I have left a voice mail, but wanted to follow it up with an email. FCC testing has been completed and went well. One item that did come up is that the following statement should be included in the instructions for this.

This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may caused undesired operation.

We are shipping the three replacement controls with the resistor tomorrow. You should receive them on Friday and if you can please get us feedback regarding the performance by Monday, we need to start building parts.

Additionally, we need feedback regarding the harness today. Please confirm that the harnesses are acceptable. If you can also provide feedback regarding the key covers and the fit of the transponder.
