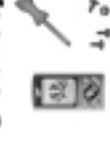


● Usage Precautions

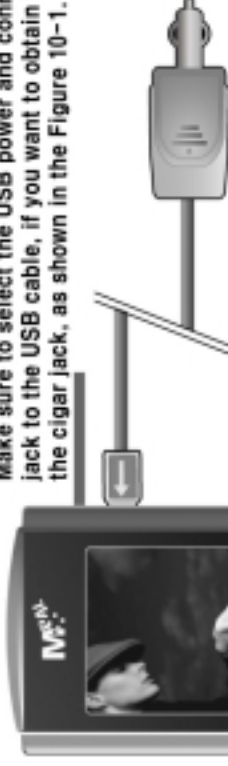

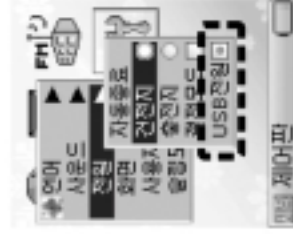
(Figure 10-1)

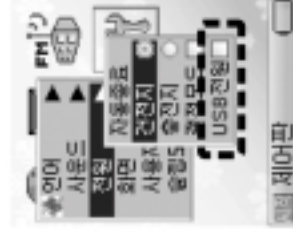


(Figure 11-1)

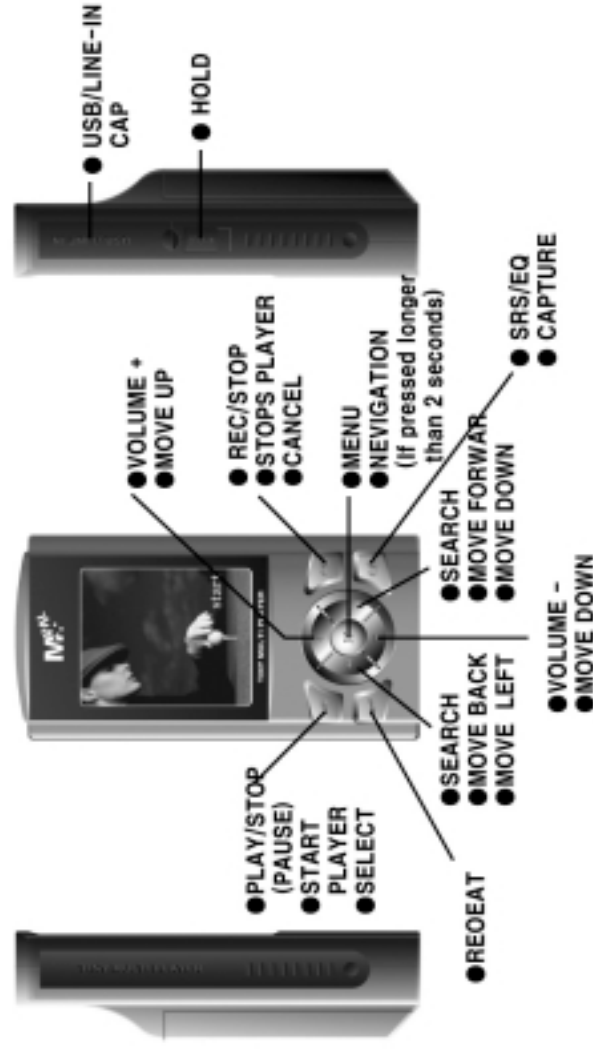
(Figure 11-3)

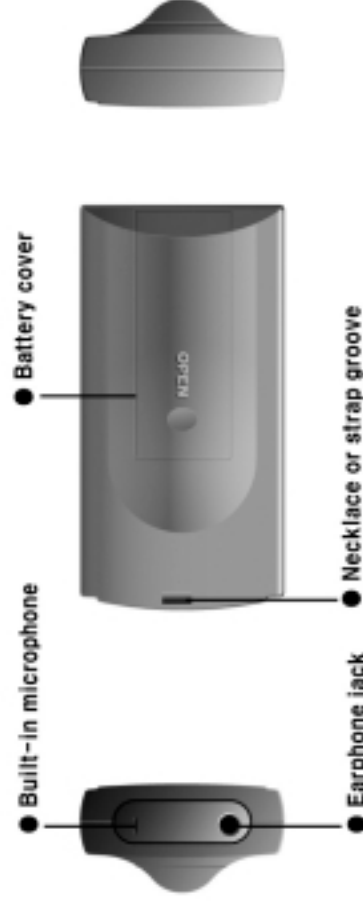
●Battery Usage Precautions

- ▶ If the battery is almost flat, the "Low Batt" message will appear on the LCD. If message display continues longer than 5 seconds, the player will be turned off automatically.
- ▶ The battery life span can vary according to the sound volume or the player mode.
- ▶ Set the Auto Power Off time to effectively manage the battery usage time.
- ▶ If you don't use the player, turn HOLD switch to the "On" position to prevent battery consumption by unintended key operation by mistake.
- ▶ If your skin or cloth is contaminated with the electrolyte, wash it with clean water.

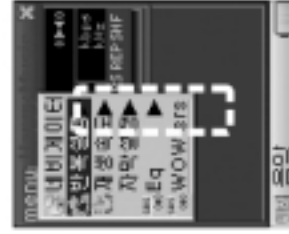

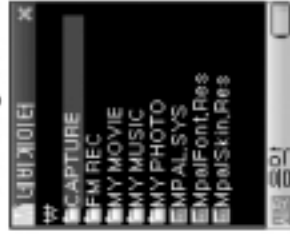


(Figure 16-3)

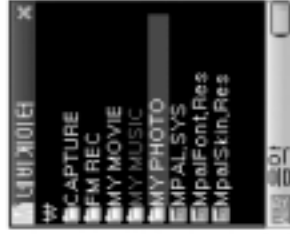

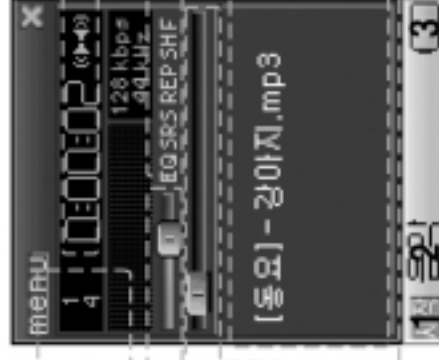

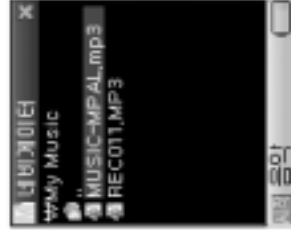
(Figure 24-1)

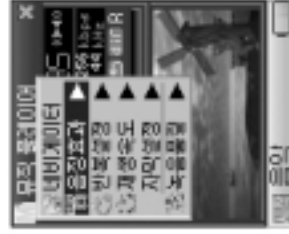

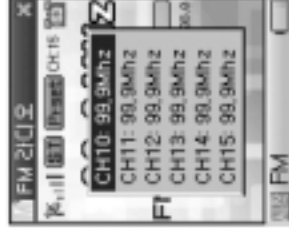
(Figure 33-1)

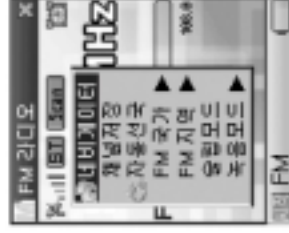
(Figure 33-2)

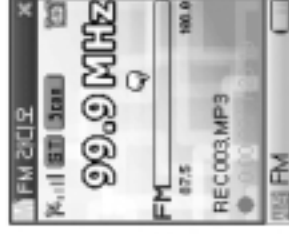
(Figure 34-1)

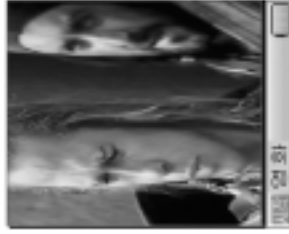

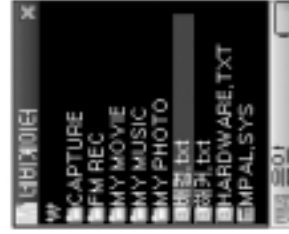

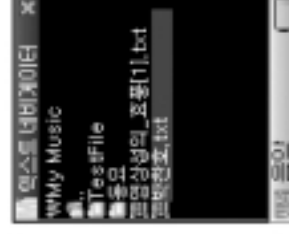
(Figure 43-3)

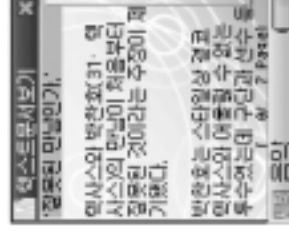
(Figure 44-1)

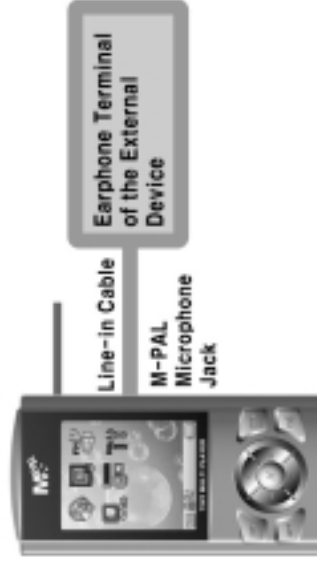
(Figure 44-3)

● Recording External Sound Using the Voice Recorder

You can record sound from the external audio devices.

1. Connect the audio connection cable between the output terminal (earphone terminal) of the external device and the line-in terminal of the voice recorder.
2. Adjust the sound volume of the external device. If the sound volume of the external device is too high, sound can be distorted when playing it back.
3. Press the [Play] button in the external device and the [Record] button in the voice recorder at the same time.



- ▶ Stereo sound will be recorded. To check the recording status, use the earphone.
- ▶ To save the external sound in M-PAL, change the input type to the line-in mode before starting to record.

● Recording the Sound Recorded in the Voice Recorder to the External Device

You can move the contents recorded in the voice recorder to the external device.

Connect the audio connection cable between the output terminal (microphone terminal) of the external device and the earphone terminal of the voice recorder



- ▶ Run the recording test first.
- ▶ Adjust the volume in the external device for volume control.
