

Troubleshooting

Bluetooth - If a problem pairing check that the blue light is illuminated. If not repeat steps 1 and 2. If it still will not pair delete any previous "PLANTPETZ™" pairings on your phone.

Microphone - If your flowers are not responding move closer (within 8") and speak louder. If playing music move your phone closer to the microphone and/or increase the volume if necessary.

Touch Response - If your flowers are not responding, be sure to touch or stroke gently and slowly with both hands.

If your PLANTPETZ Vase stops responding:

1. Try switching the Power Button off and on again.
2. If switching off and on does not work you may need to replace the batteries.
3. If the vase is still not responding check that the batteries are fresh and inserted with the correct +/- polarity.
4. If the Inner Vase stops moving remove it by pulling it out to release the magnetic coupling. Clean out anything that might be restricting the movement.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

Retain this information for future reference. Batteries should be replaced by an adult.

CAUTION: TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

1. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.
2. Do not mix old and new batteries.
3. Do not mix alkaline, standard(carbon zinc), or rechargeable batteries.
4. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
5. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
6. Do not short circuit the supply terminals.

Should this product cause, or be affected by, local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment. Reset (switching off and back on again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.

Touch your flowers and they will respond with movement, sounds and music

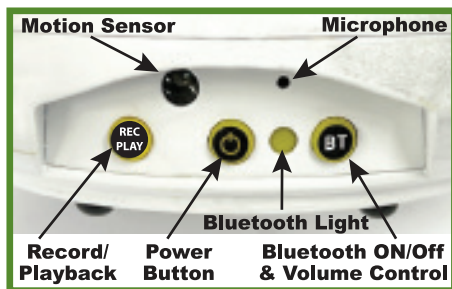


Pair with your smartphone. It's a Bluetooth speaker to stream your own music.

Motion sensor responds to your presence with movement and sound.

Microphone Speak or play music and it will dance. Record a message to play back.

Getting Started

1. Fill the inner vase approximately half full with water. Insert and arrange your flowers.
2. Press and release the Power Button.

Now you are ready to interact with your flowers.

Move close to the microphone and speak, your flowers will respond with movement.

With both hands gently touch or stroke the flowers and they will respond with sounds, music and movement.

Play music from your smartphone or other sound source close to the microphone and your flowers will respond with movement.



Volume Control

Short press and release (less than 1 second) the Bluetooth button (BT) to change the volume level, indicated with a beep. Each consecutive short press and release will adjust the volume level progressively one increment higher or lower.

If you do not switch off your PLANTPETZ™ Vase it will enter sleep mode after 2 minutes of no inactivity, and 'wake up' when the motion sensor is activated.

Pair to a smartphone with Bluetooth

1. Press and hold the Bluetooth Button (BT) for more than 3 seconds until you hear "ready to pair" and the blue light is on continuously.
2. Open Bluetooth on your smartphone, click on "PLANTPETZ™ Vase" to pair. Now your Vase is a Bluetooth speaker. Stream music or any audio from your smartphone and your flowers will dance to the music.

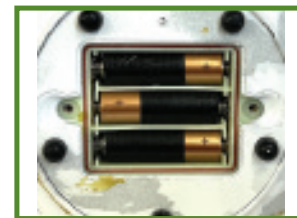
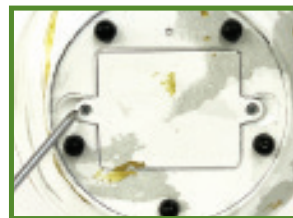
Record A Message

1. Press and hold the Record Button (REC/PLAY).
2. When you hear a beep start recording a message, speaking closely into the microphone. Continue to hold the (REC/PLAY) button for the duration of your message.
3. Press and release the (REC/PLAY) button to play back your message. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to re-record.
4. Turn your PLANTPETZ™ vase off. Turn the power back on and your message will play when the Motion Sensor is activated. Touch your flowers and your message will play back once more.

Caring for PLANTPETZ™

1. Remove the Inner Vase and check that the drain hole through the PLANTPETZ™ base is not obstructed.
2. Check the underside of the Inner Vase and remove any potting soil trapped in the magnetic coupling.
3. Do not immerse the PLANTPETZ™ vase in water.

How to install or replace batteries



1. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw in the battery box cover and remove the cover.
2. Insert 3 x 1.5V AA size alkaline batteries (included). Be sure to install correctly as indicated by the +/-.
3. Replace battery cover and tighten the screw.
4. A 'beeping' sound every 30 seconds alerts you that the batteries need replacing.
