div>5</div>

<p>Pairing headset to your cell phone</p> <p>Pairing is the process of linking the headset with your Bluetooth cell phone. Before you use headset with your cell phone you must pair the devices. After this process is completed, you can use the headset only with its paired cell phone. The pairing process only need to be done once for continuous usage. If you wish to use the headset with a different cell phone, you must repeat the pairing process with the new cell phone. In this case, the headset will no longer work with the original cell phone. Before you pair the headset, ensure that the battery is fully charged.</p> <p>To pair the devices</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. With the headset turned off, press and hold the TALK button for five seconds. The blue and amber LEDs will flash alternately, and you will hear the PAIRING tone.2. Release the TALK button. The headset is now in pairing mode.3. Turn on the cell phone and place it within 10 feet of the headset.4. Initiate the device discovery feature on the cell phone. Refer to the cell phone user guide for instructions for initiating this feature.	<p><small>I mego Bluetooth Wireless Headset User Guide for BT-H-318</small></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">5. When prompted by the cell phone, enter the headset pin code 1000. When pairing is complete, the blue LED on the headset will flash at three-second intervals and the headset will be placed in standby mode, ready to make and receive calls. <p>If disconnection or lost links occur, it may be due to the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The range over 10 feet between both headset and cell phone.2. Cell phone to disconnect the link in order to save the power or other purpose.3. Either device has been switched off. <p>Note: The headset will keep the connection with cell phone at all times if both connection links have been built up.</p> <p>To cancel pairing mode</p> <p>While you are in pairing mode, you can cancel the pairing process and turn off the headset.</p> <p>Press and hold the TALK button for three seconds. Both LEDs will turn off and you will hear the OFF tone.</p>

<p>Earhook go around the earhook</p> <p>Fitting Headset on your ear</p> <p>Headset is designed to fit comfortably in your ear. For added comfort, you can add the optional earhook and/or fit ring.</p>  <p>To place the headset on your ear. Place the headset speaker in your ear with the micro-phon angled toward your mouth as shown. The headset should fit snugly in your ear. However, if the speaker is too small for your ear, you can change to other size of the fit ring that is provided with your headset.</p> <p>To add the fit ring</p> <p>Stretch the fit ring around the end of the speaker as shown.</p> <p>To add the earhook</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. To wear headset on your right ear, insert earhook into earhook holder, pushing until it stops.2. To remove the earhook, gently pull the earhook away from the holder until it separates from the headset. <p>To replace the decorate cover</p> <p>Accessory include 5 piece attachment decorate covers,you may choose one of them, and replace it as shown.</p> <p>Powering Up</p> <p>To turn ON the headset</p> <p>Press and hold the Talk button for four seconds. You will hear the ON tone or blue light flash. The headset turns on and is placed in standby mode, ready to make and receive calls.</p> <p>To turn OFF the headset</p> <p>When the headset is on, press and hold the Talk button for four seconds. You will hear the OFF tone or blue light off. The headset turns off.</p> <p>Making Calls</p> <p>You can make calls from your cell phone, or directly from your headset using voice dialing commands (if this feature is supported by your cell phone).</p> <p>To make calls from your cell phone</p> <p>Dial the call from your cell phone. <p>To make calls using voice dialing (if supported by your cell phone)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the Talk button on your headset. 2. Speak the name of the person you wish to call. The call is automatically connected to your headset. 	<p>Adjusting The Volume To increase the volume Press the volume button "+" to increase the volume by 1 level, repeat this procedure until you have reached the desired level.</p> <p>To decrease the volume Press the volume button "-" to decrease the volume by 1 level, repeat this procedure until you have reached the desired level.</p>
<p>Receiving Calls You must configure your cell phone to answer calls directly on your headset. Refer to the cell phone user guide for instructions for initiating this feature.</p>	<p>Muting/Un-muting Headset You can mute and un-mute the microphone temporarily so that you cannot be heard by the connected party.</p>
<p>When your cell phone rings, press the Talk button on your headset. The call is automatically connected to your headset.</p>	<p>To mute the headset Press and hold the volume button for three seconds.</p>
<p>Ending Calls When you have finished your call, press the Talk button on your headset. The call will be disconnected.</p>	<p>To un-mute the headset When the microphone is muted, press and hold the volume button for three seconds.</p>
