



Charging Operation

- To charge the product, please plug the charger into an electrical outlet and connect with the device's micro USB port.
- It is normal phenomenon that the device become warm during charging, which will not affect its service lifetime or performance.
- If the device can not be charged normally, please contact our service center.



Appearance & Buttons



- (1) Front camera.
- (2) Screen: Window for operation and display
- (3) (5) Speaker
- (4) The return key: press to return to the previous operation screen interface
- (6) Power on/off: Short press to enter into sleep mode or wake up, long press to power on/off the device.
- (7) Vol- : Turn down the volume
- (8) Vol +: Turn up the volume
- (9) Menu: Function menu for any application interface.
- (10) Reset

Kids Interface




Kids interface displays the applications assigned by parents, on the top of the screen, it shows wifi, battery life , kid's avatar and nickname etc, on the bottom of the screen, it shows the Personalized Favorites, kids can keep the preferred applications inside, which can hide or pop up by click or drag-and-drop.

Remark: The infrared distance sensor will darken in kids interface to remind keeping right distance with

the screen to protect kid's eyesight.

● Children set



Click “Children set” in the kids interface to enter into children set interface, and you can adjust the volume, screen brightness and Wifi.

● Kids Browser



After added the children's personalized brower in the kids interface, if parents set the browser to access all websites, children can search the preferred site; while if parents set the specific websites, the


children can click and visit the designated links only, which will be displayed below.

● Theme



Children can set the their favorite theme . click the “theme manager” to preview, click the Apply button to finish the setting.

● Children Applications Uninstall and Remove




Long press the desktop application icon and then click black icon  to uninstall, accordingly it will also be uninstalled in the parents interface. If you want to remove it in the kids interface only, you can

Interface Switch


Kids Interface switch to Parents Interface: Press Menu button in Kids interface, will pop up a password window, enter the correct password and confirm “quit” to back into parents interface.



Parents interface switch to Kids interface: Click “Launcher” in the parents interface to enter into Kids interface.

Password: If you forgot your password, pls click “Forgot your password” in the password interface, and

you will receive the password notice in your binding- email address.



select“Settings” enter Parents Settings; select“quit”to exit kid interface.

Parents Setting

Press Menu button in kids interface, there will pop up a password window, enter correct password to enter into parents interface or directly click “ Parents Setting” in parents interface.


- Set the child's name, gender, birthday, etc.

● Apps Manager




Parents can assign or delete the entertainment or educational applications for children.

- **Monitoring Manager**




It can clearly see each application's usage record in the last seven days, convenient for parents to supervise children better

Period setting : Children use it only in the set period


- Brower Manager
